BUYATTI SAICA was the 52nd largest exporter of soy from ARGENTINA in 2019, accounting for 2 thousand tons. This is a 64% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, BUYATTI SAICA sources from 1 departments, or 100% of the soy production departments.



Recent updates to "Deforestation Exposure"

On 10 November 2022, the term '**deforestation risk**' was replaced with '**deforestation exposure**' as a measure of the exposure of supply chain actors to deforestation from commodity production based on sourcing patterns.

Improvements in how commodity deforestation exposure is calculated were made on 7 December 2022. Numbers accessed before that date will differ from those accessed after.

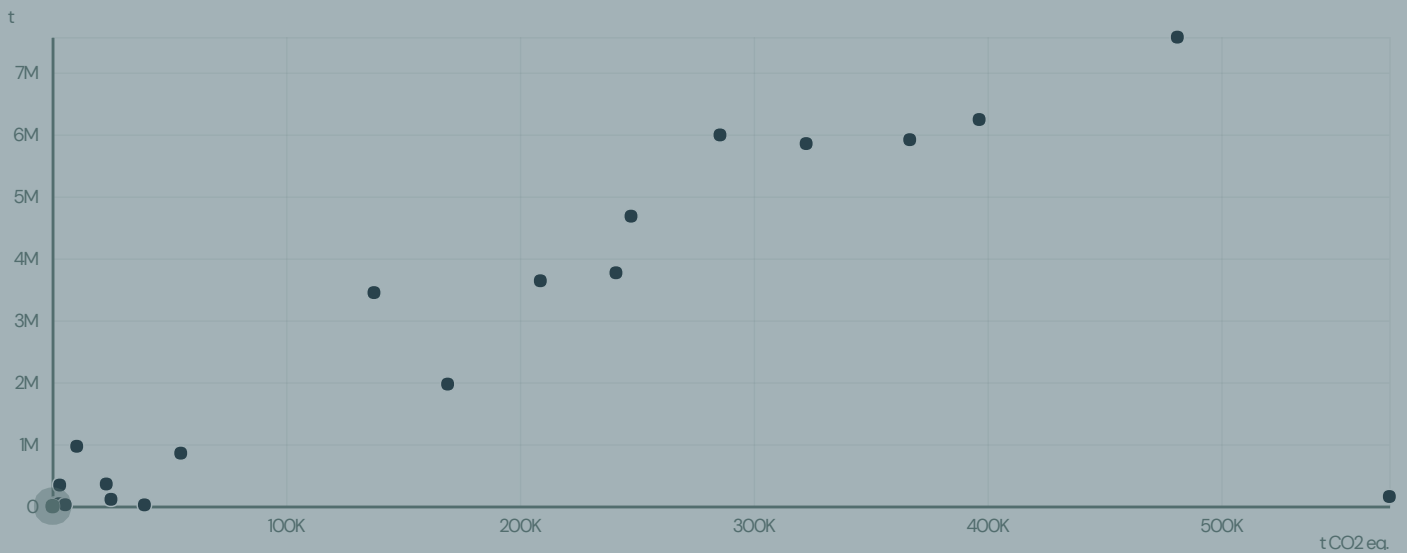
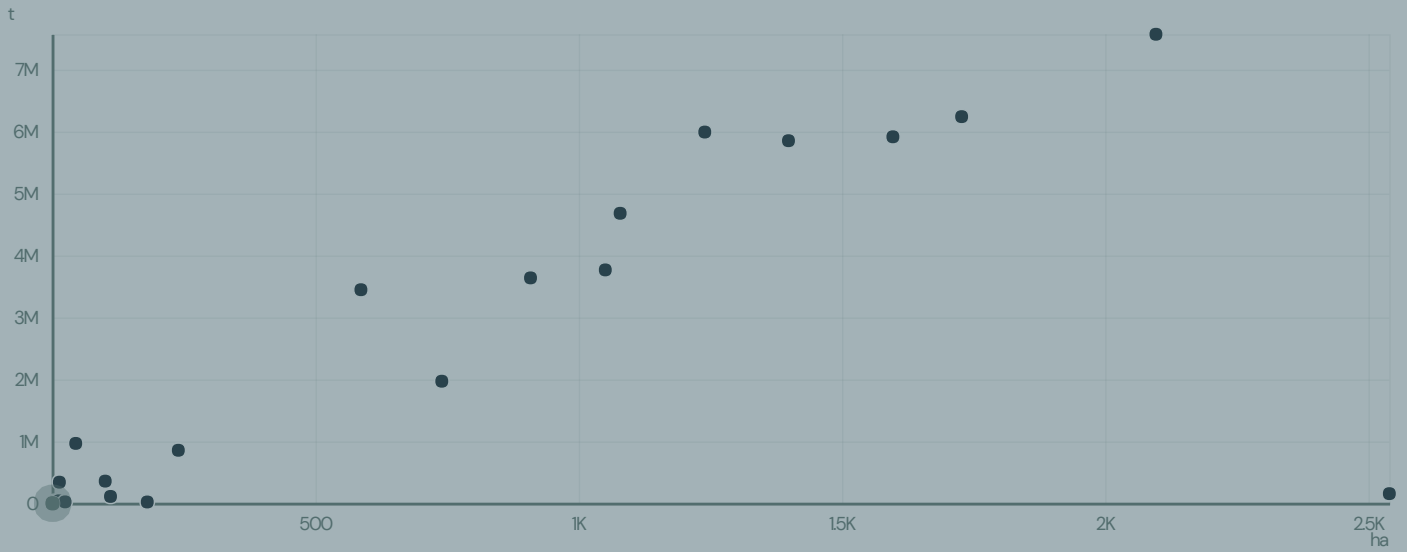
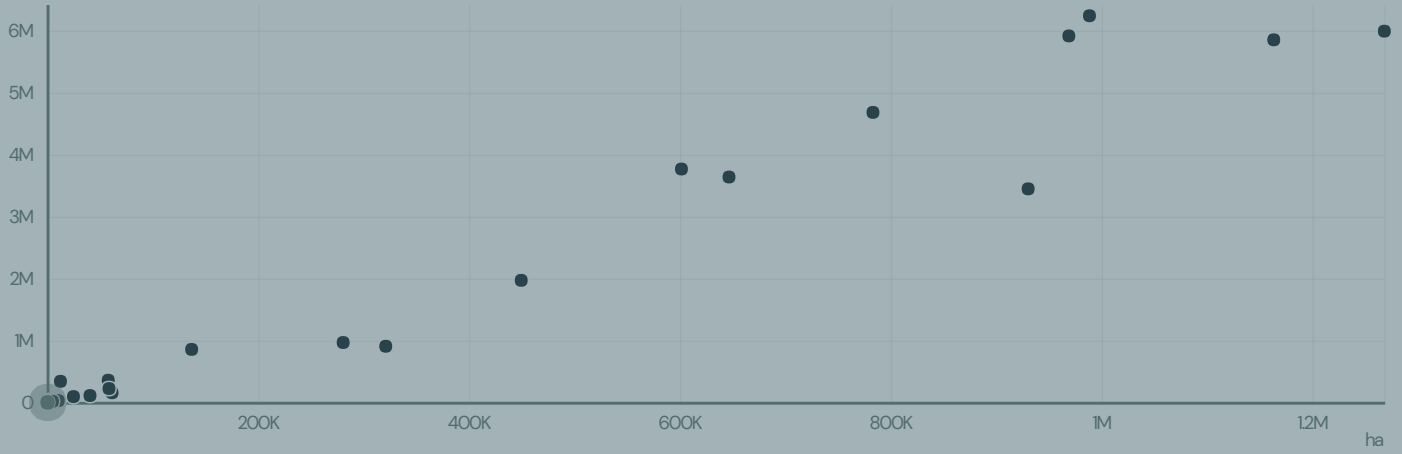
