



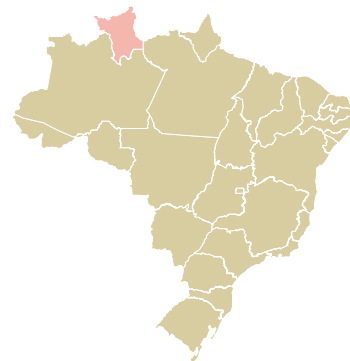
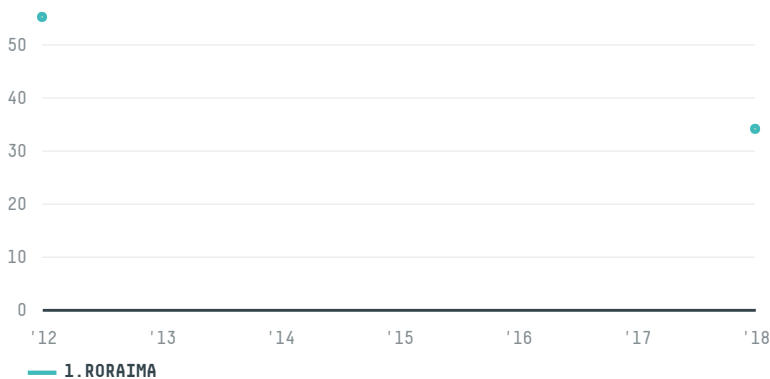

AMEER ISHMAIL was the 147th largest importer of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 34 tons. This is a 38% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, AMEER ISHMAIL sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy imported by AMEER ISHMAIL is GUYANA, accounting for 100% of the total.

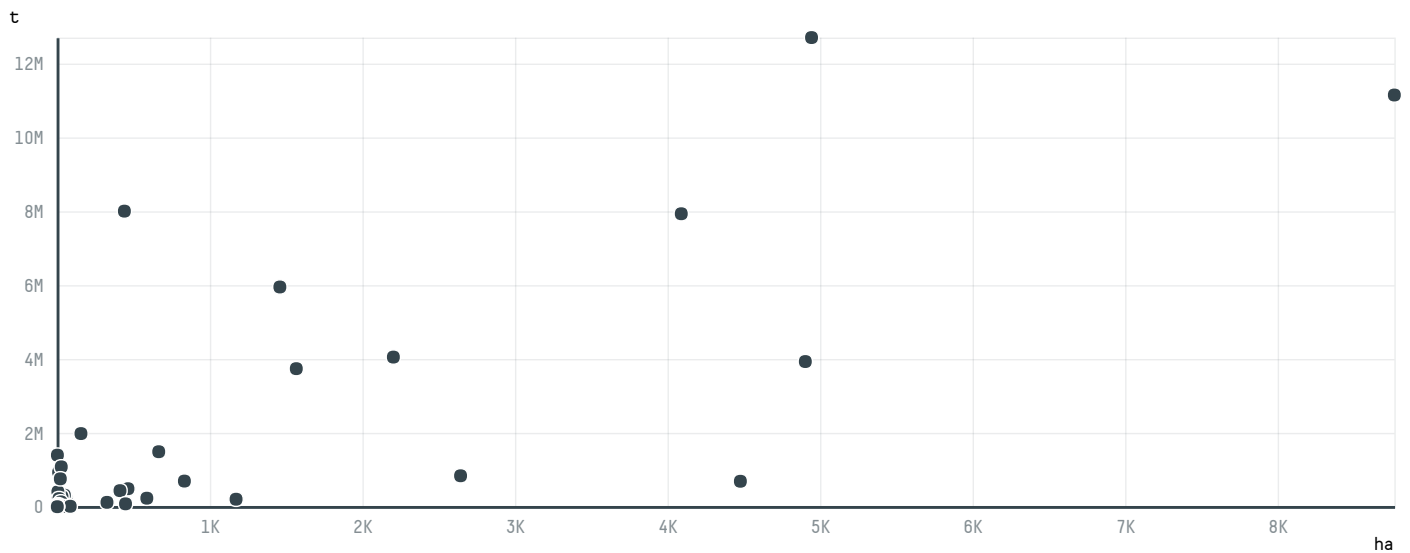
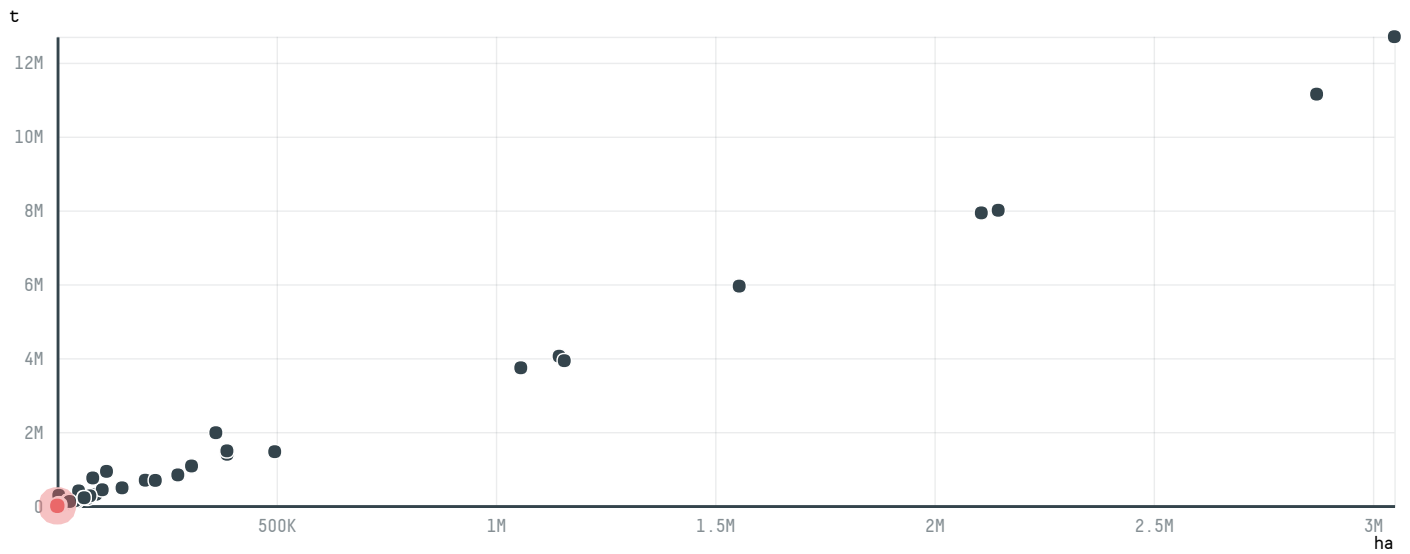

