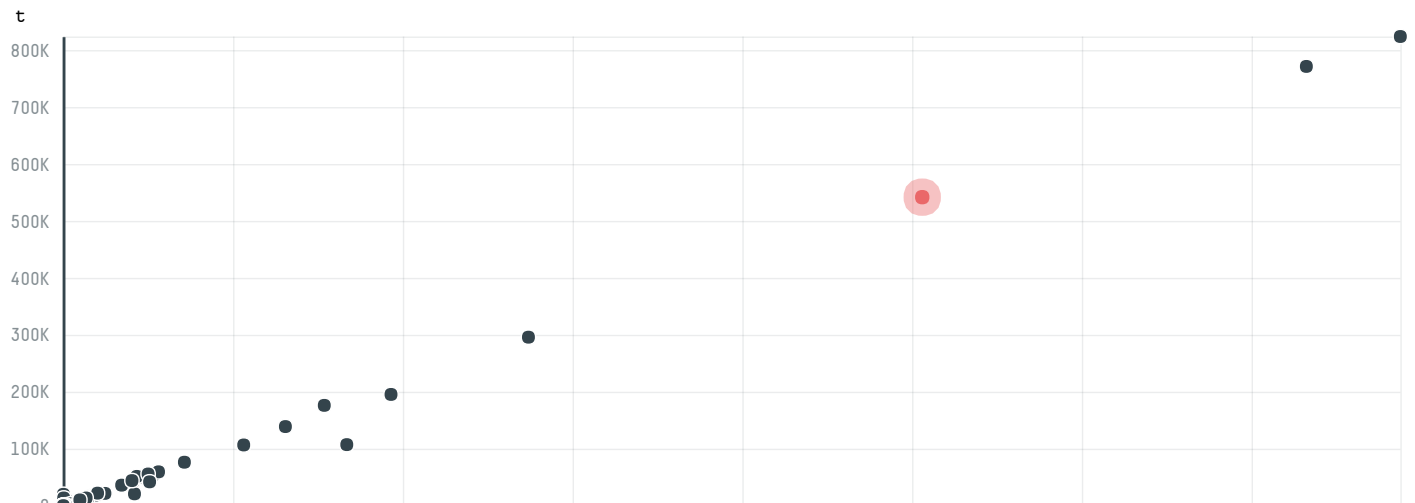
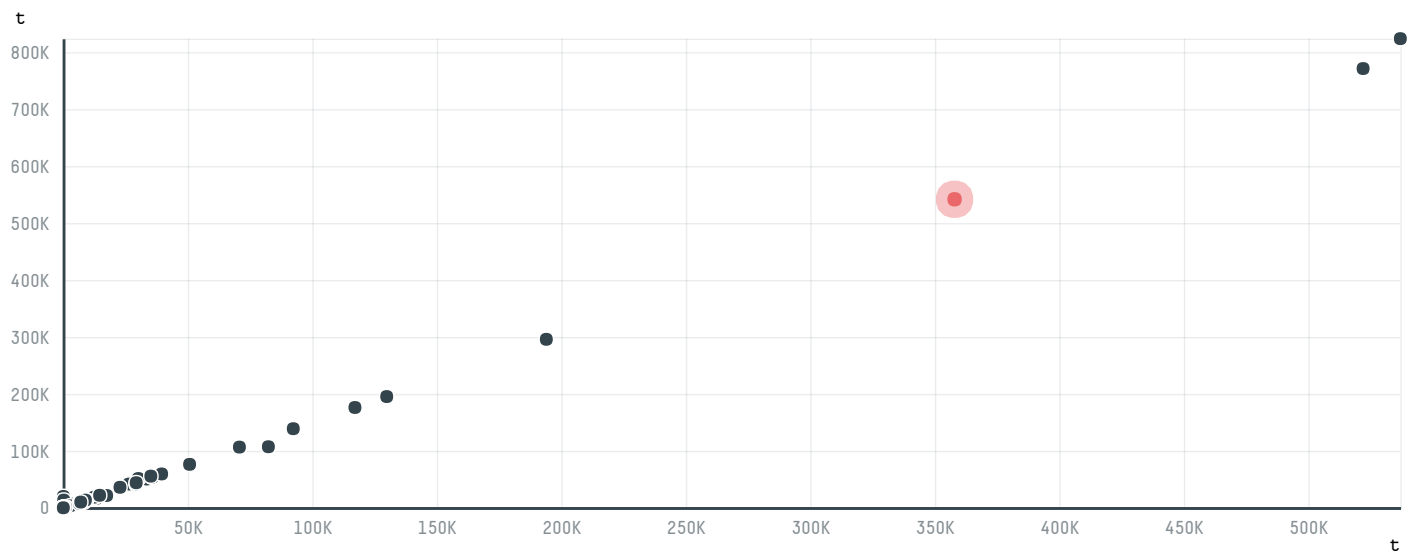
BRF was the 3rd largest exporter of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 542 thousand tons. This is a 16% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, BRF sources from 64 municipalities, or 13% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken exported by BRF is JAPAN, accounting for 27% of the total.
