



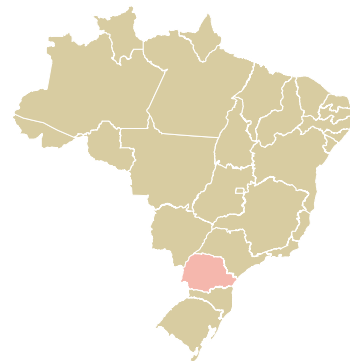
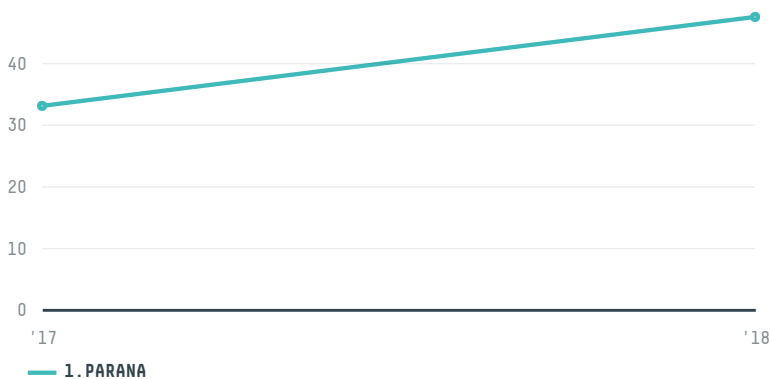
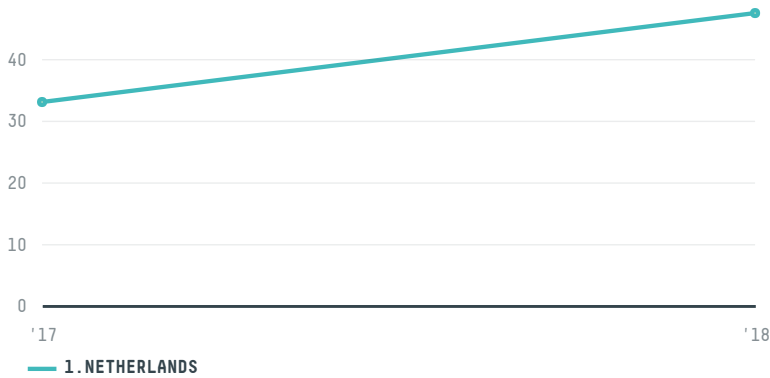

The main destination of the soy imported by CARGIL BV ZOR is NETHERLANDS, accounting for 100% of the total.

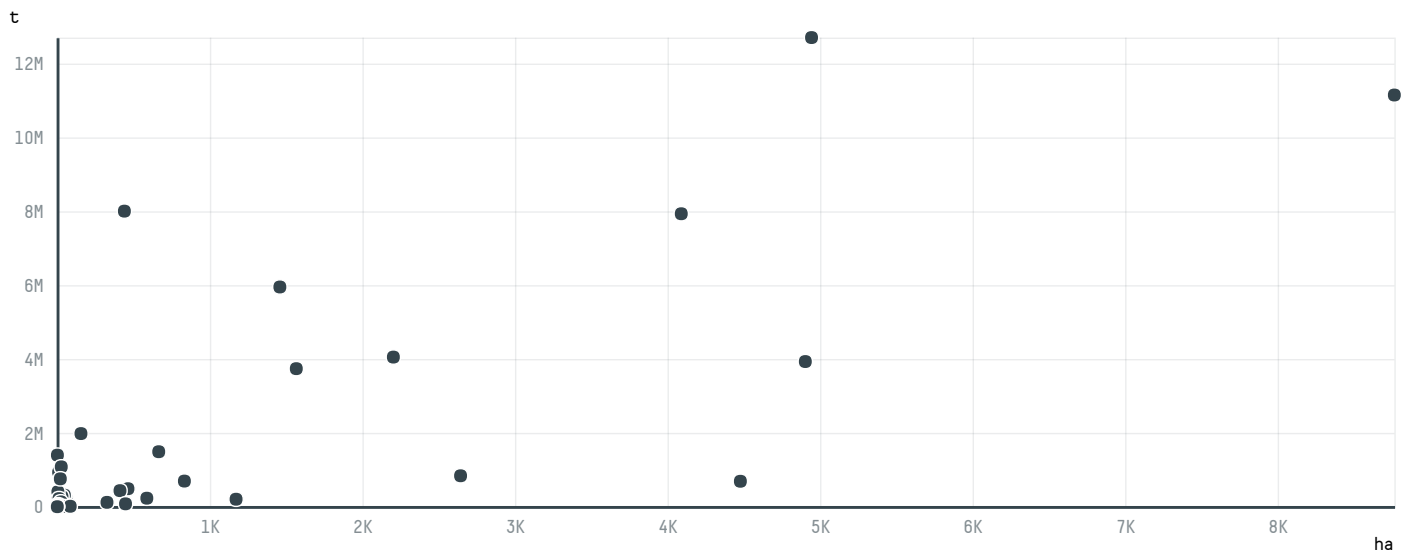
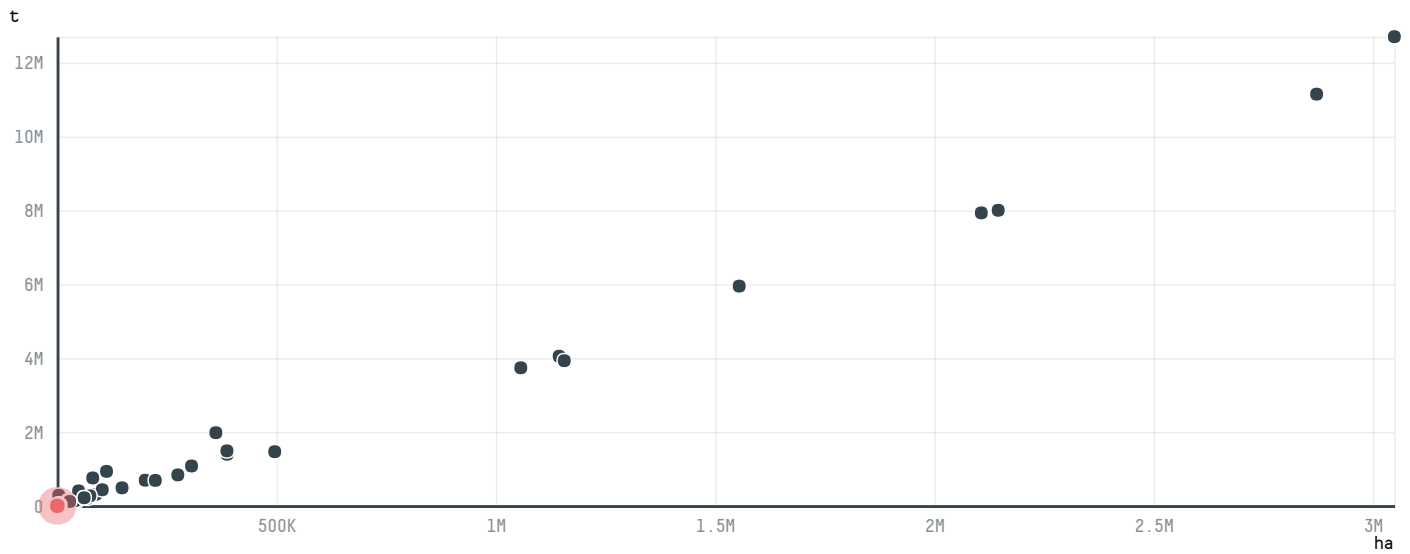