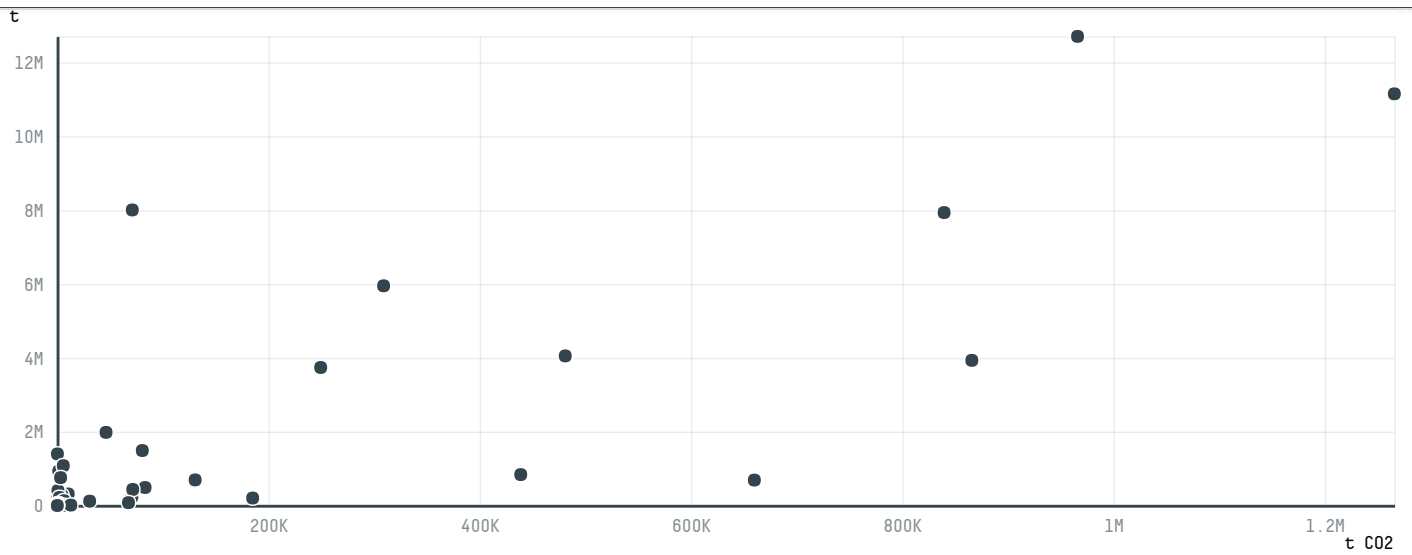
