As an exporter, CARLOS ALBERTO POLATO sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy exported by CARLOS ALBERTO POLATO is France, accounting for 80% of the total.

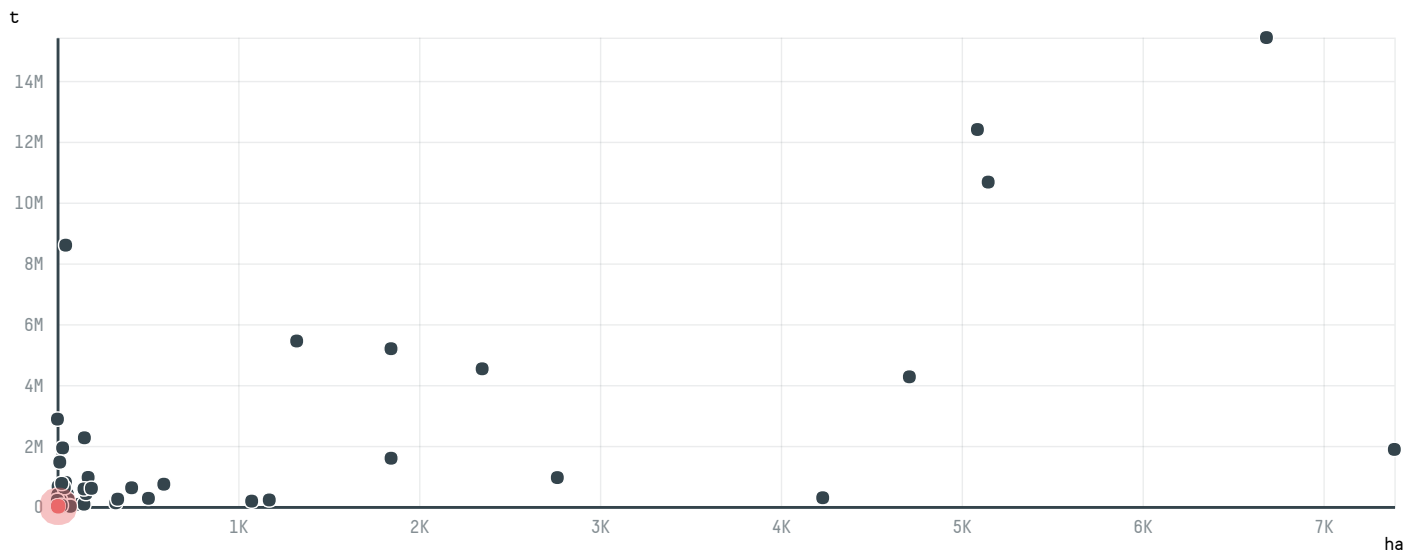
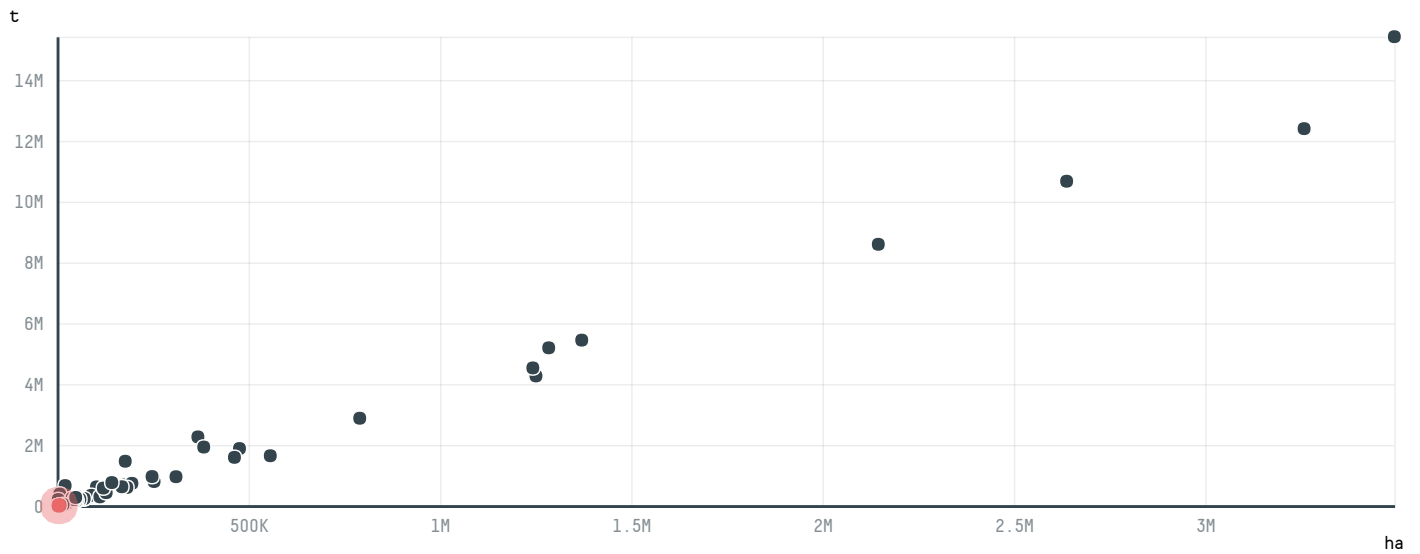
