OLFAR was the 87th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 26 thousand tons. This is a 57% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, OLFAR sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by OLFAR is SLOVENIA, accounting for 77% of the total.

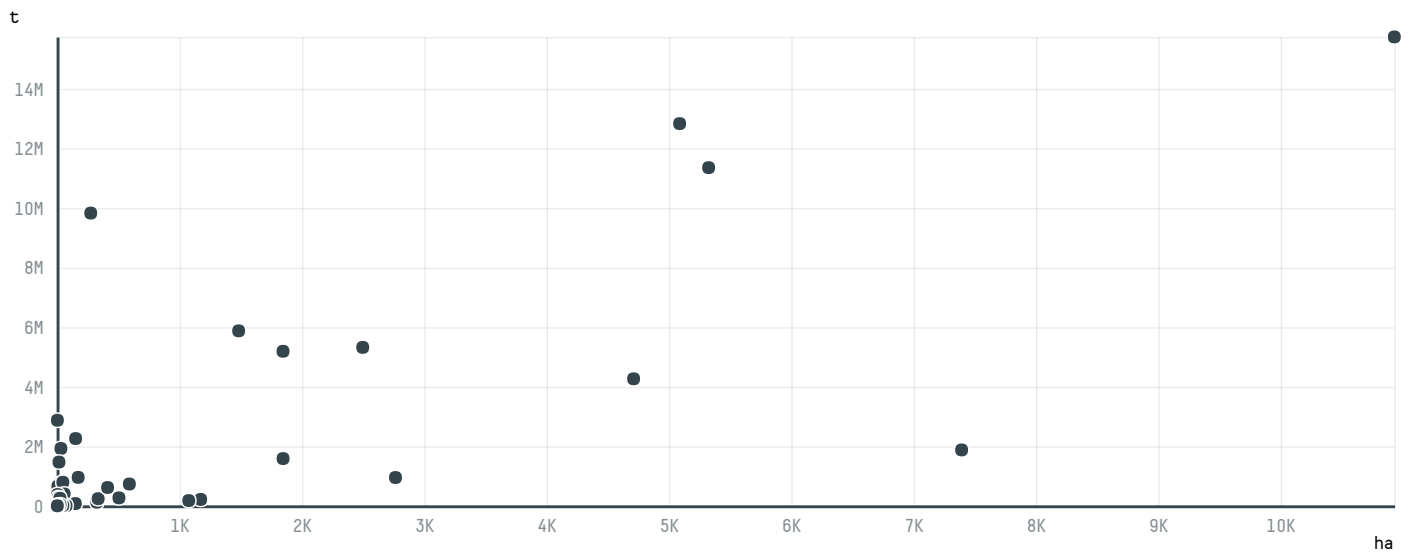
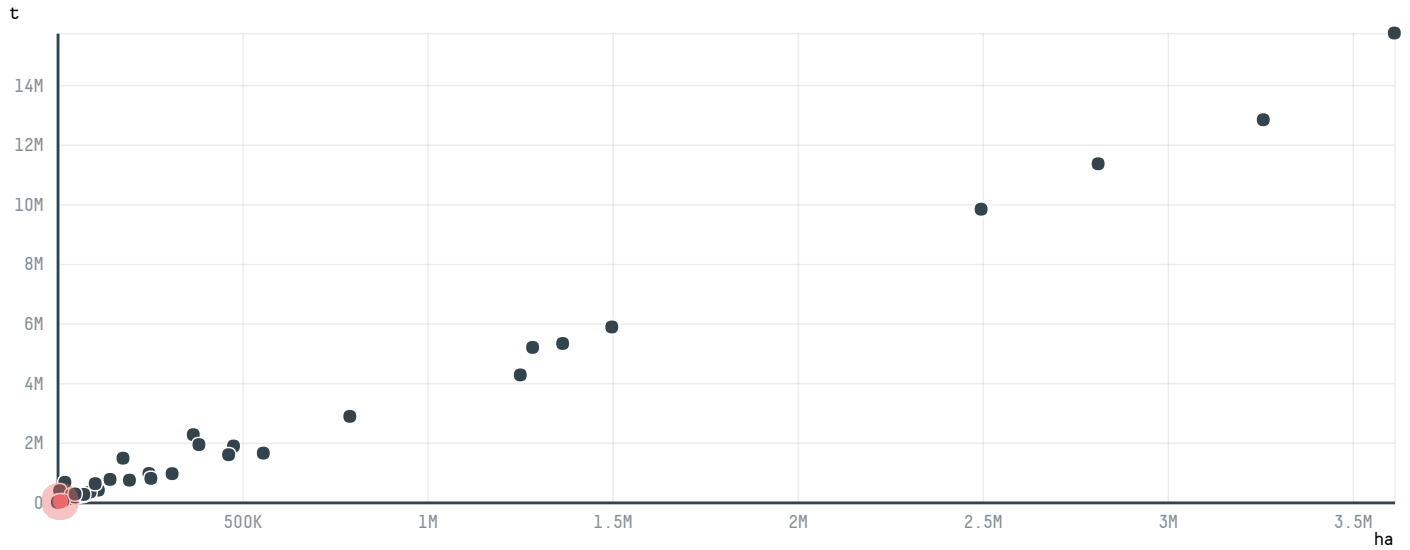

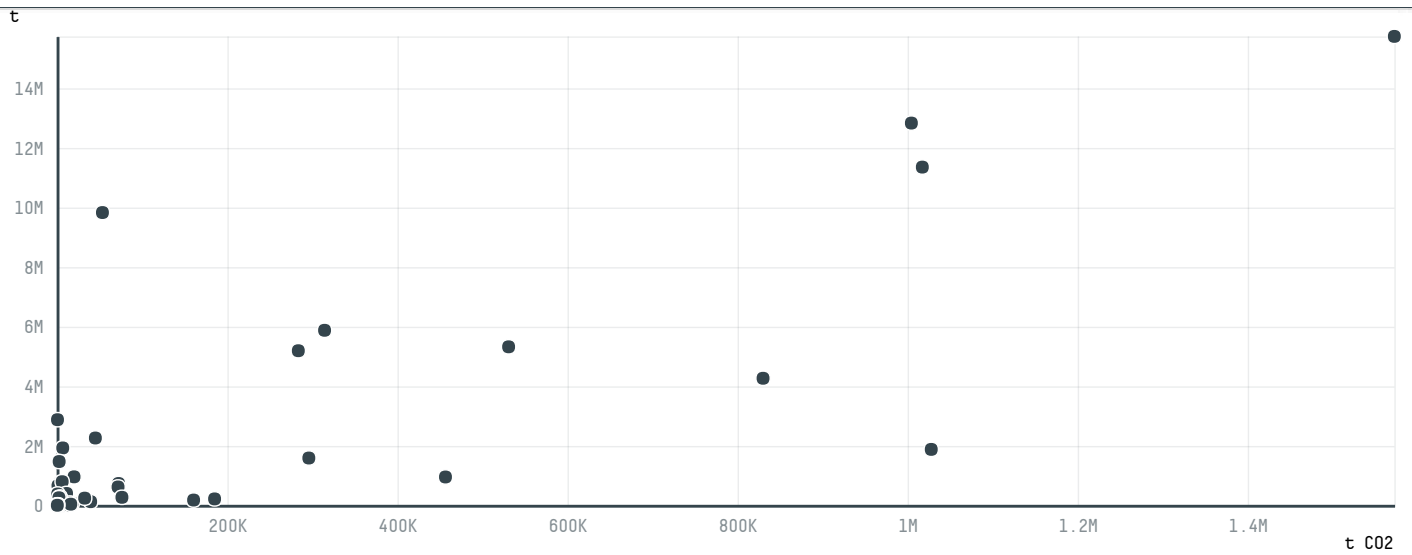
