



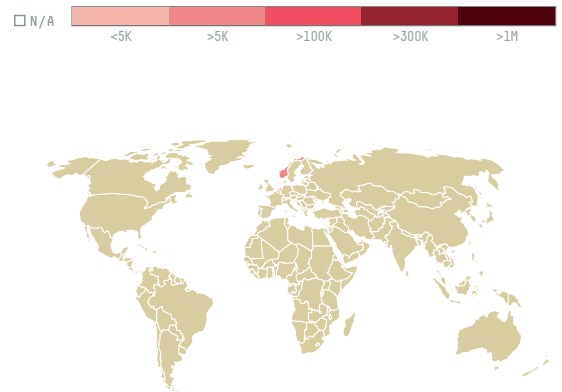
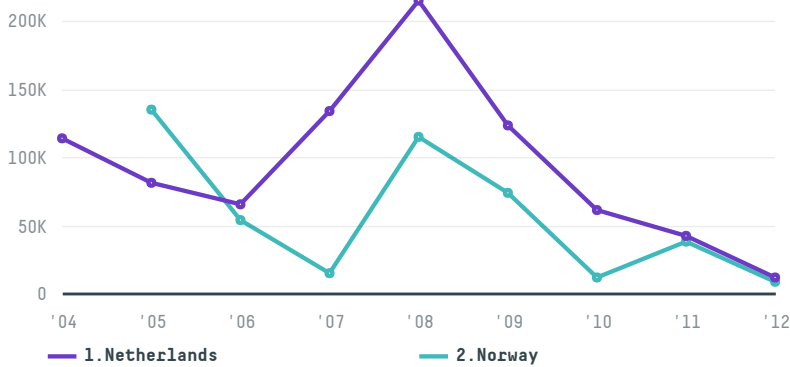

IMCOPA was the 88th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2012, accounting for 21 thousand tons. This is a 78% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, IMCOPA sources from 3 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by IMCOPA is Netherlands, accounting for 57% of the total.

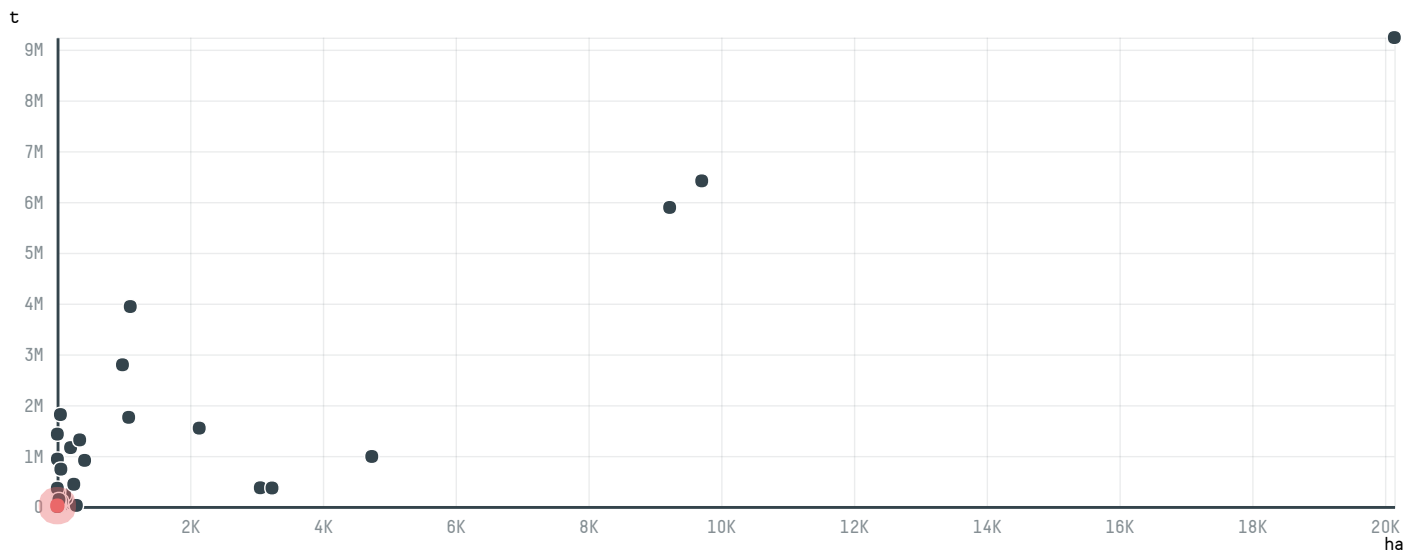
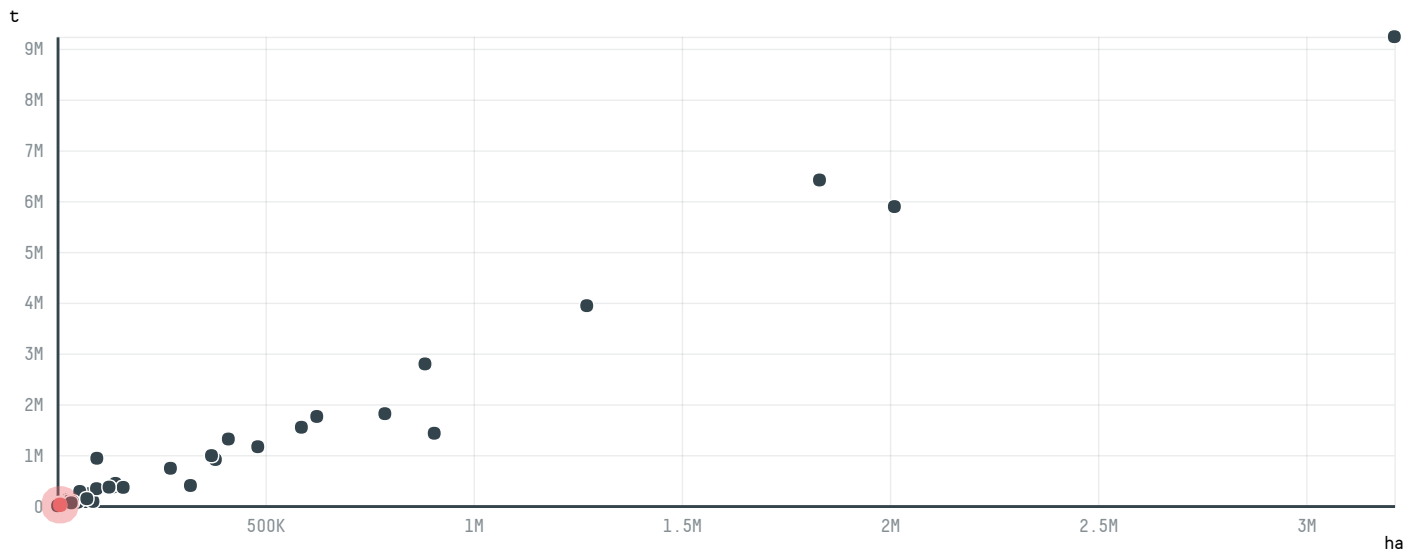

