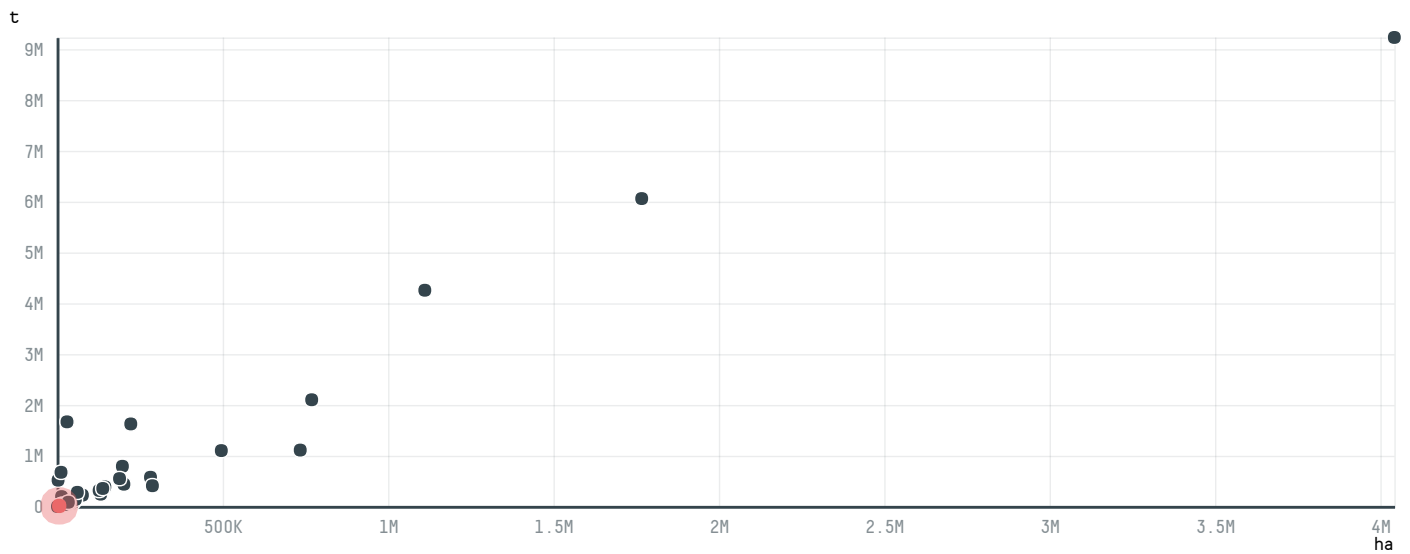

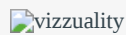
COMPARING COMPANIES IMPORTING SOY FROM BRAZIL IN 2004
