

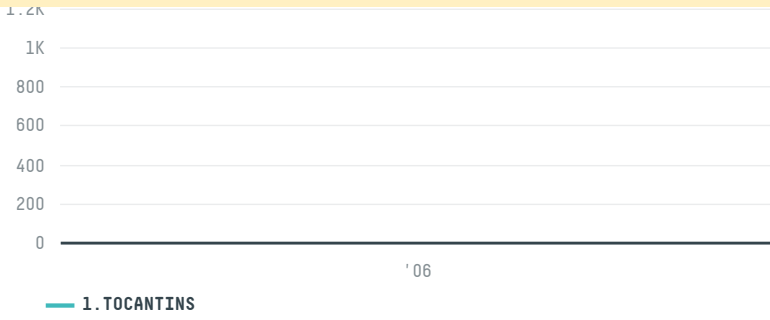
# ROBERTO RODRIGUES DA CUNHA FILHO
