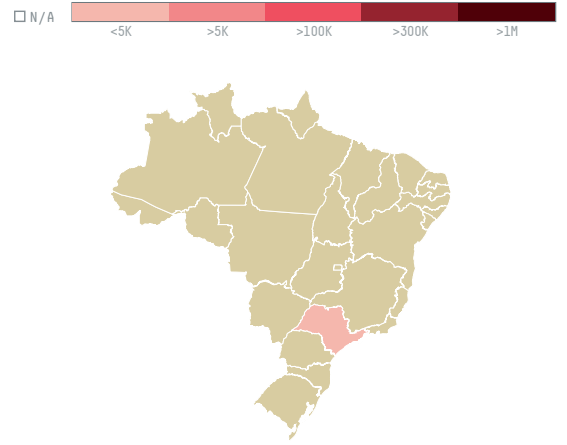
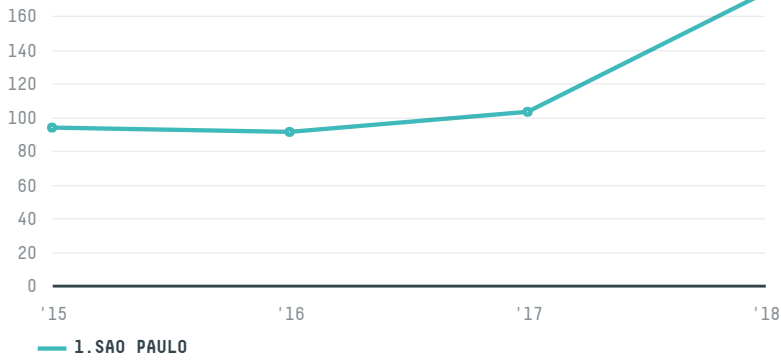
COBB-VANTRESS BRASIL LTDA was the 58th largest exporter of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 174 tons. This is a 69% increase vs the previous year. As an exporter, COBB-VANTRESS BRASIL LTDA sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken exported by COBB-VANTRESS BRASIL LTDA is ECUADOR, accounting for 46% of the total.

### TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN EXPORTED BY COBB-VANTRESS BRASIL LTDA:



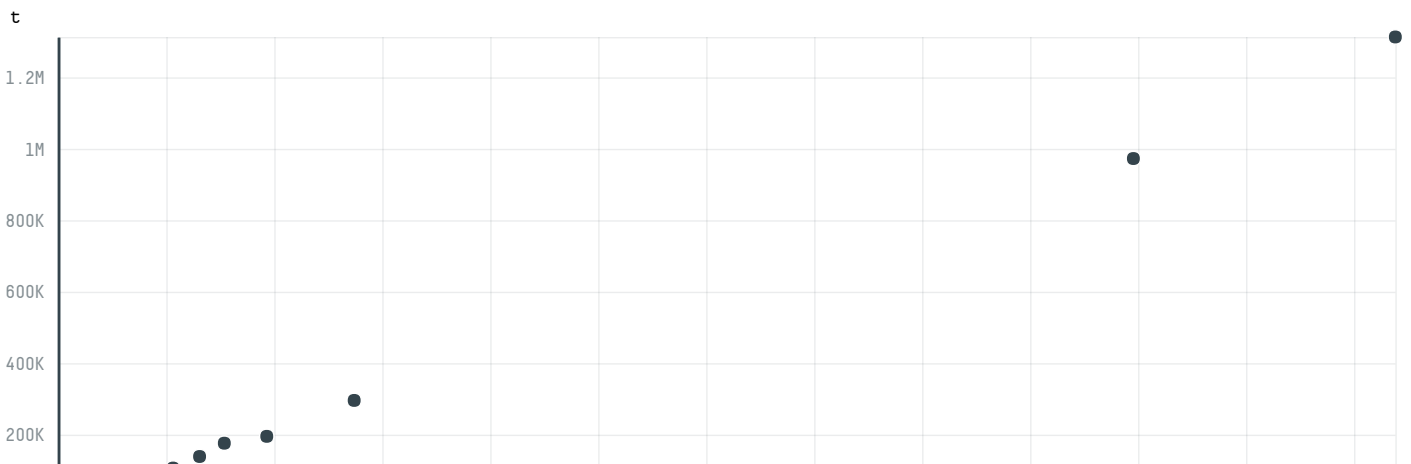
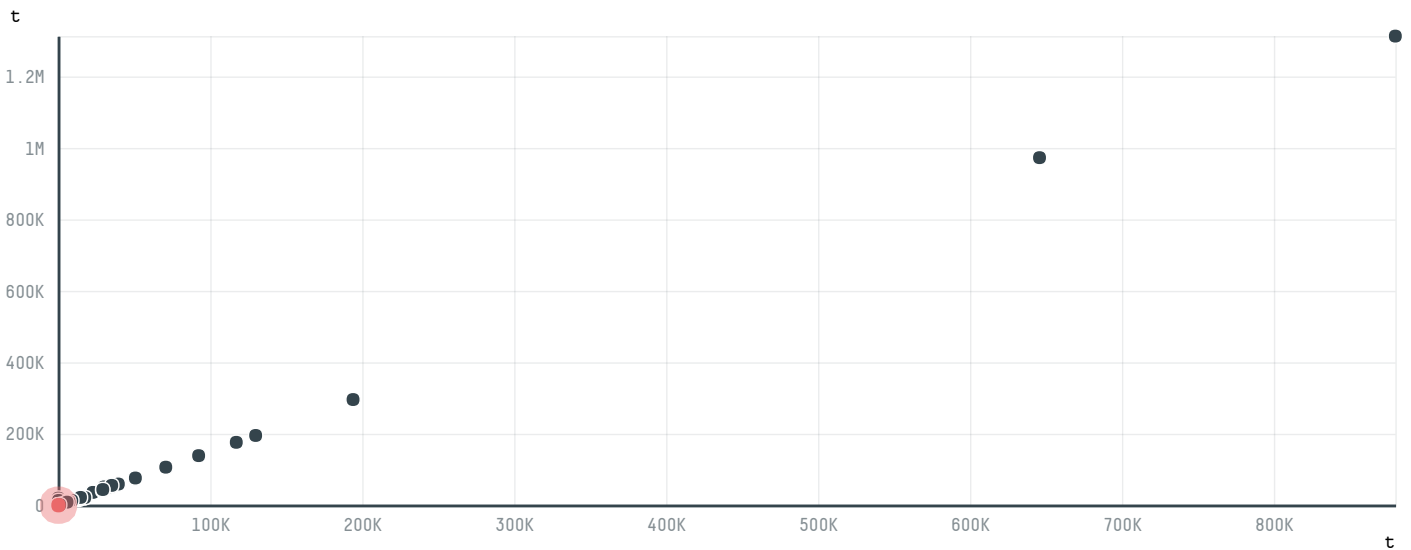
