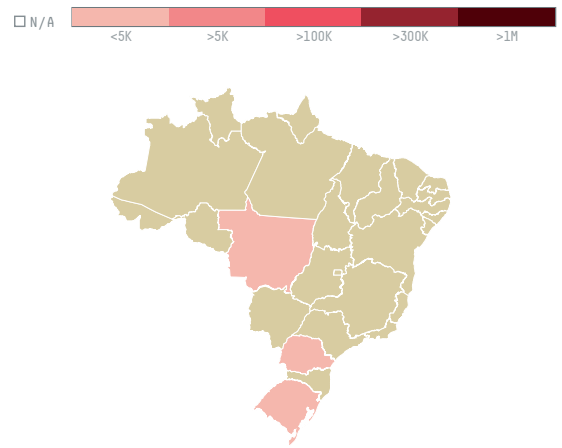
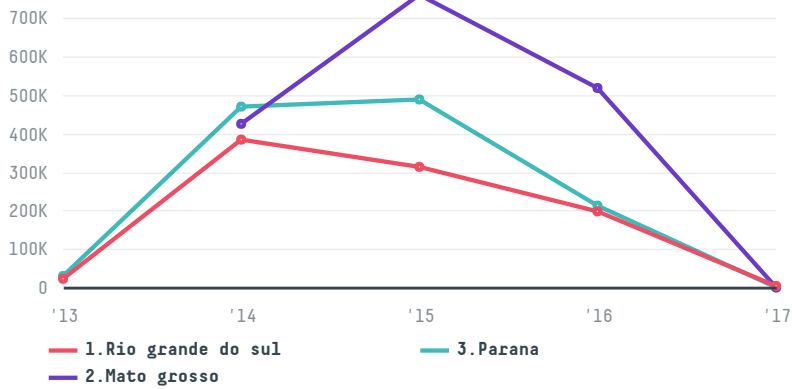
FOREST 500 SCORE

