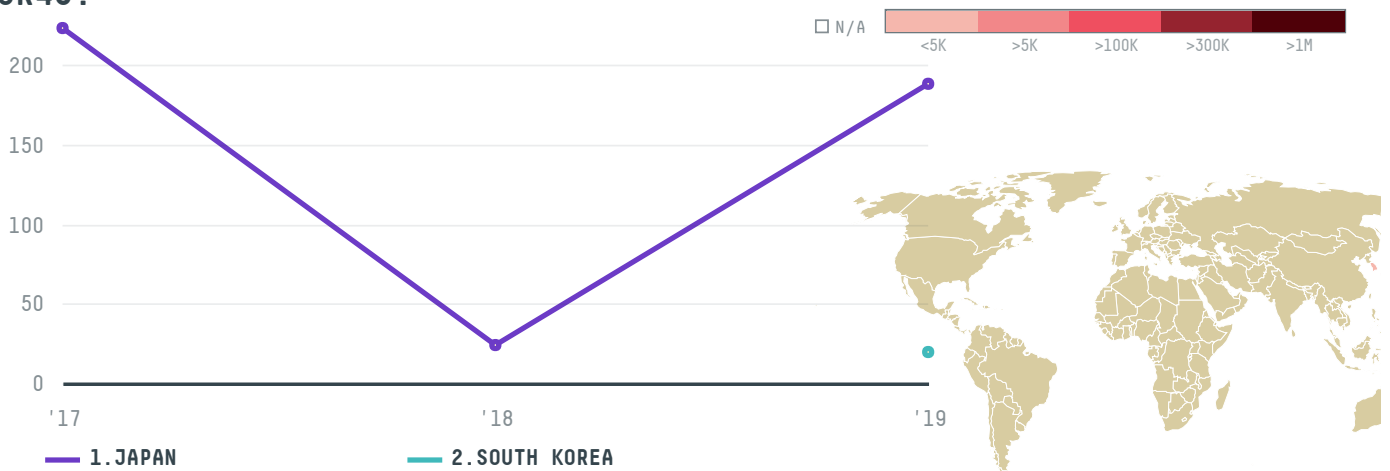
KANEMATSU CORPORATION SECT TGR43

As an importer, KANEMATSU CORPORATION SECT TGR43 sources from 1 parishes, or 3% of the shrimp production parishes. The main destination of the shrimp imported by KANEMATSU CORPORATION SECT TGR43 is JAPAN, accounting for 90% of the total.
