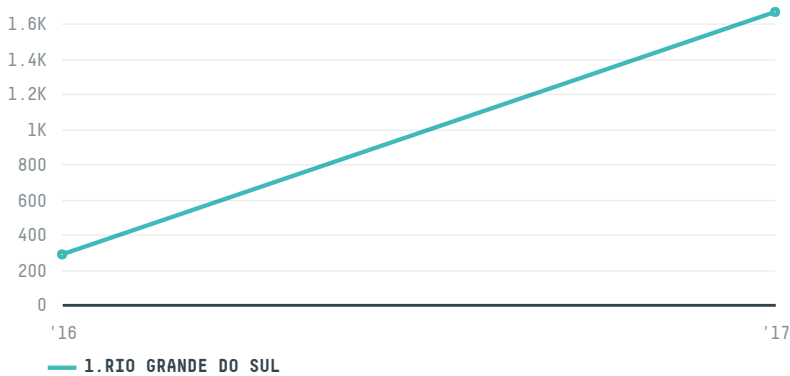
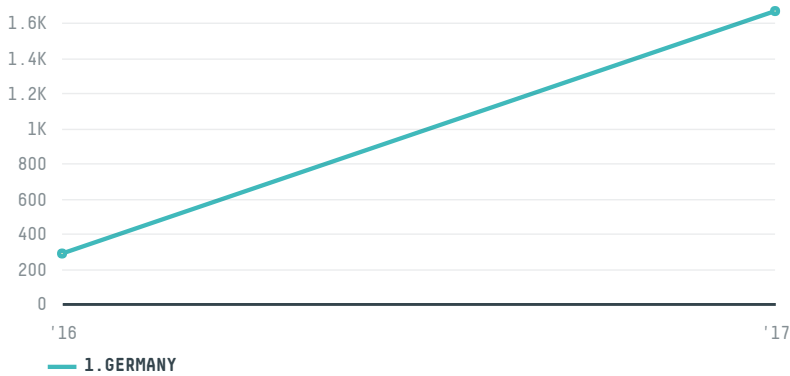


# GRAIN AG SWISS

The main destination of the soy imported by GRAIN AG SWISS is GERMANY, accounting for 100% of the total.

