

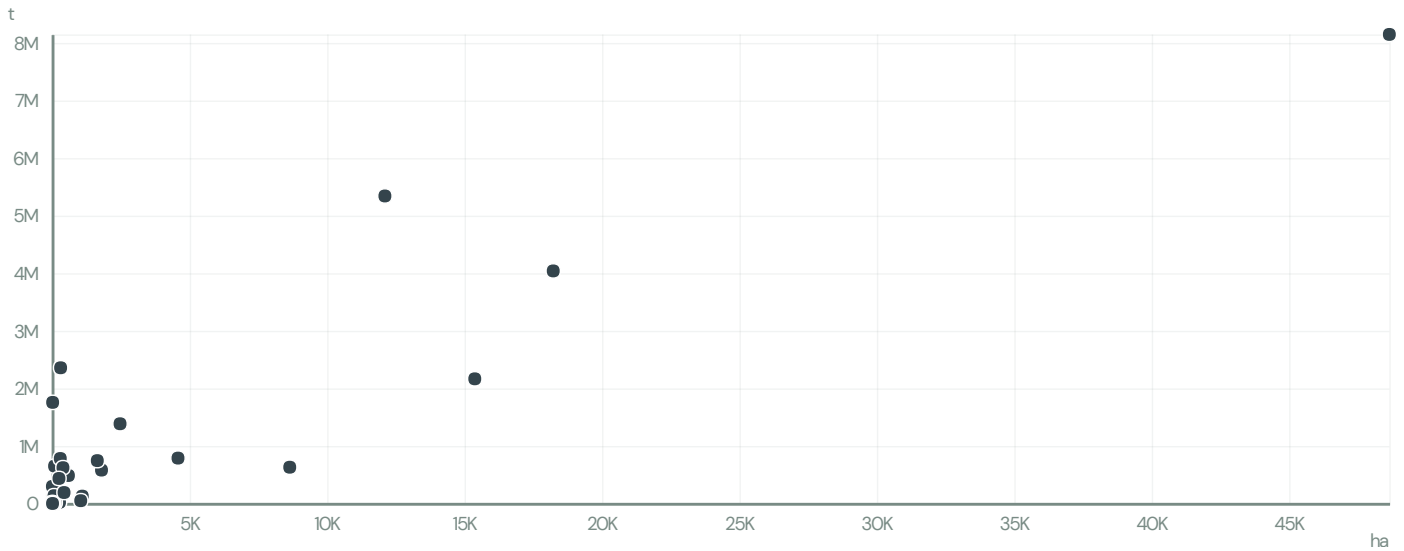
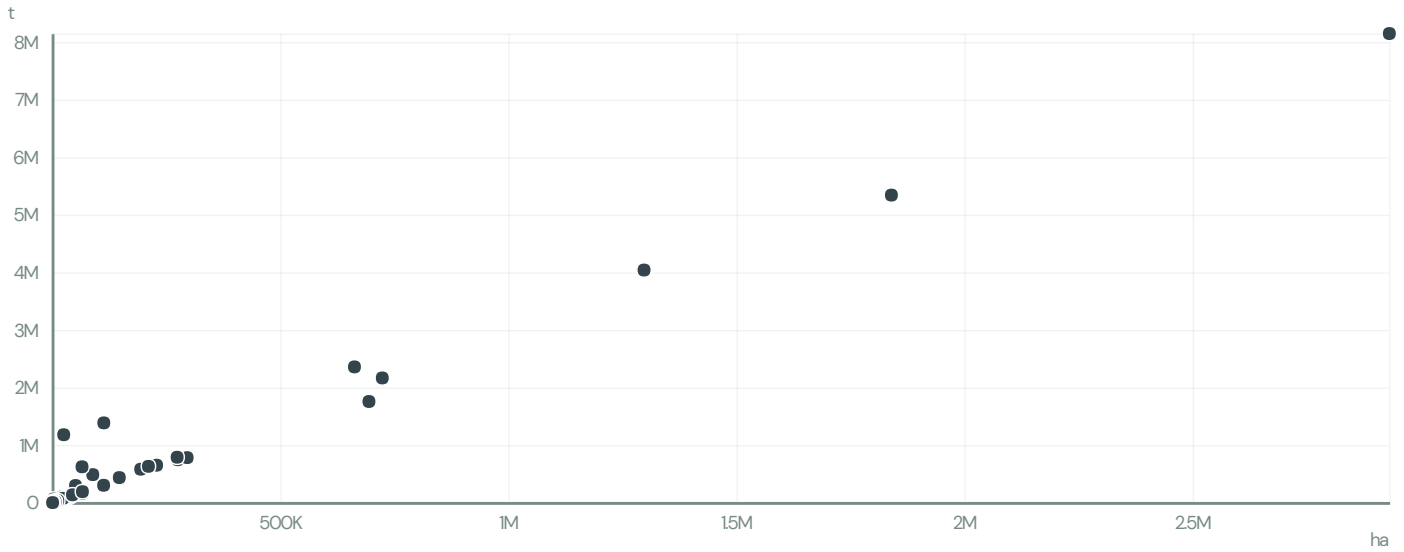

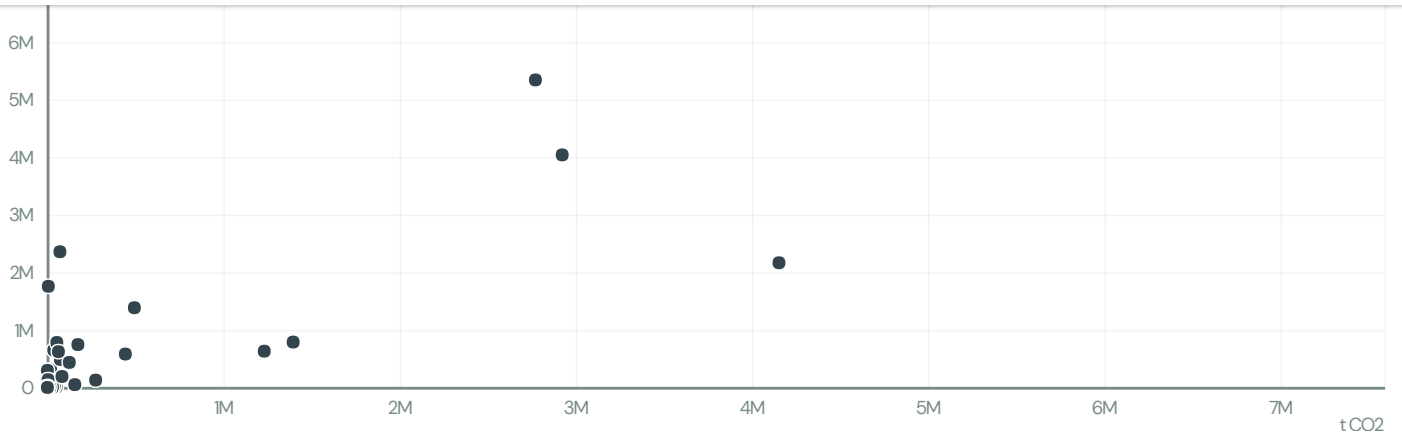

Comparing companies exporting SOY from Brazil in 2007

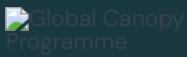
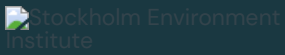
