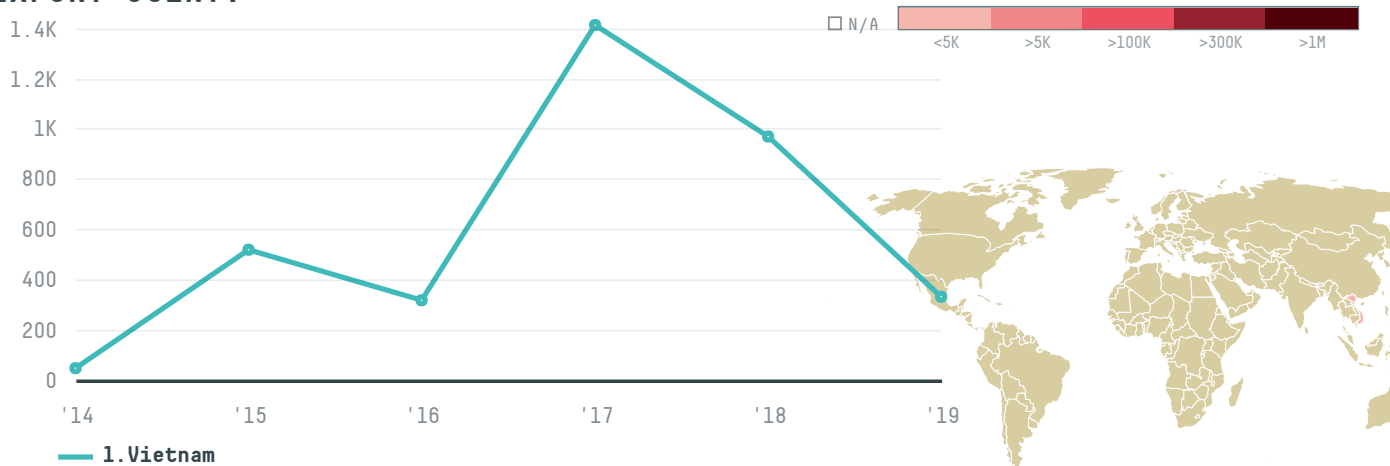

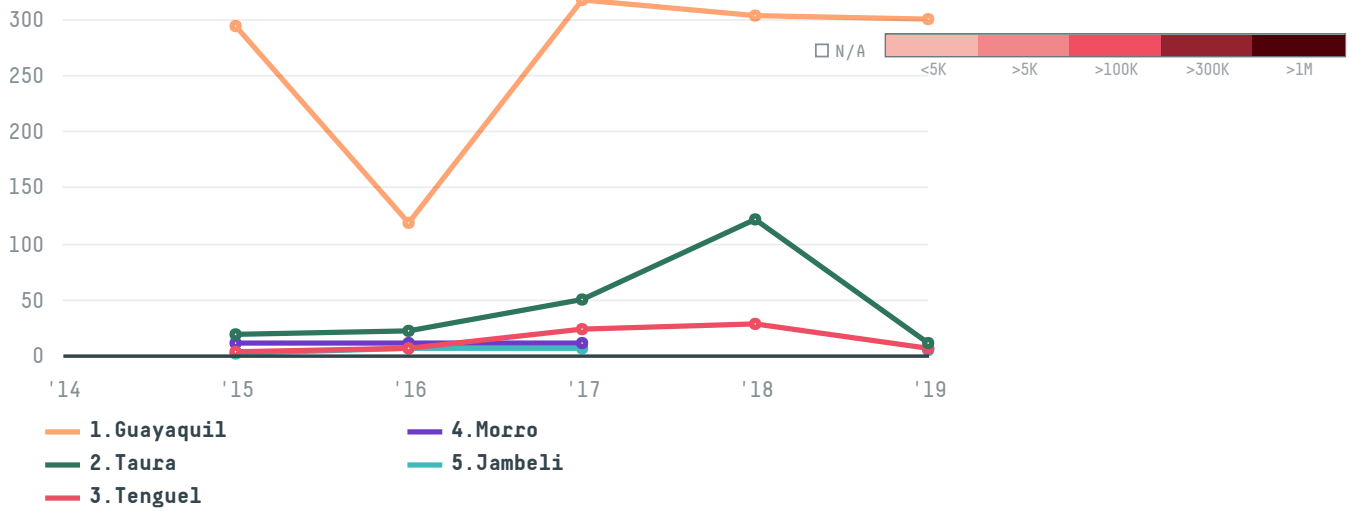
QUANG BINH IMPORT AND EXPORT JOINT was the 239th largest importer of shrimp from ECUADOR in 2019, accounting for 333 tons. This is a 66% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, QUANG BINH IMPORT AND EXPORT JOINT sources from 16 parishes, or 41% of the shrimp production parishes. The main destination of the shrimp imported by QUANG BINH IMPORT AND EXPORT JOINT is Vietnam, accounting for 100% of the total.
