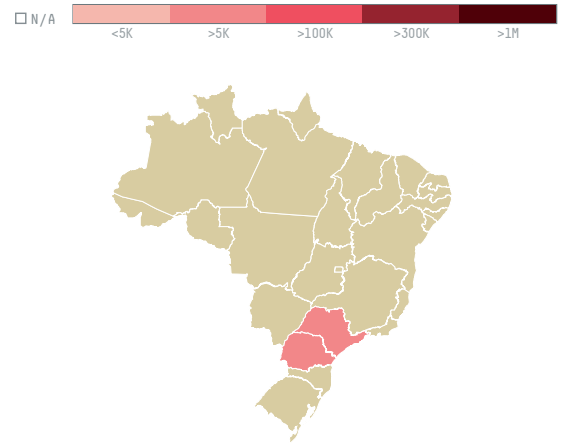
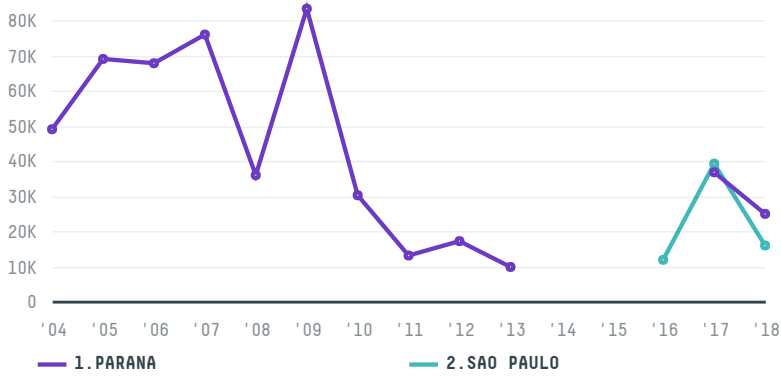
INTEGRADA COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL

INTEGRADA COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL was the 61st largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 56 thousand tons. This is a 27% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, INTEGRADA COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL sources from 10 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by INTEGRADA COOPERATIVA AGROINDUSTRIAL is CHINA (MAINLAND), accounting for 93% of the total.

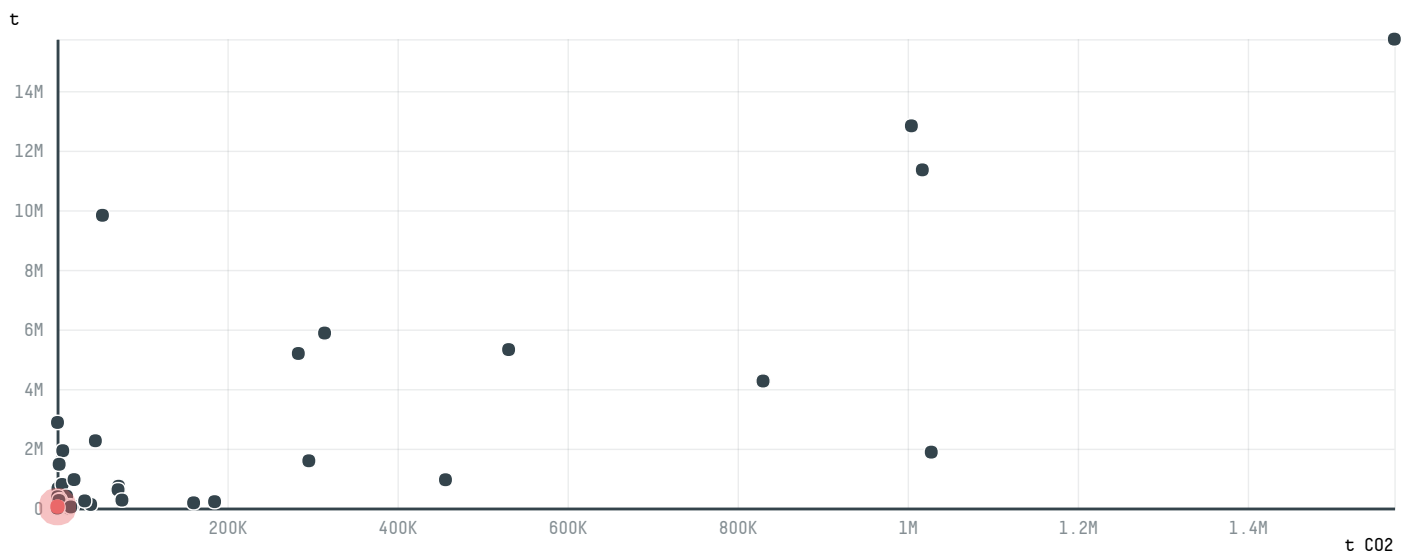
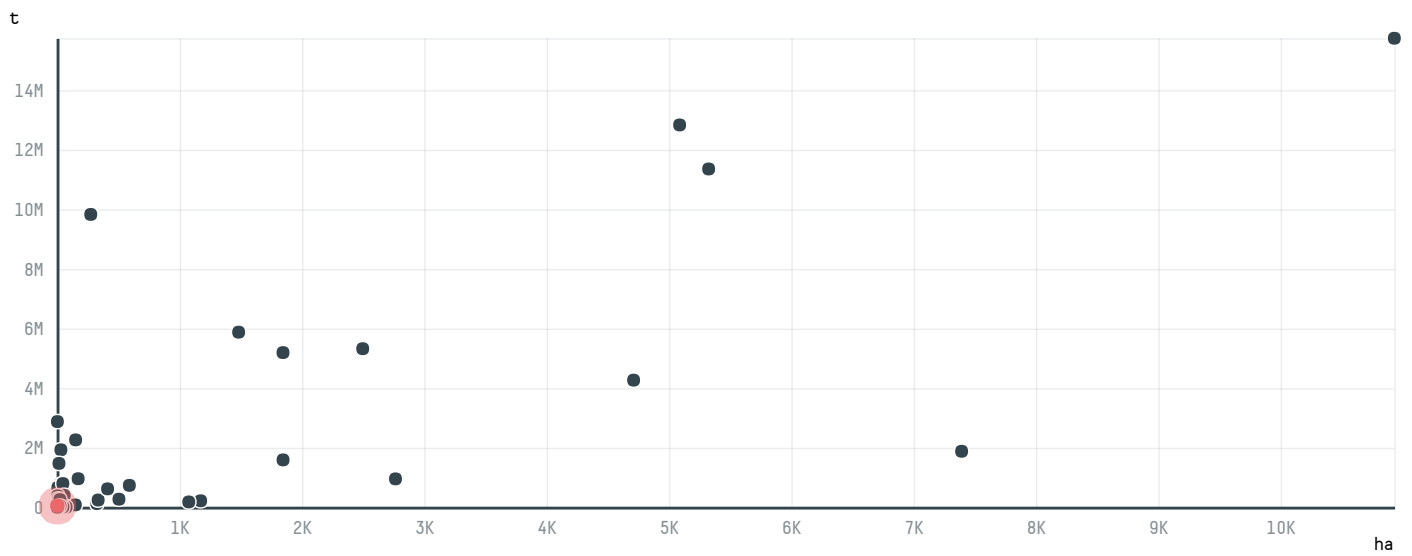
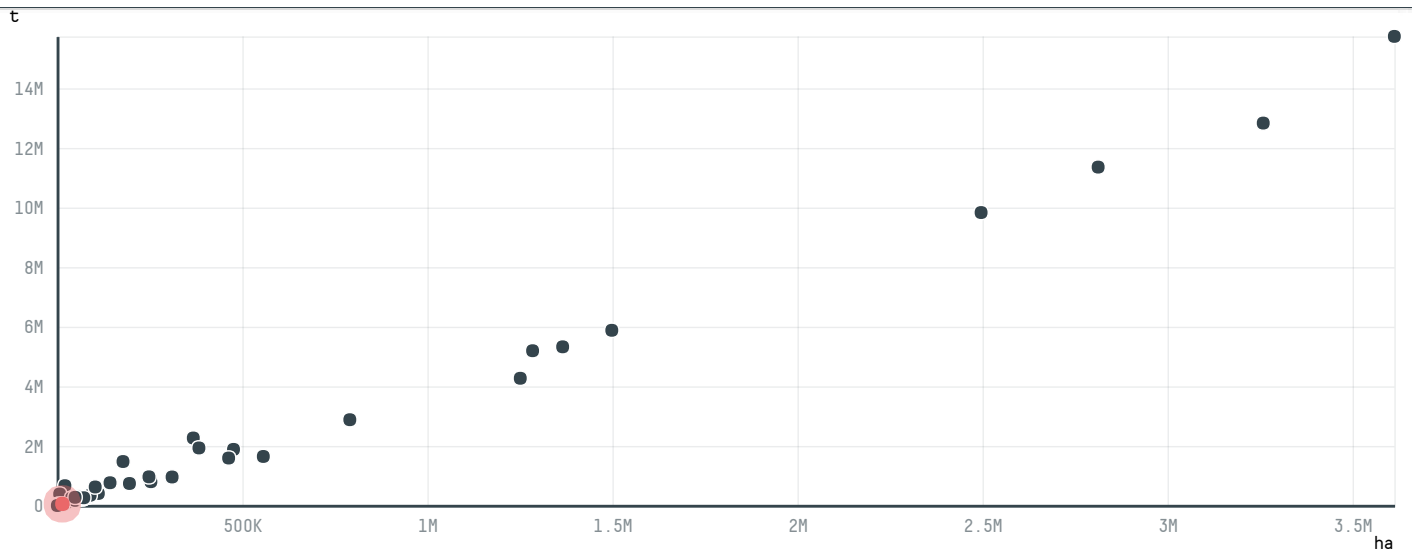
