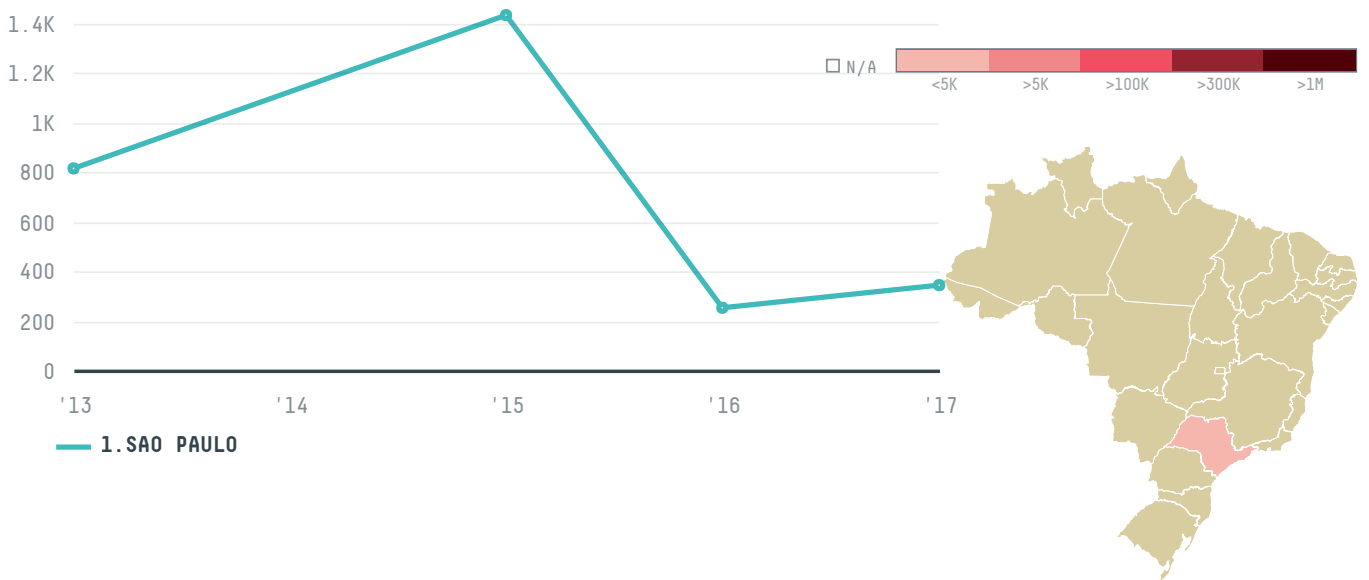
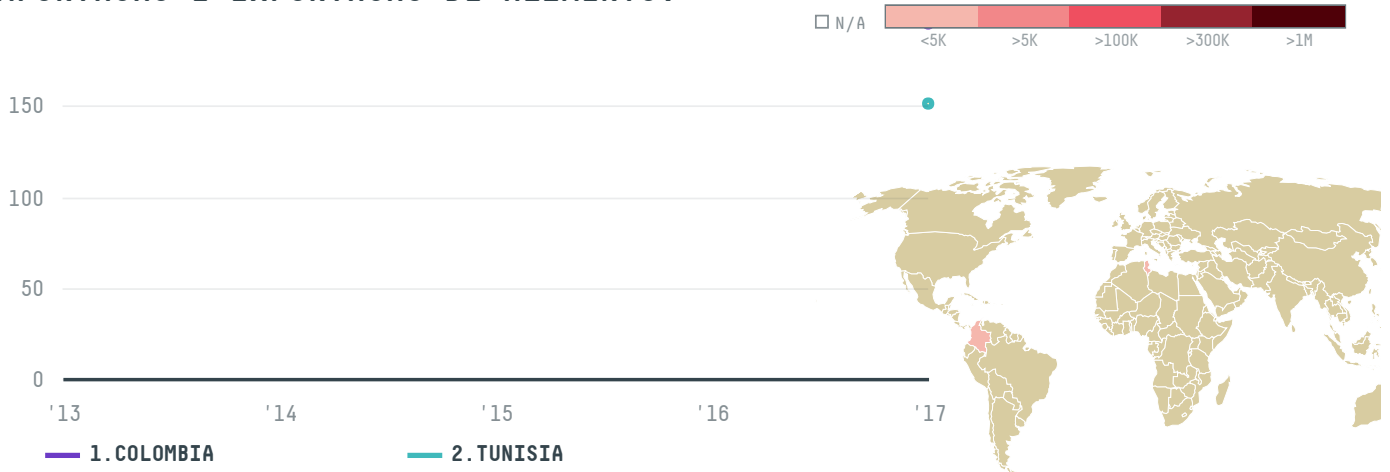

The main destination of the soy exported by DELTA INDUSTRIA COMERCIO IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO DE ALIMENTO is COLOMBIA, accounting for 56% of the total.
