



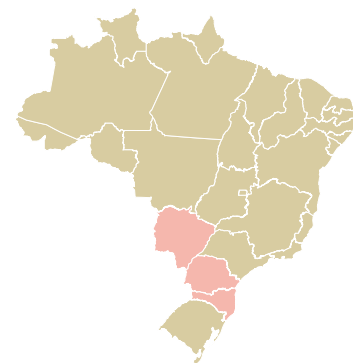
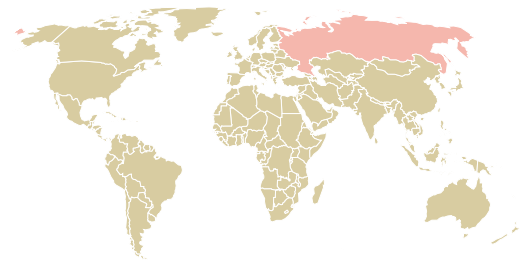
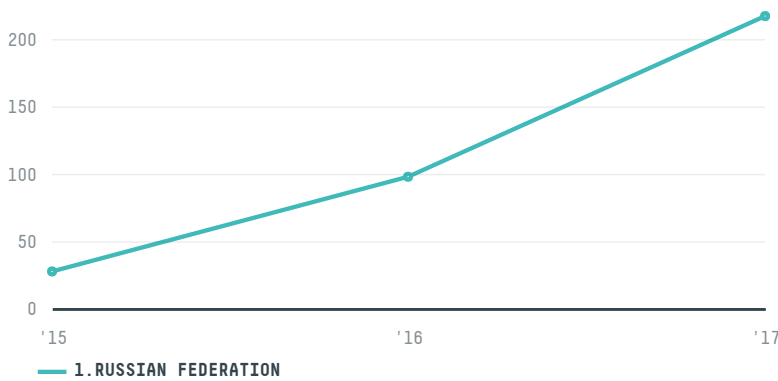

DELTA VIT was the 680th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 217 tons. This is a 121% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, DELTA VIT sources from 6 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by DELTA VIT is RUSSIAN FEDERATION, accounting for 100% of the total.

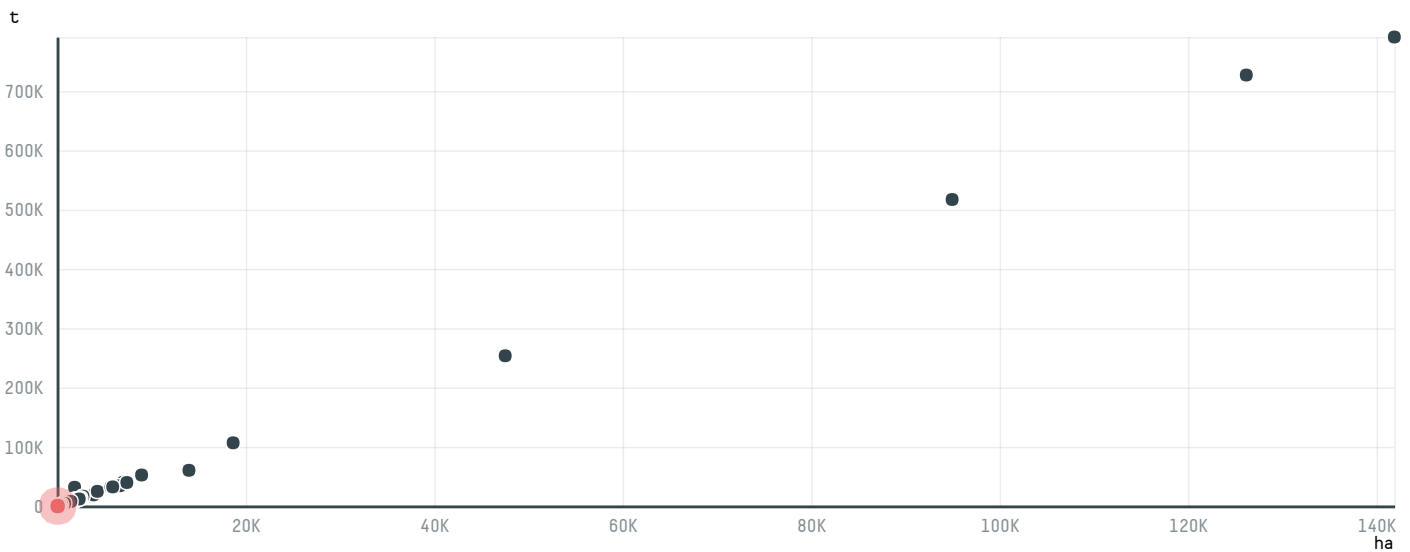
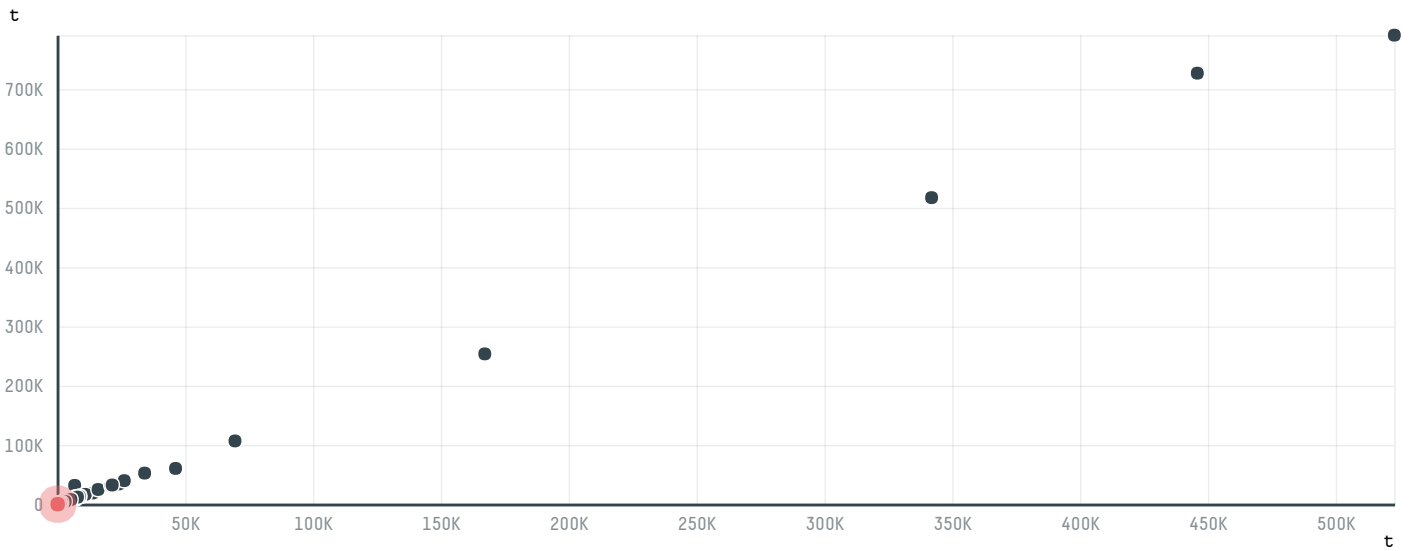
