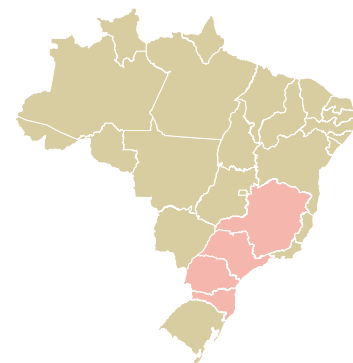
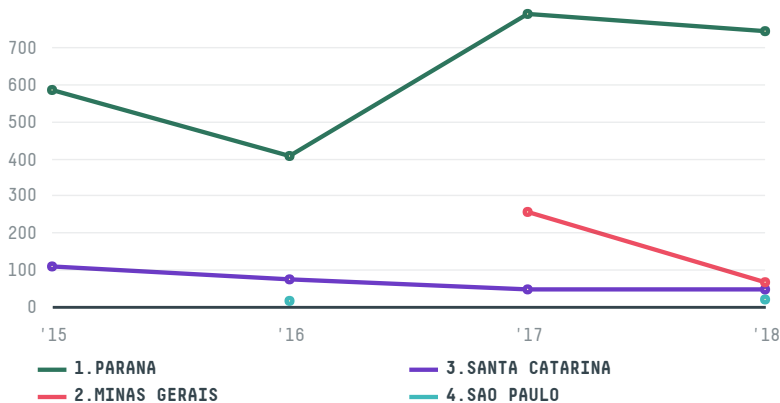
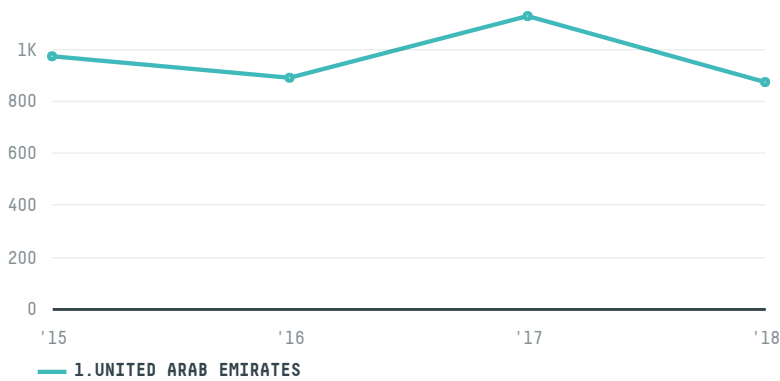


# SIAM TRADING CO

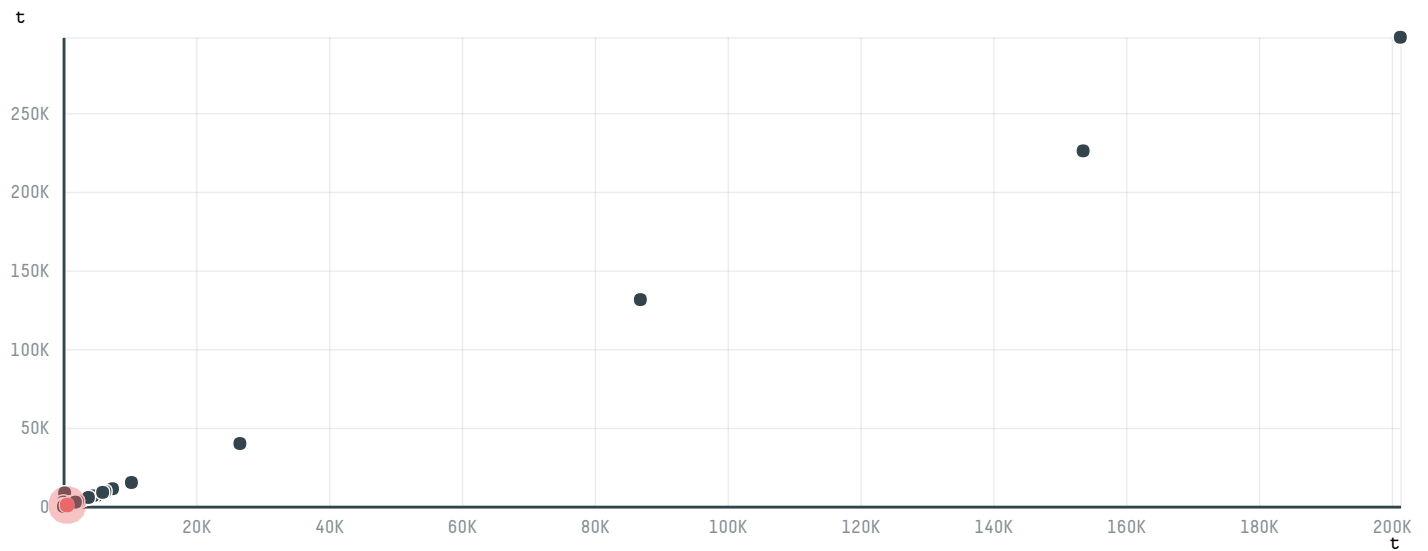

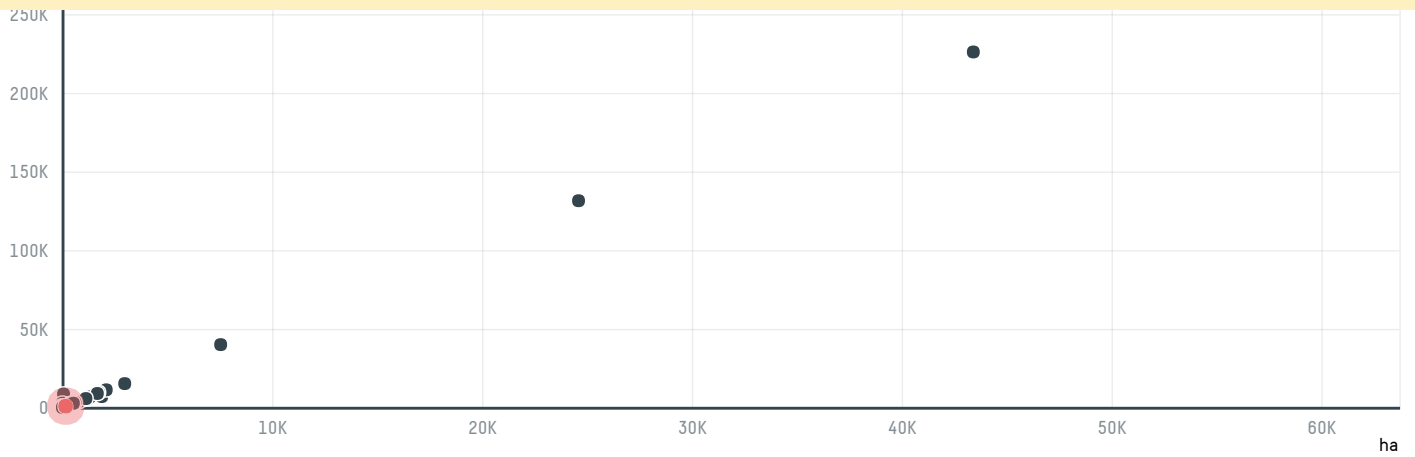