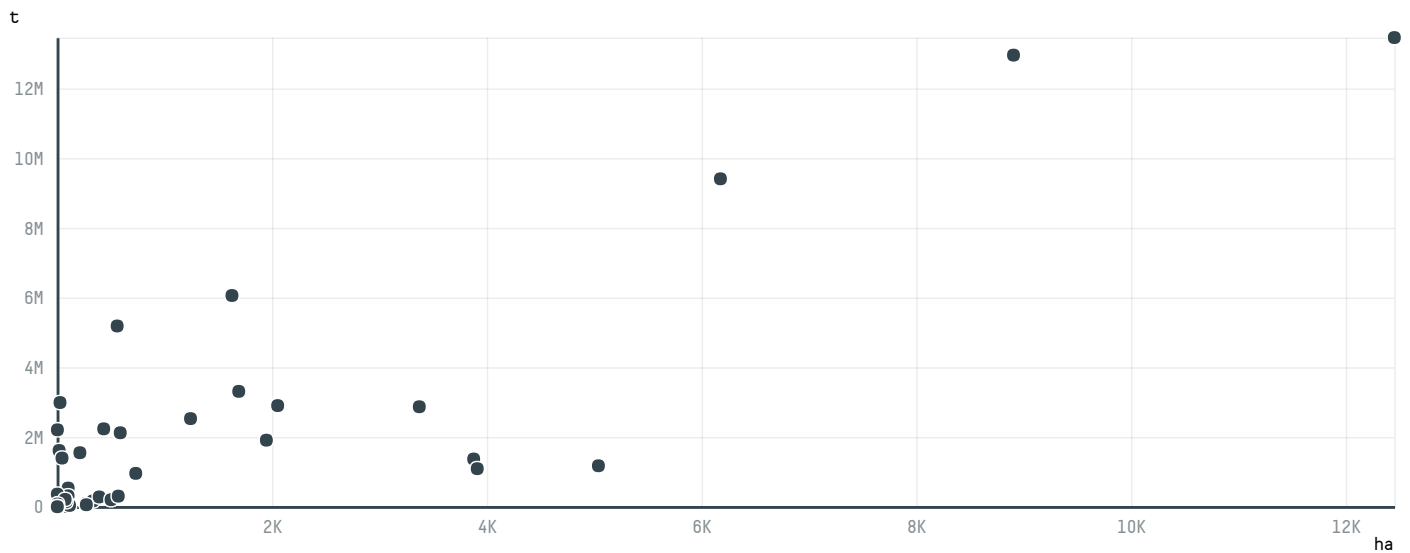
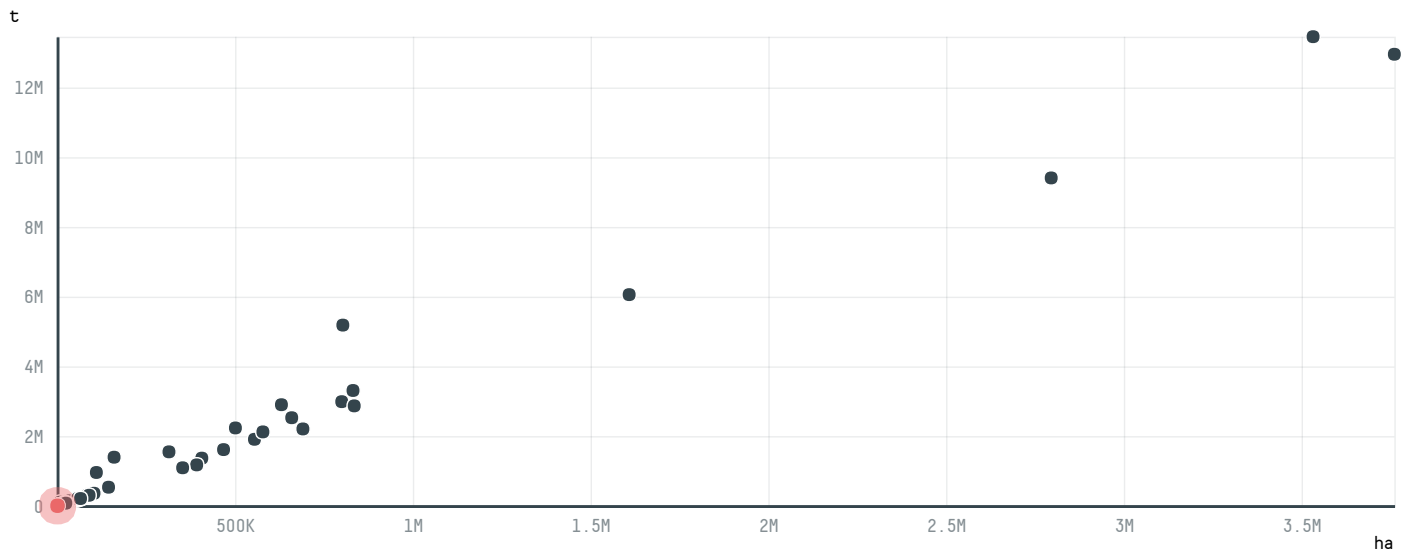

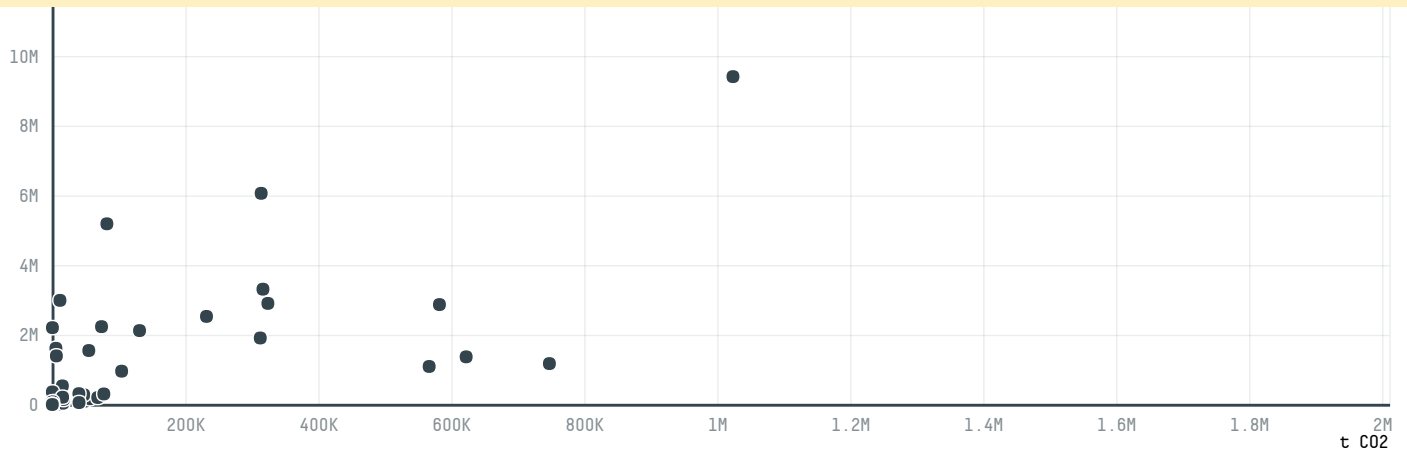
