DAIRY LAND was the 502nd largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 83 tons. As an importer, DAIRY LAND sources from 5 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by DAIRY LAND is CHINA (HONG KONG), accounting for 100% of the total.

### TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN IMPORTED BY DAIRY LAND:

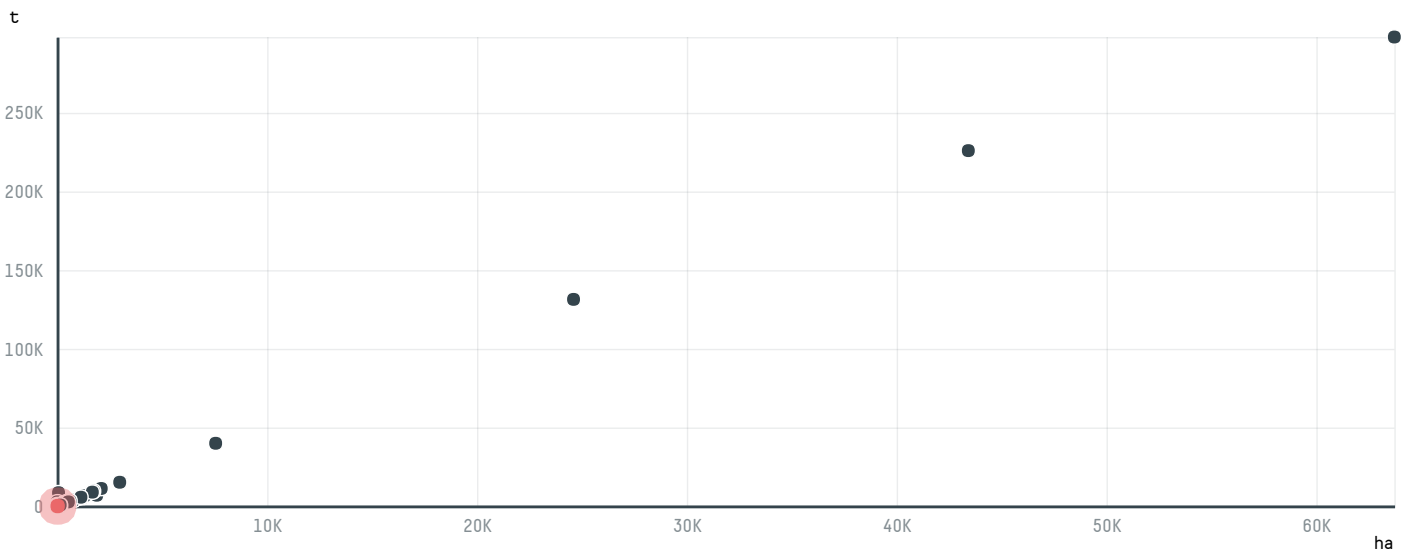
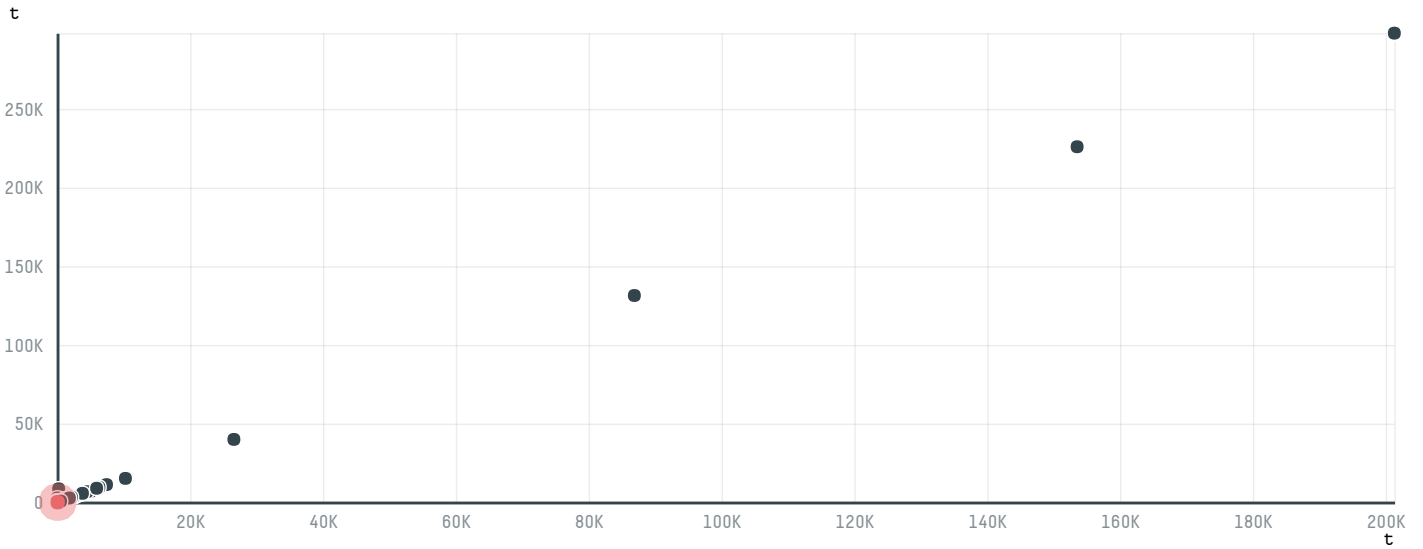
