AGRICOLA XINGU was the 137th largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 13 thousand tons. This is a 62% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, AGRICOLA XINGU sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by AGRICOLA XINGU is CHINA (MAINLAND), accounting for 100% of the total.

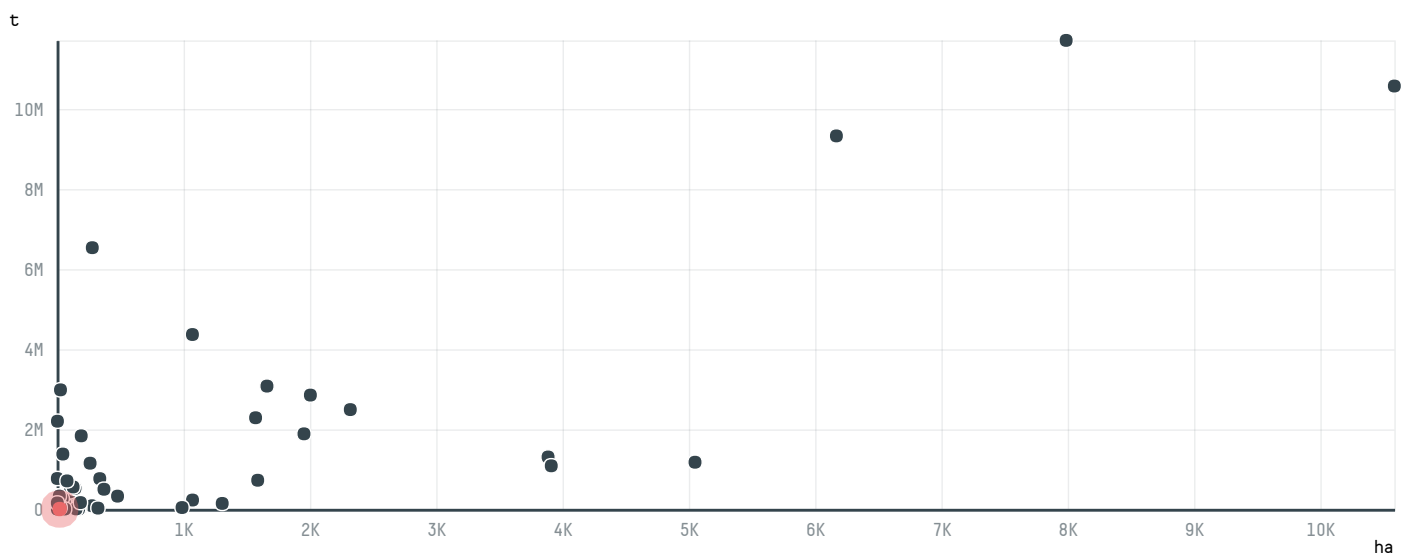
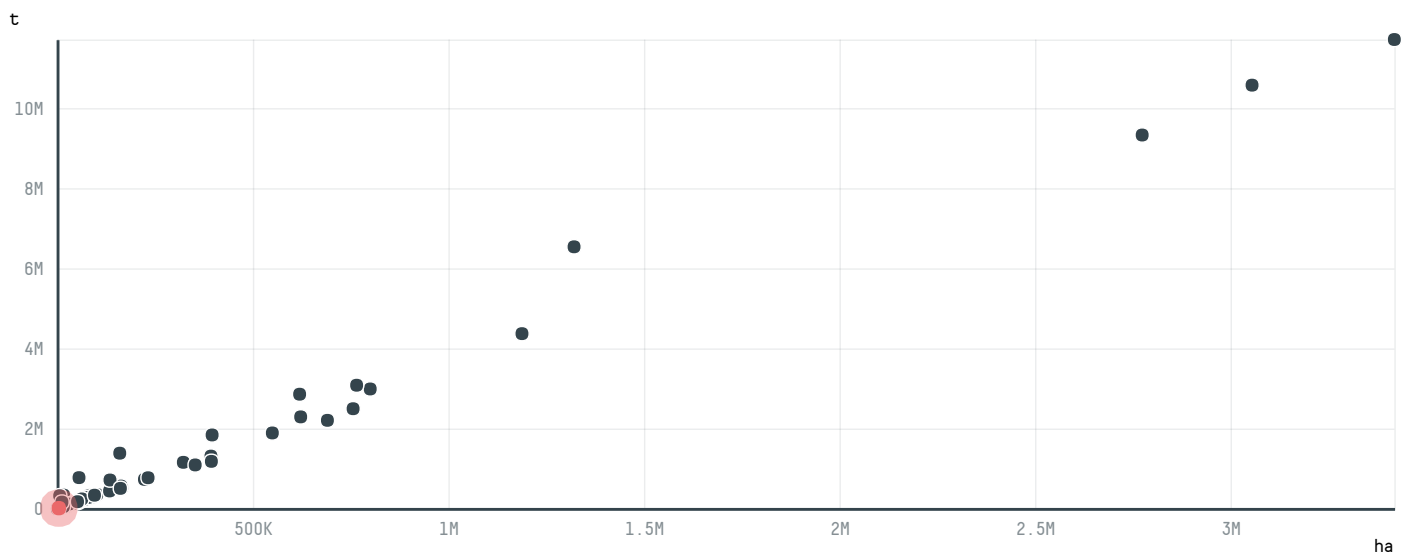