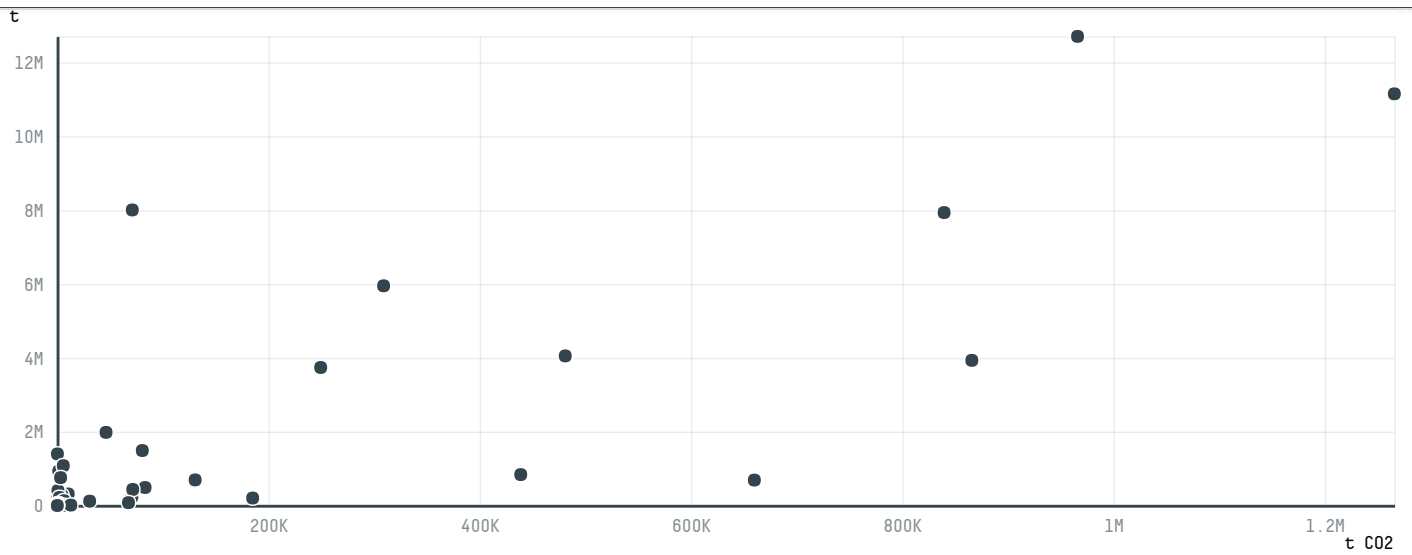
