BUNGE URUGUAY was the 34th largest importer of soy from BRAZIL in 2009, accounting for 33 thousand tons. This is a 59% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, BUNGE URUGUAY sources from 243 municipalities, or 14% of the soy production municipalities. The main destination of the soy imported by BUNGE URUGUAY is NETHERLANDS, accounting for 27% of the total.

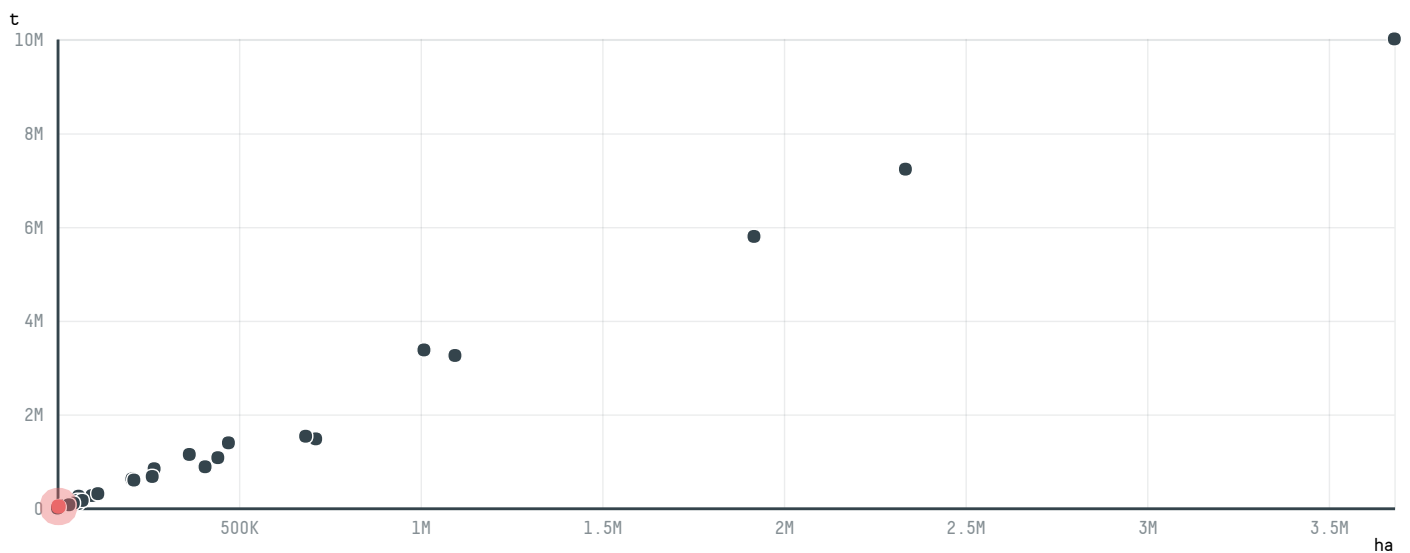
