



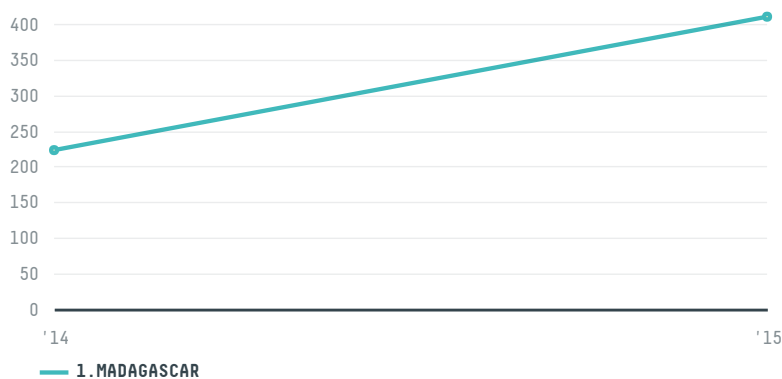

As an importer, BRASIL AGRI COMMODITIES - IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO EIRELI - E sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy imported by BRASIL AGRI COMMODITIES - IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO EIRELI - E is MADAGASCAR, accounting for 100% of the total.

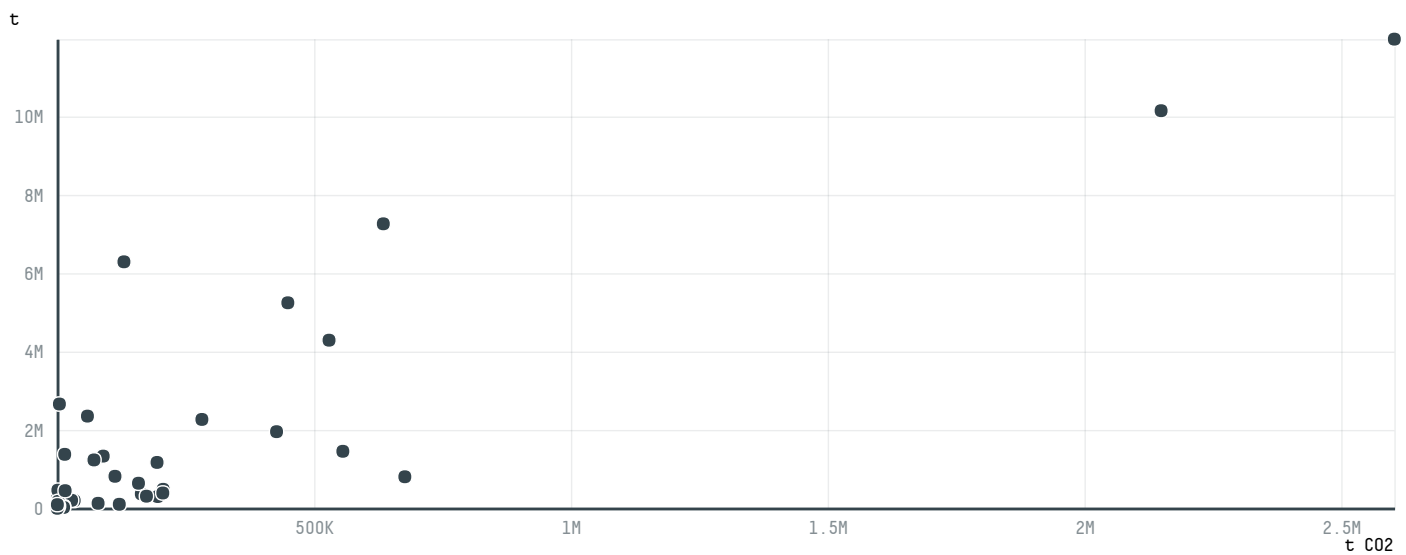
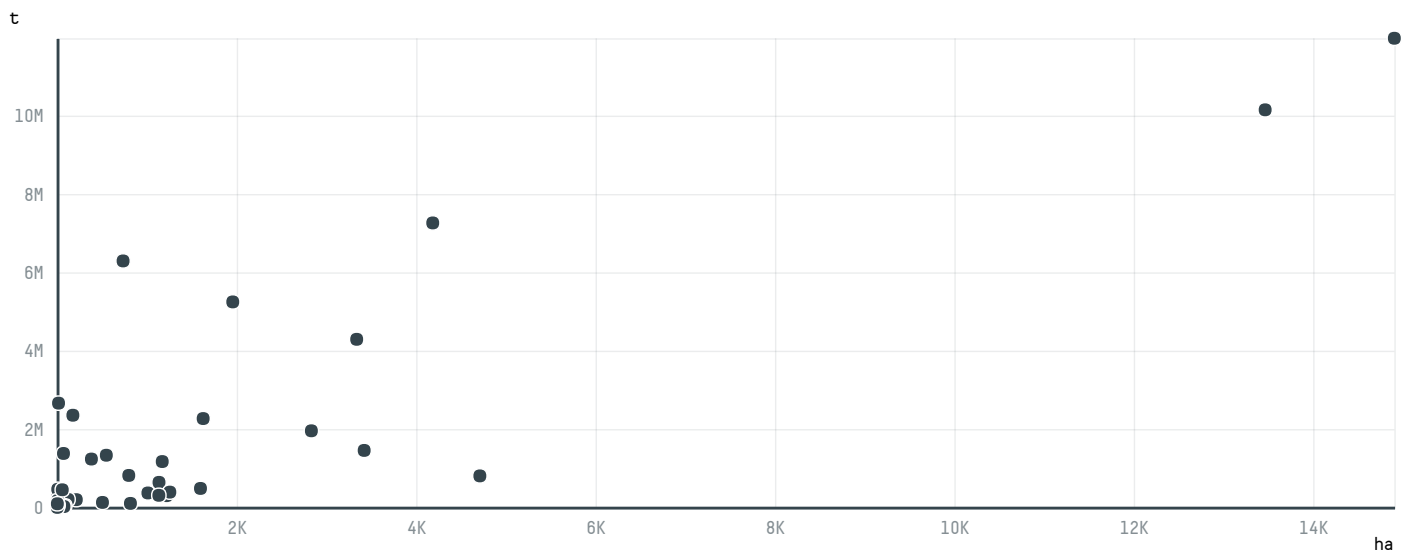
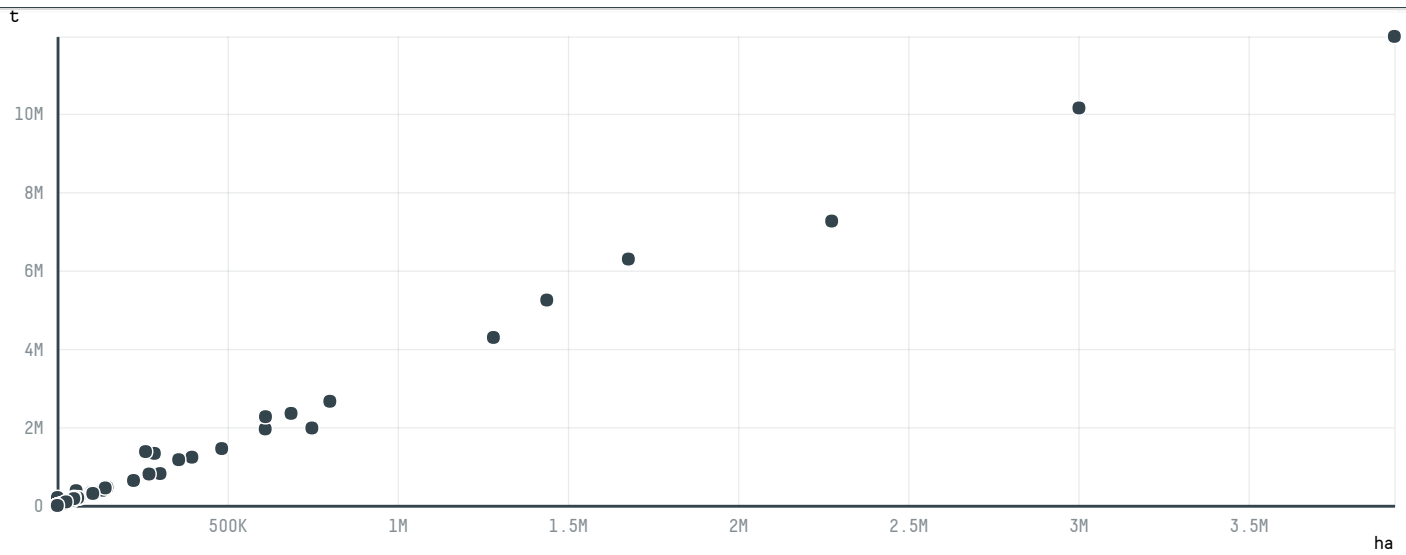
