

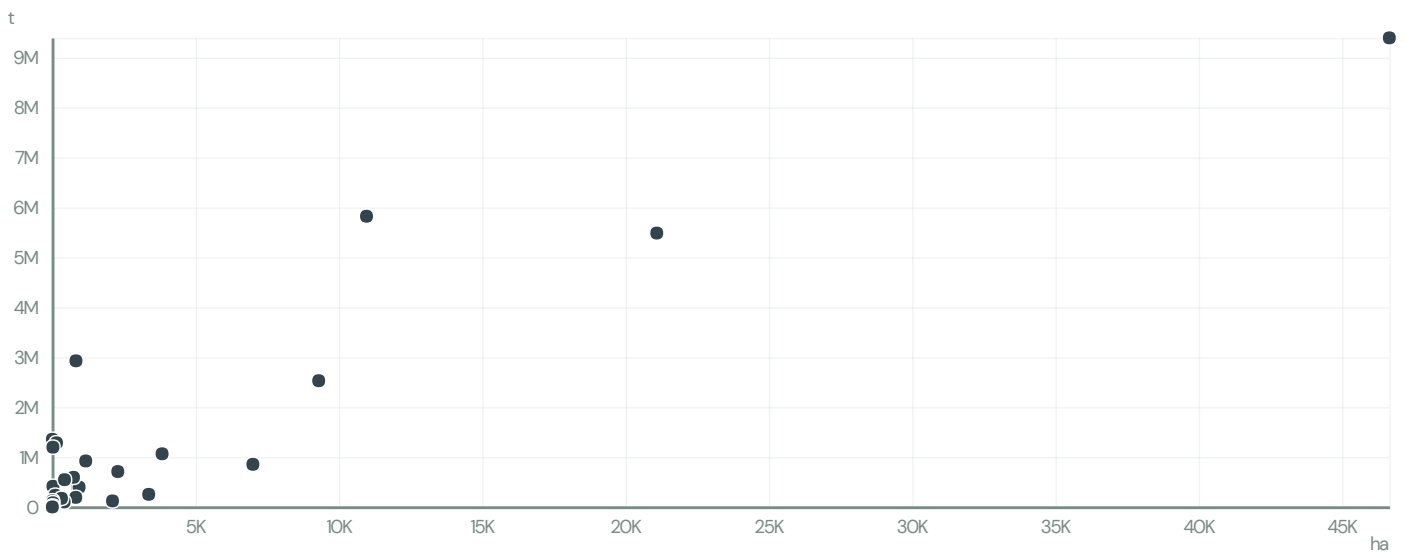
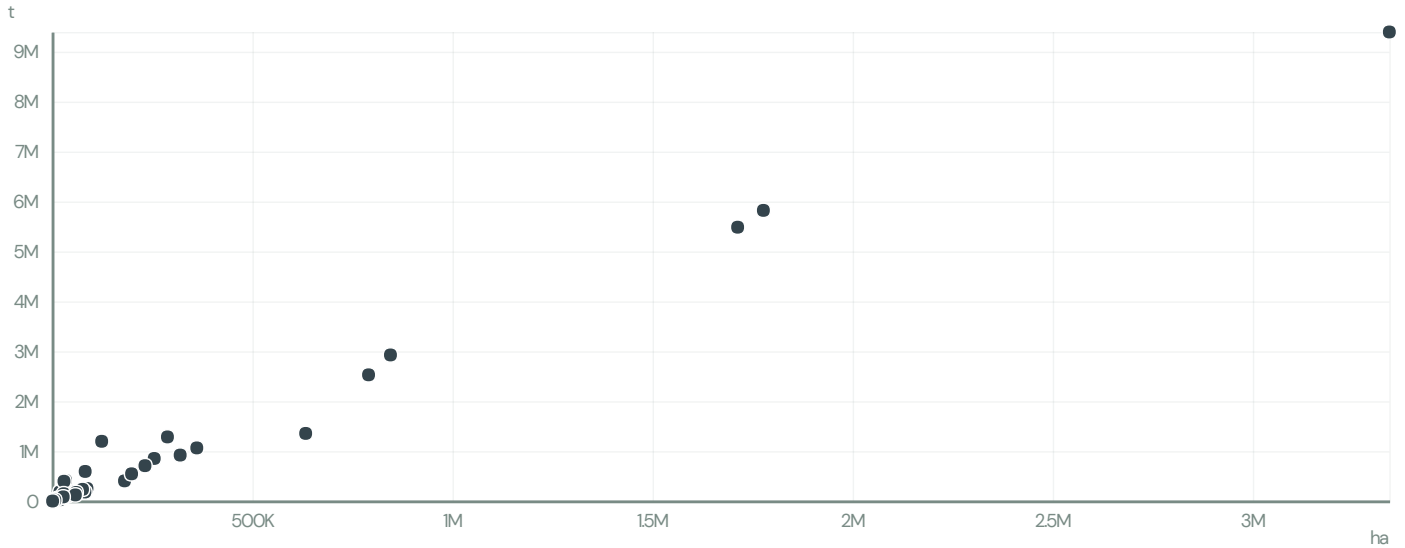

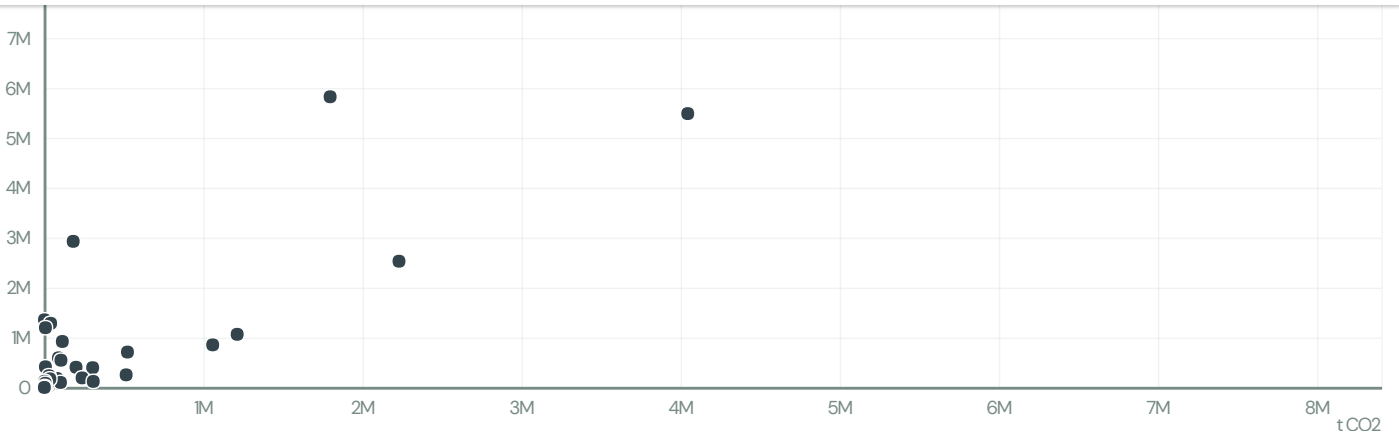

Comparing companies importing SOY from Brazil in 2008

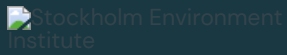
