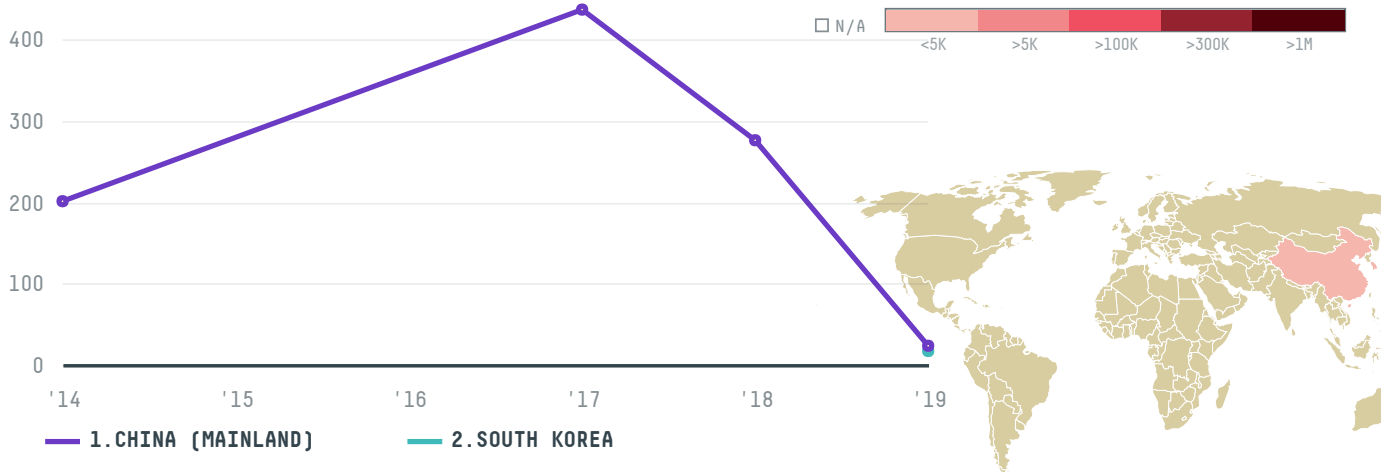

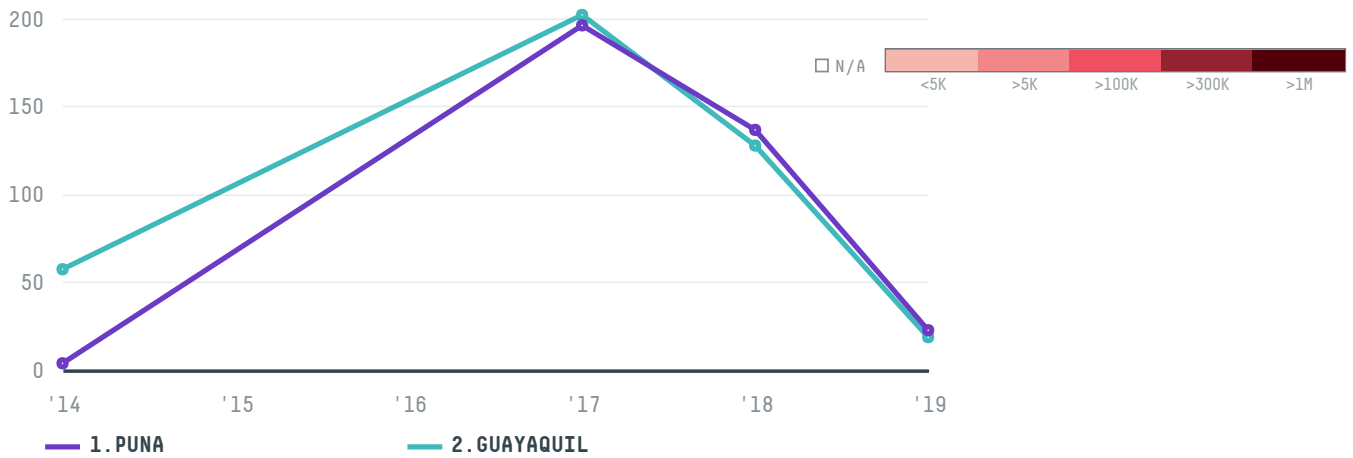
ALLIED PACIFIC FOOD was the 673rd largest importer of shrimp from ECUADOR in 2019, accounting for 42 tons. This is a 85% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, ALLIED PACIFIC FOOD sources from 2 parishes, or 5% of the shrimp production parishes. The main destination of the shrimp imported by ALLIED PACIFIC FOOD is CHINA (MAINLAND), accounting for 57% of the total.
