



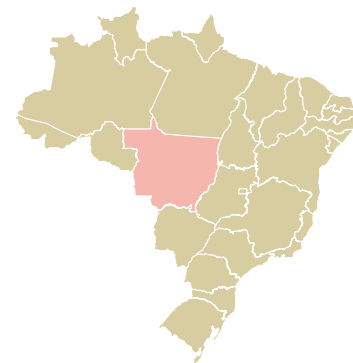
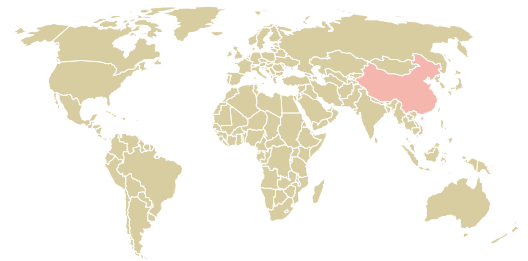
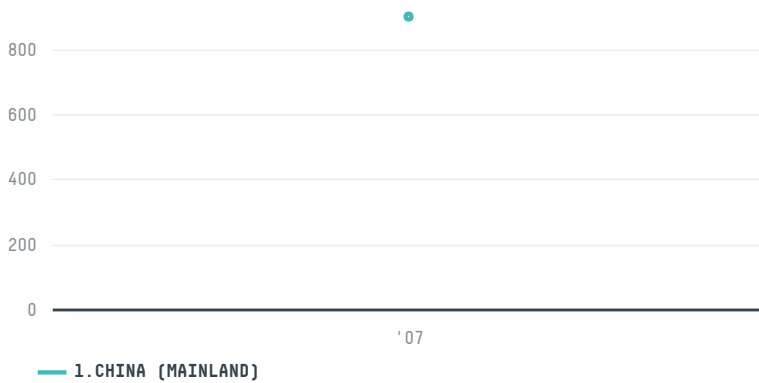

As an exporter, OLIVO MARTINAZZO sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by OLIVO MARTINAZZO is CHINA (MAINLAND), accounting for 100% of the total.

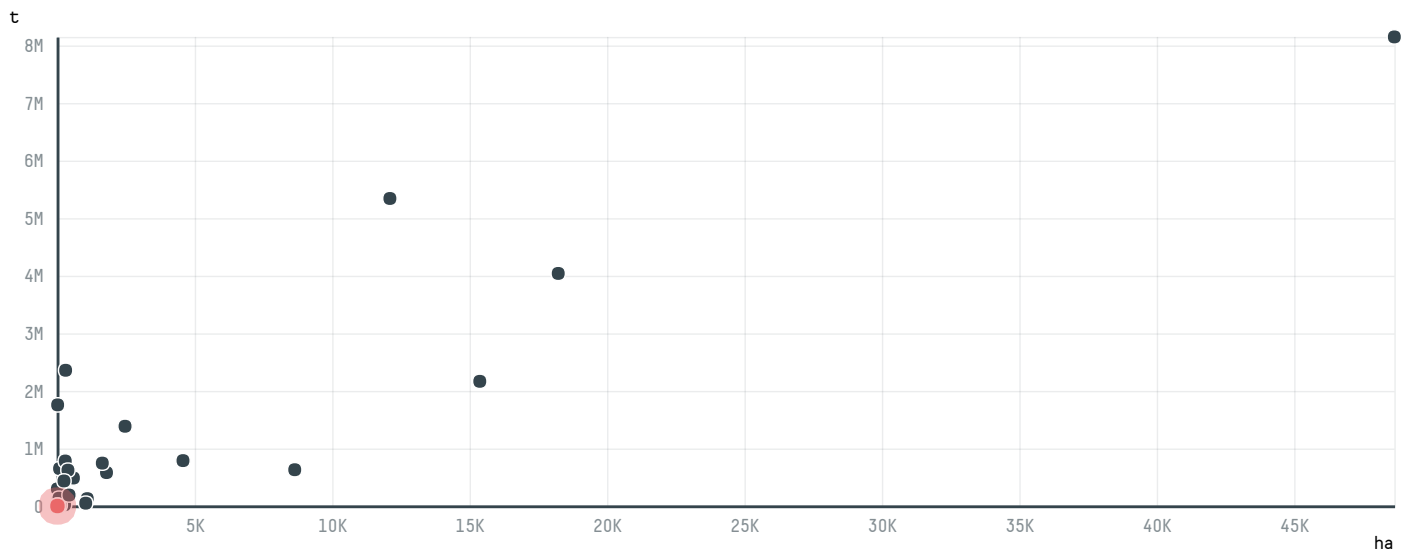
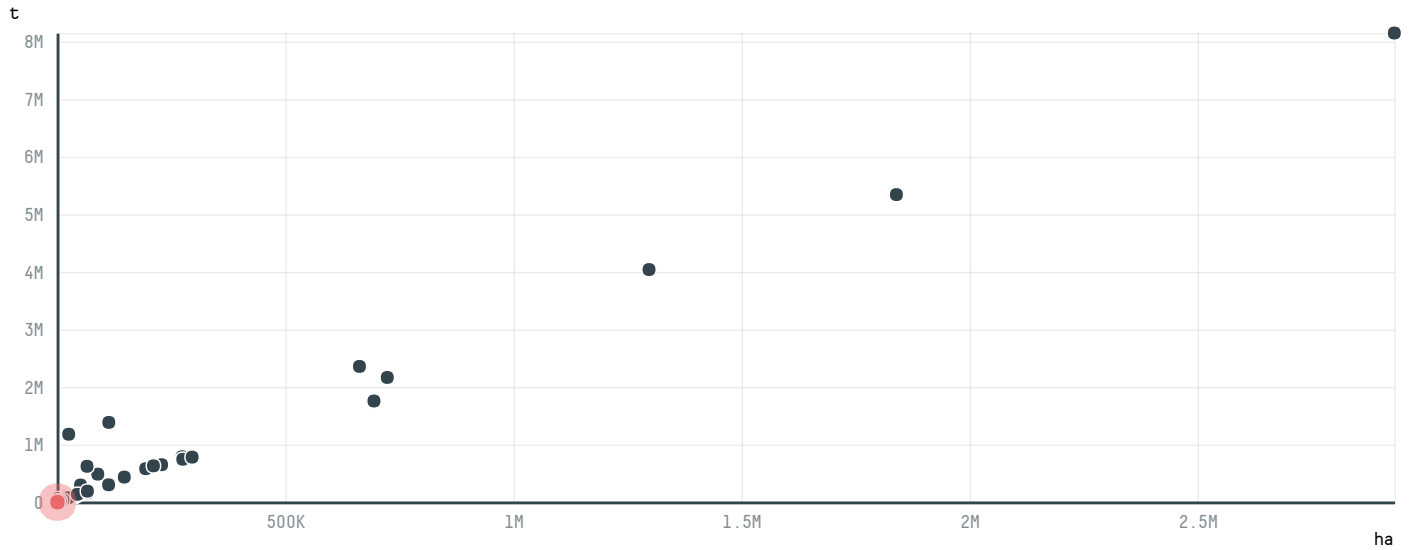