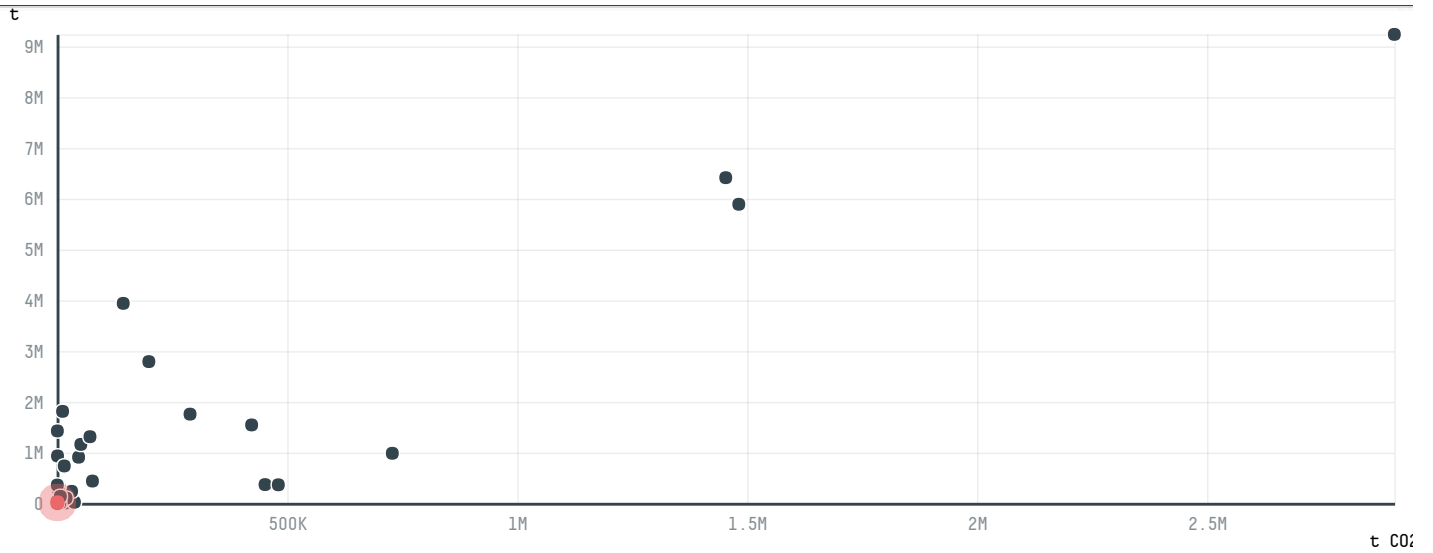
