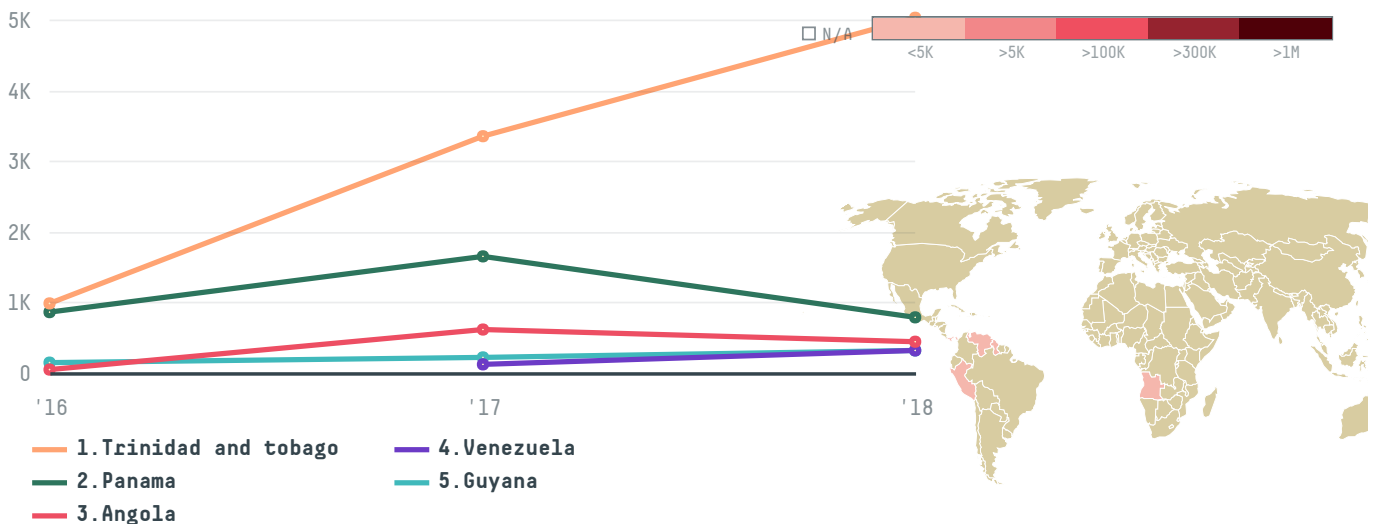

OLIGRA S.A. was the 35th largest exporter of soy from ARGENTINA in 2018, accounting for 8 thousand tons. This is a 93% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, OLIGRA S.A. sources from 1 departments, or 0% of the soy production departments. The main destination of the soy exported by OLIGRA S.A. is Trinidad and tobago, accounting for 67% of the total.