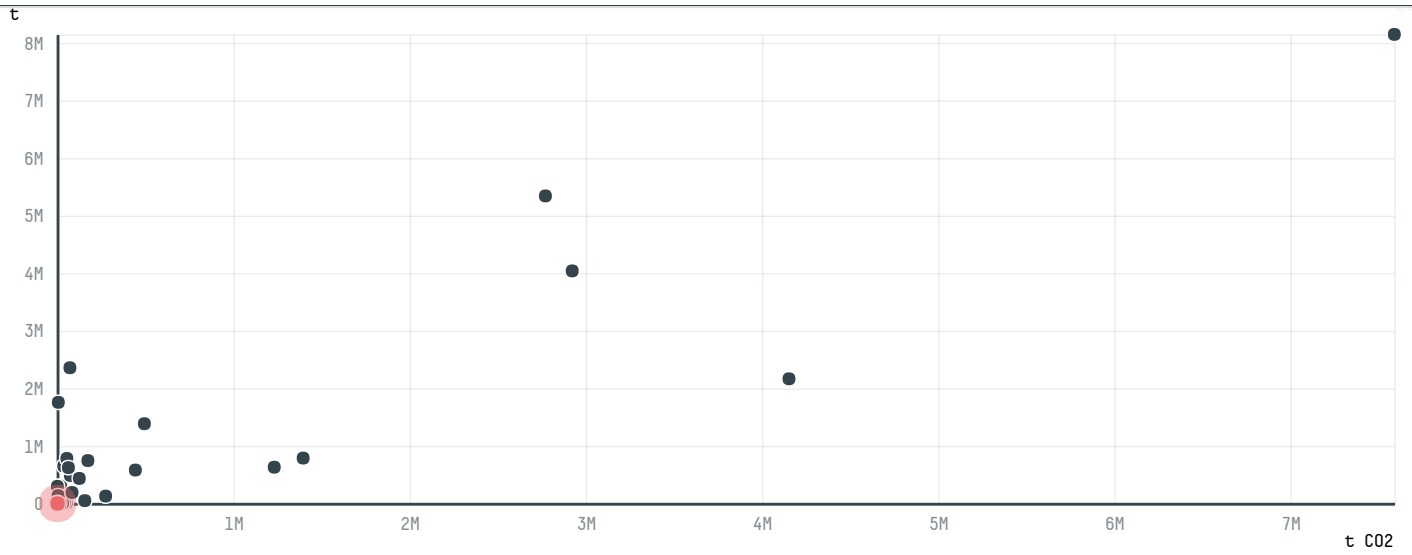