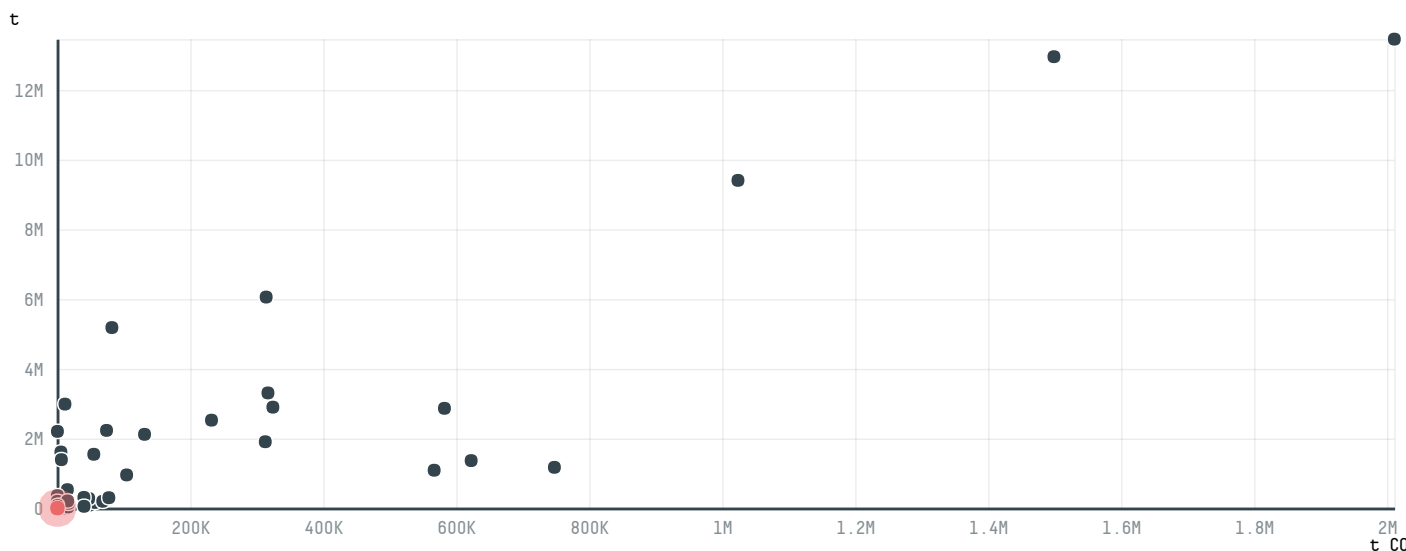
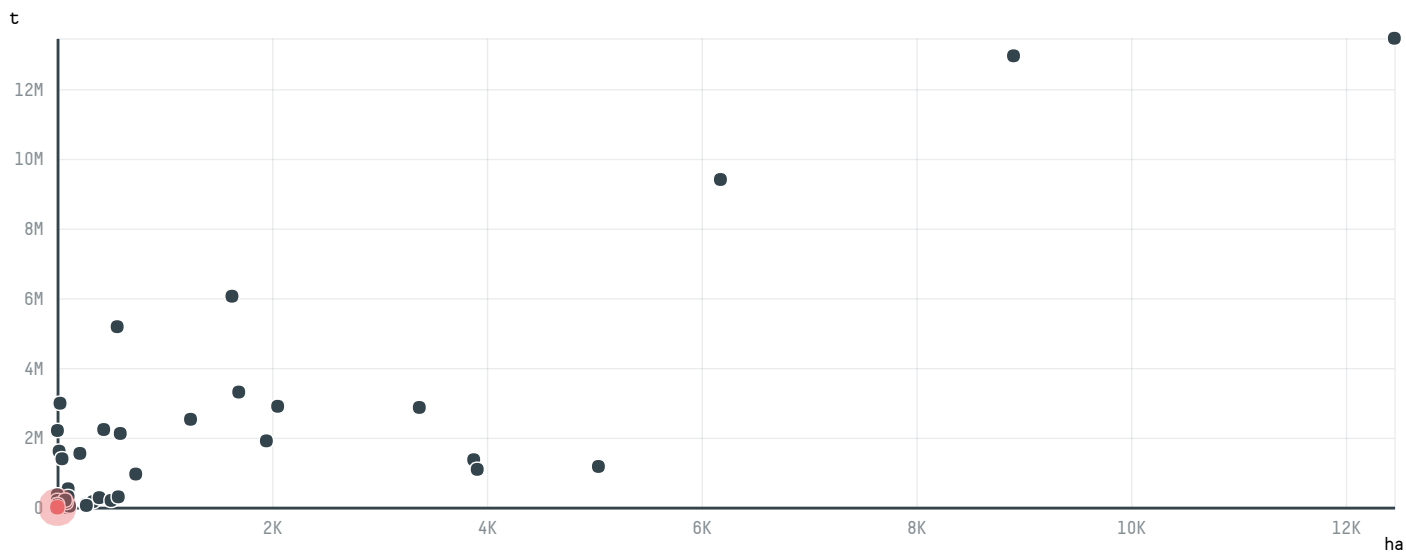
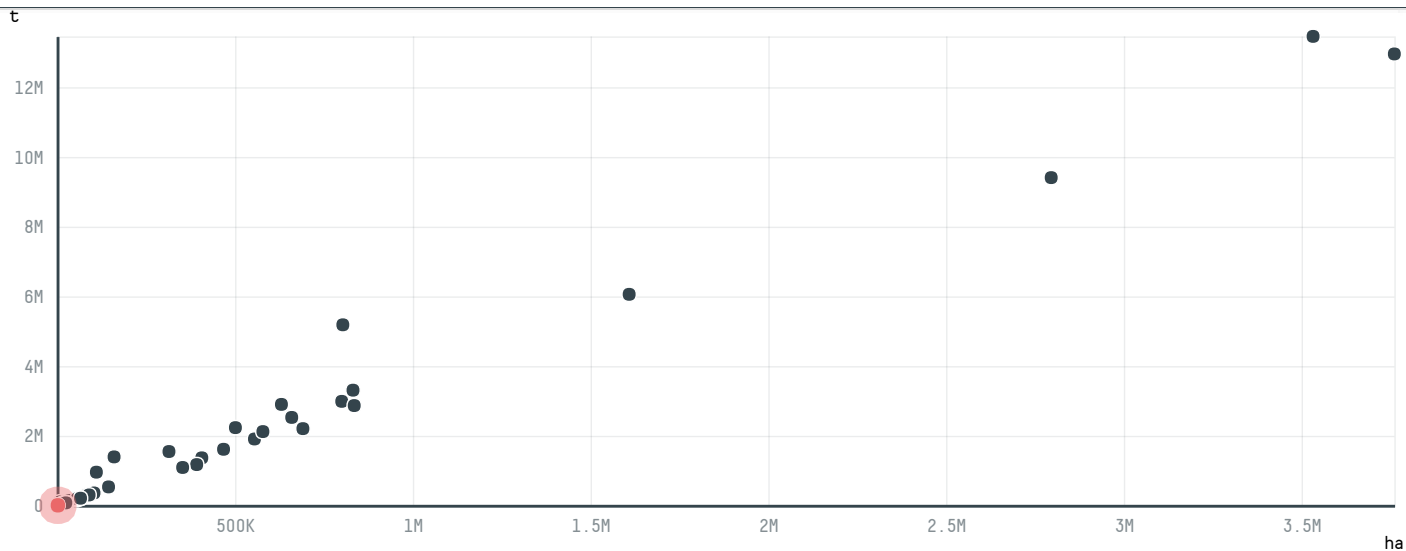
