The main destination of the soy imported by DER HERNG INDL CO is TAIWAN, accounting for 100% of the total.

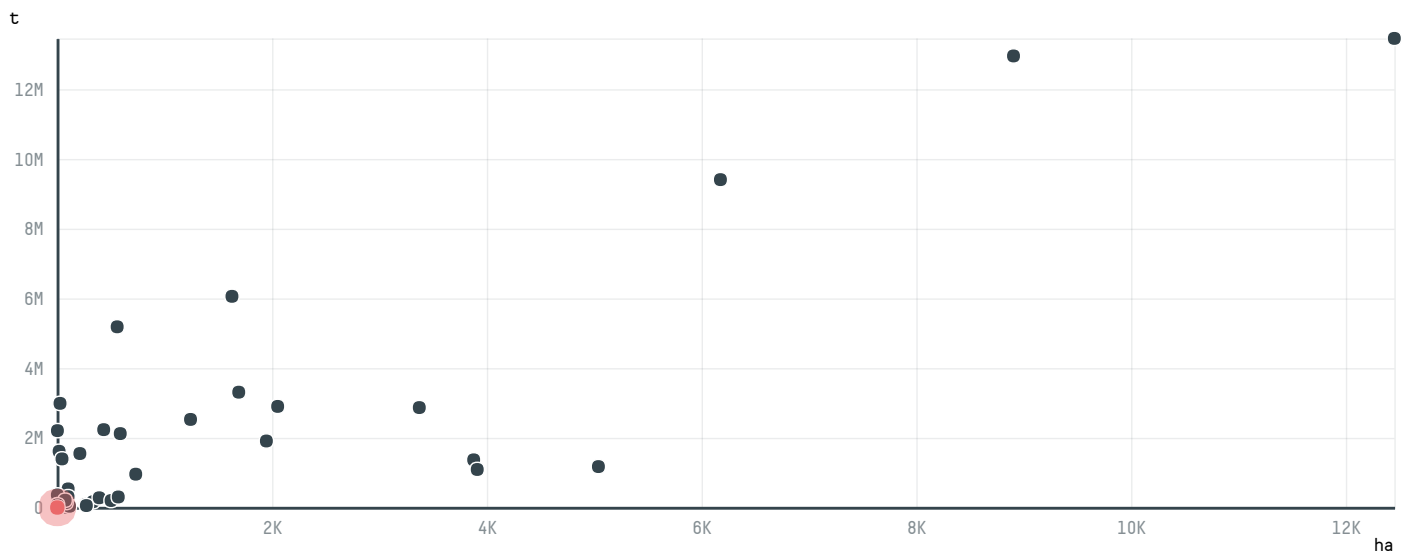
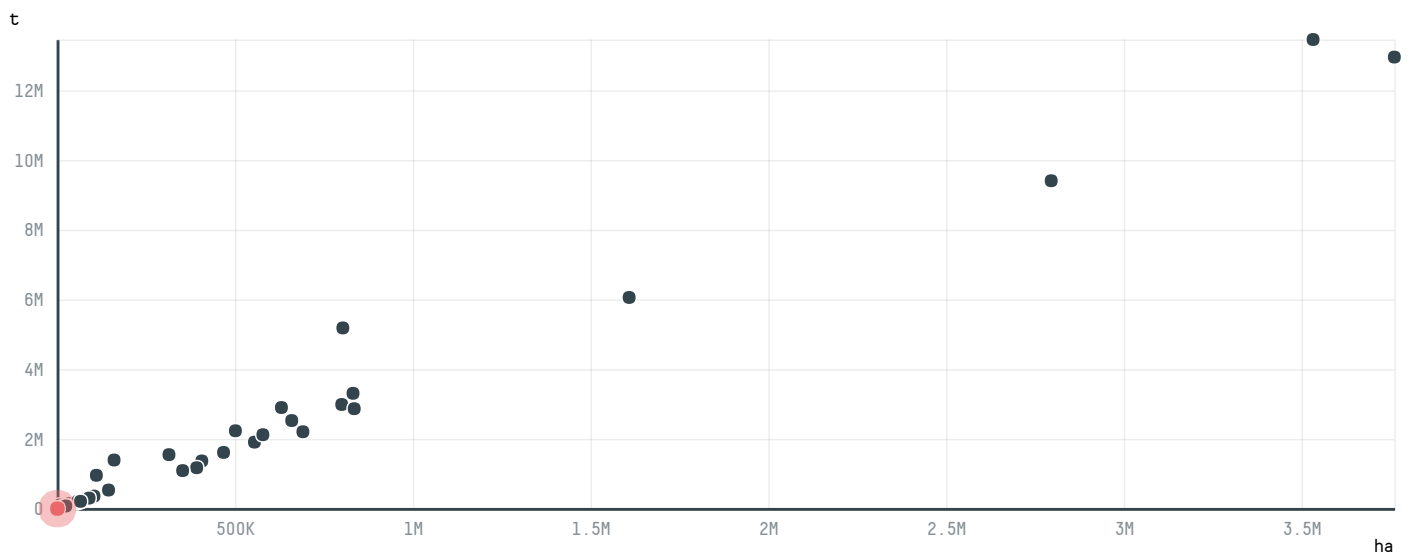

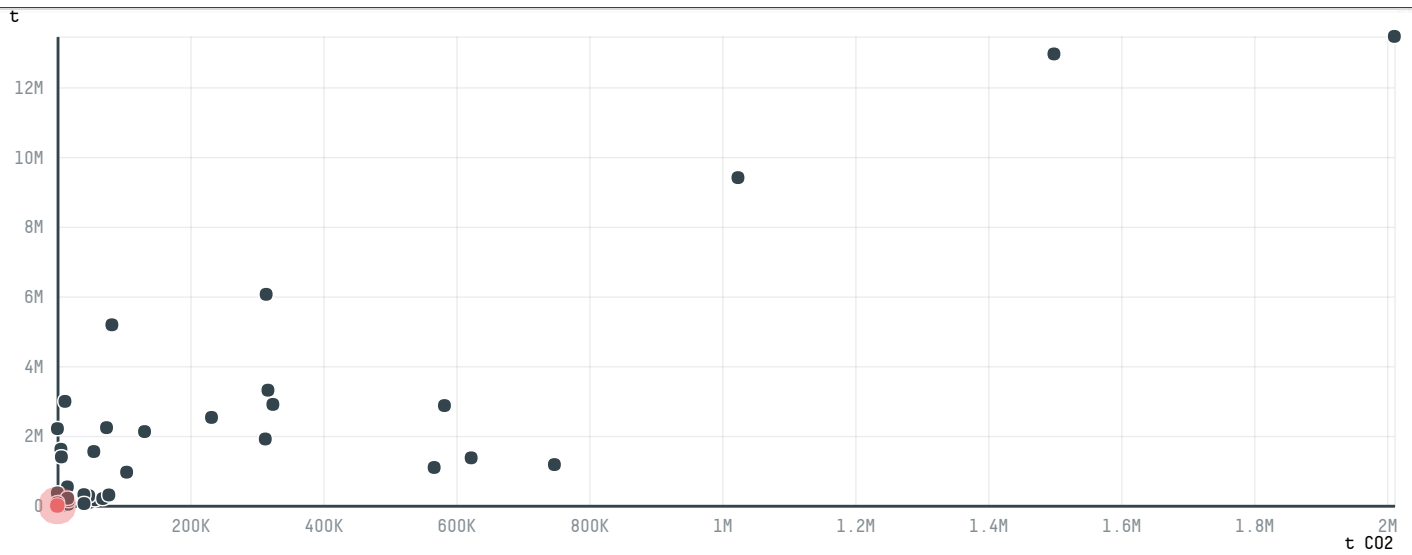
