OLEOPLAN was the 41st largest exporter of soy from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 174 thousand tons. This is a 31% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, OLEOPLAN sources from 3 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by OLEOPLAN is SLOVENIA, accounting for 53% of the total.

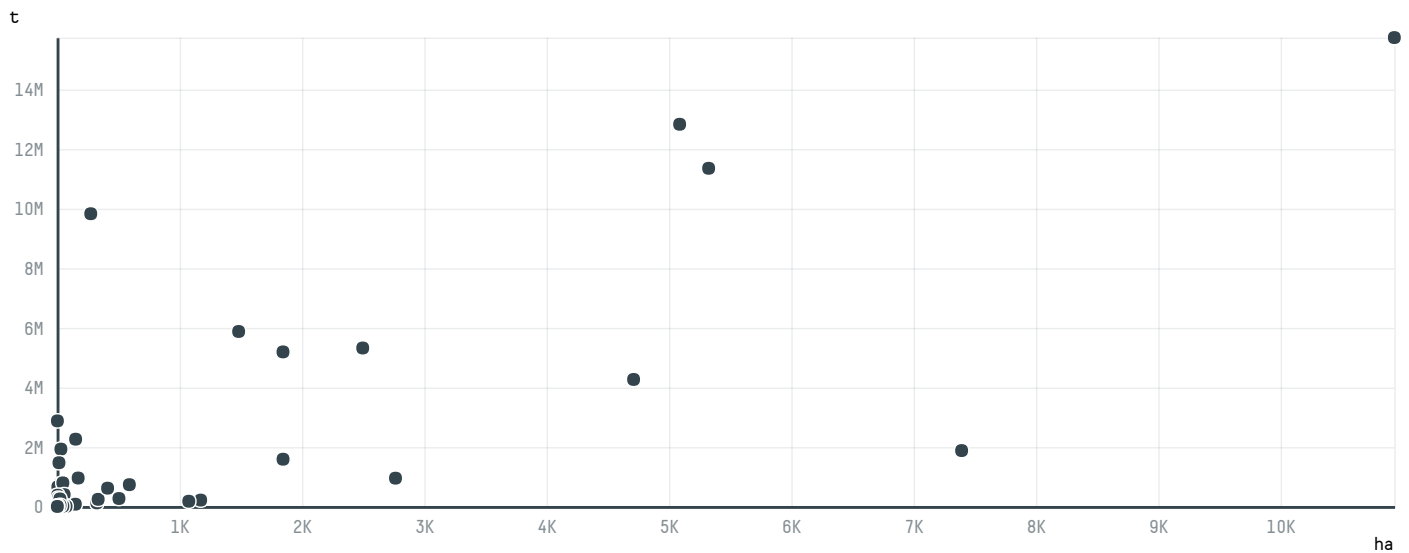
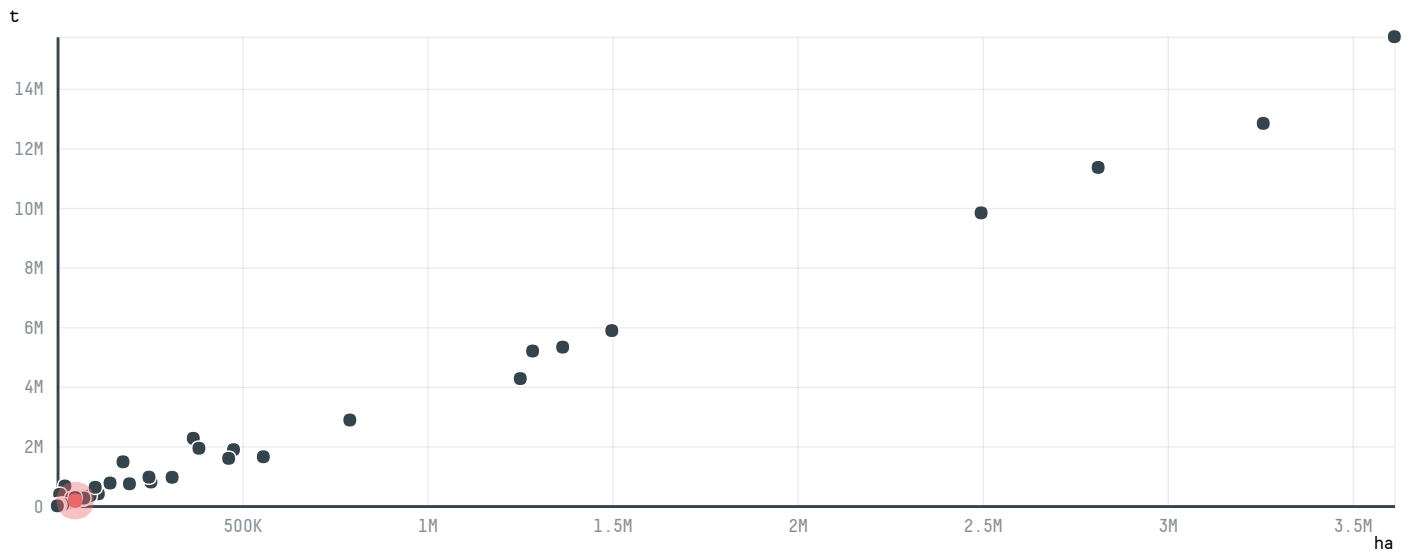

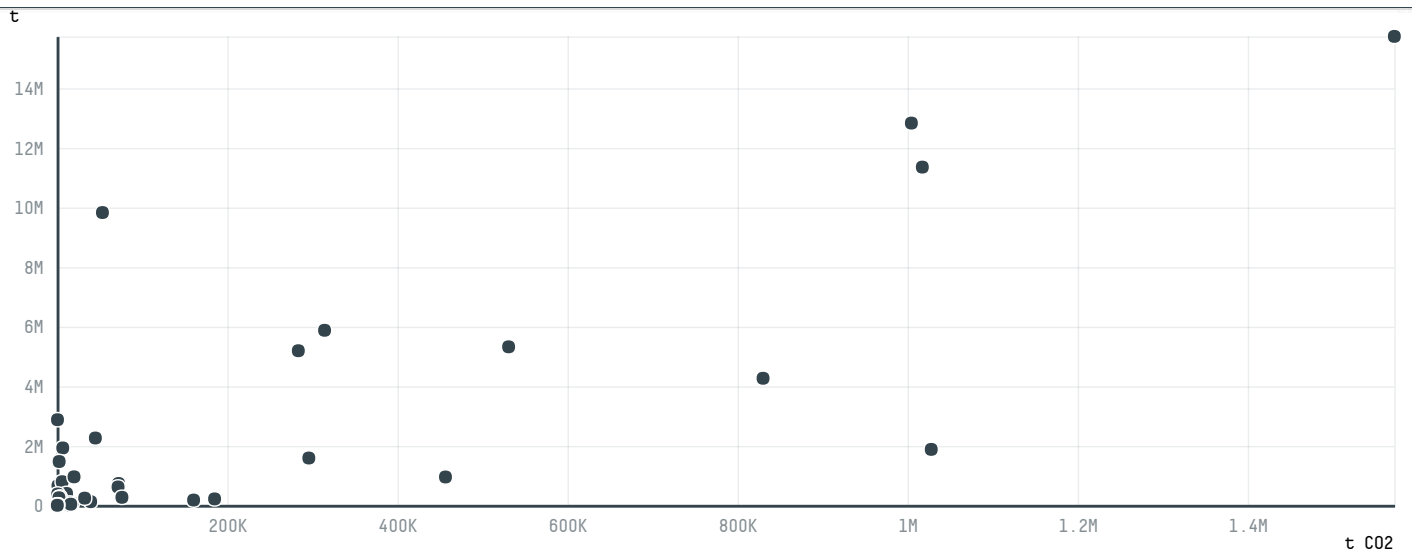
