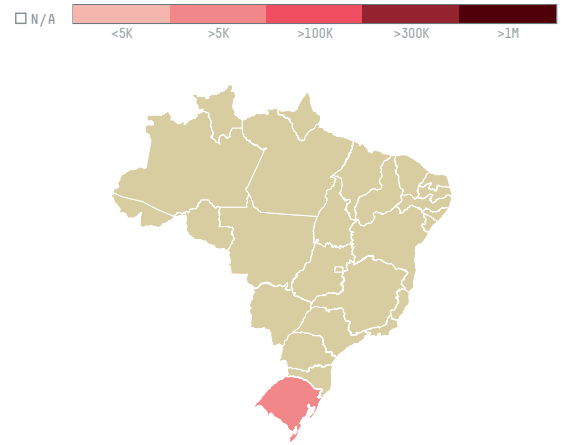
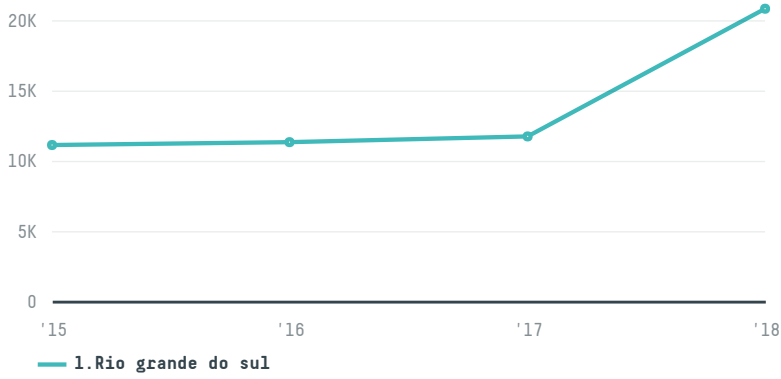
AGROSUL AGROAVICOLA INDUSTRIAL

AGROSUL AGROAVICOLA INDUSTRIAL was the 23rd largest exporter of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 21 thousand tons. This is a 77% increase vs the previous year. As an exporter, AGROSUL AGROAVICOLA INDUSTRIAL sources from 4 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken exported by AGROSUL AGROAVICOLA INDUSTRIAL is South africa, accounting for 19% of the total.

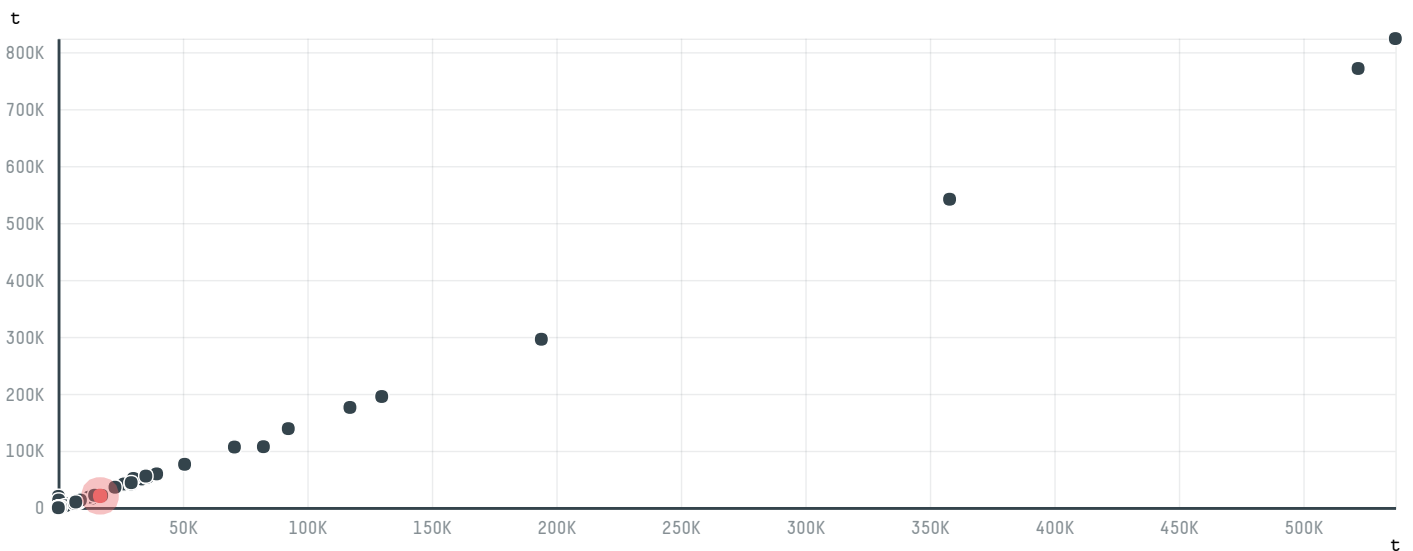

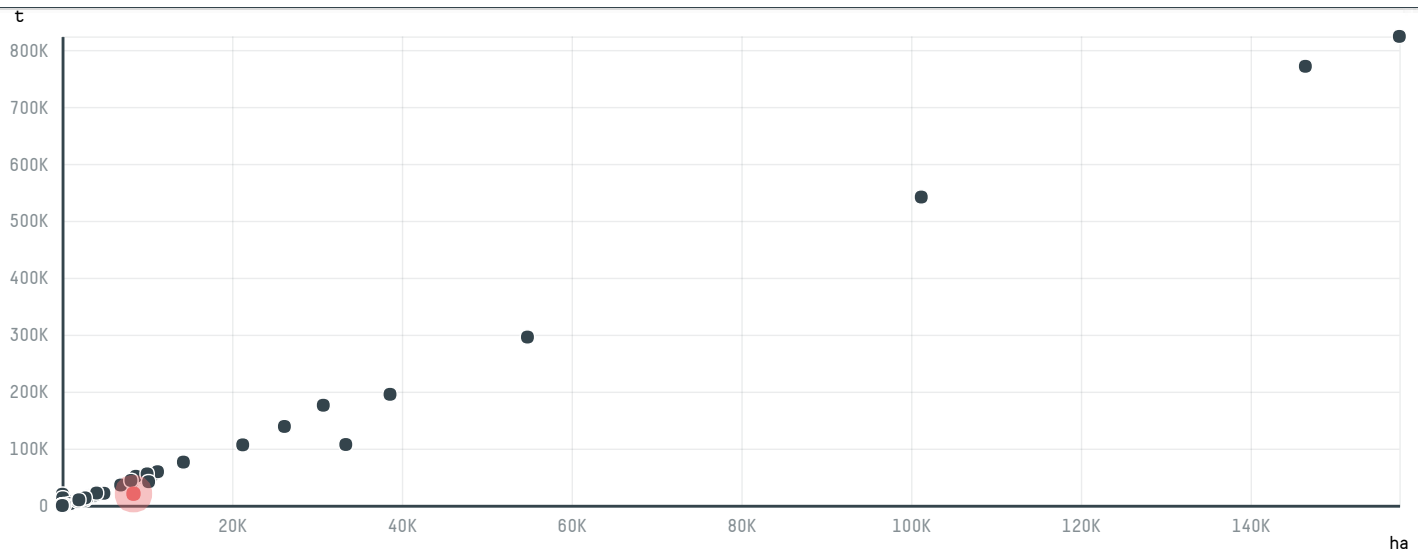
