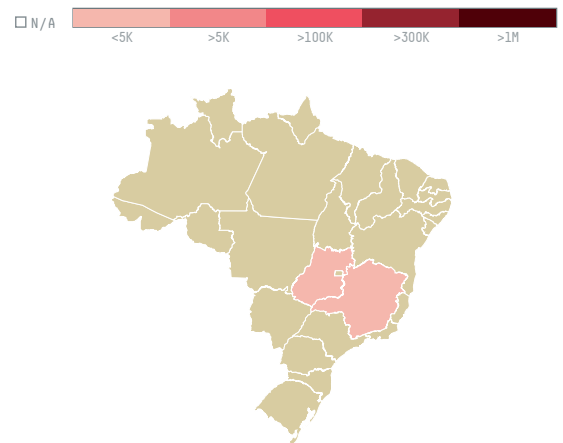
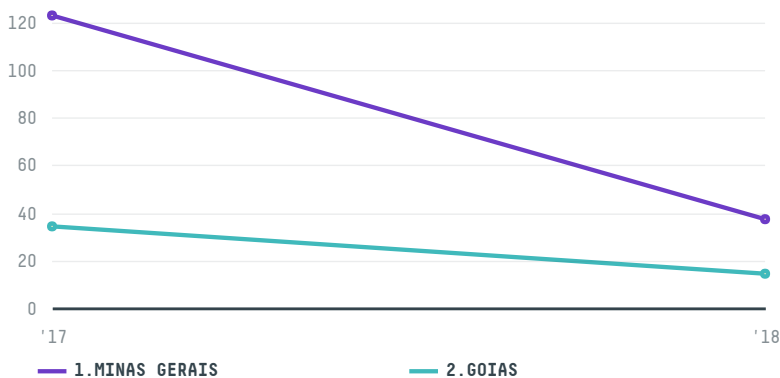
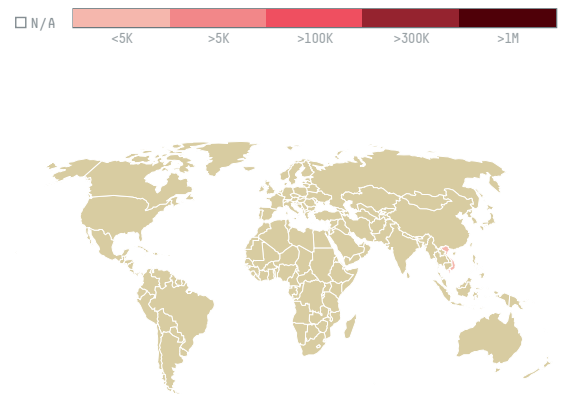
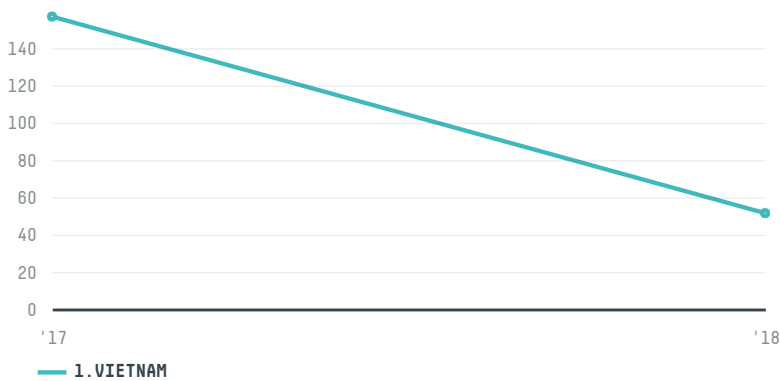


# EWOS GROUP
