



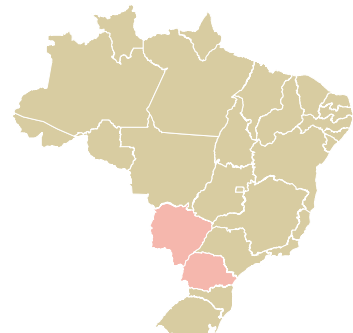
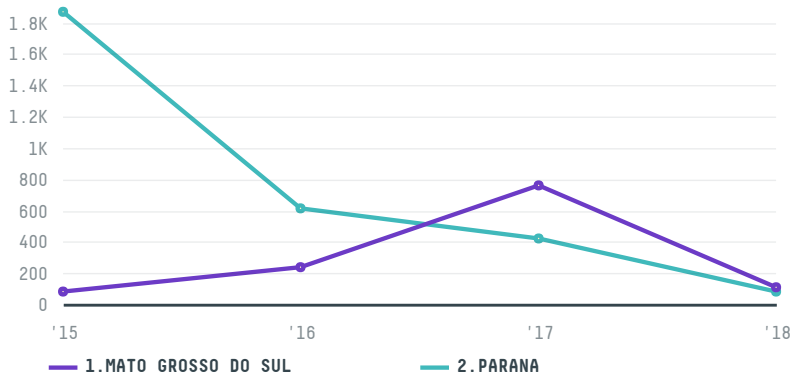
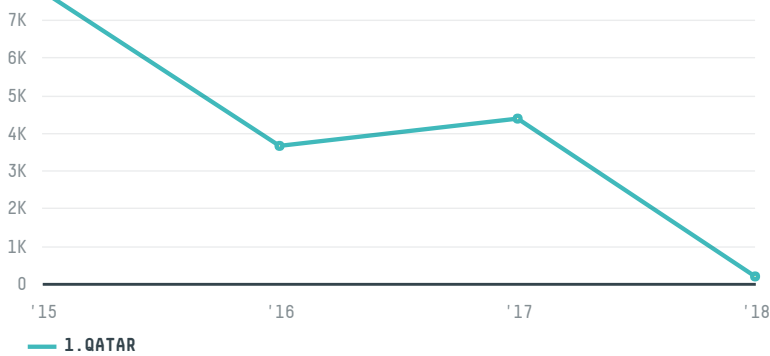

GULF CENTER FOR FOODSTUFFS was the 343rd largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 189 tons. This is a 96% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, GULF CENTER FOR FOODSTUFFS sources from 3 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by GULF CENTER FOR FOODSTUFFS is QATAR, accounting for 100% of the total.

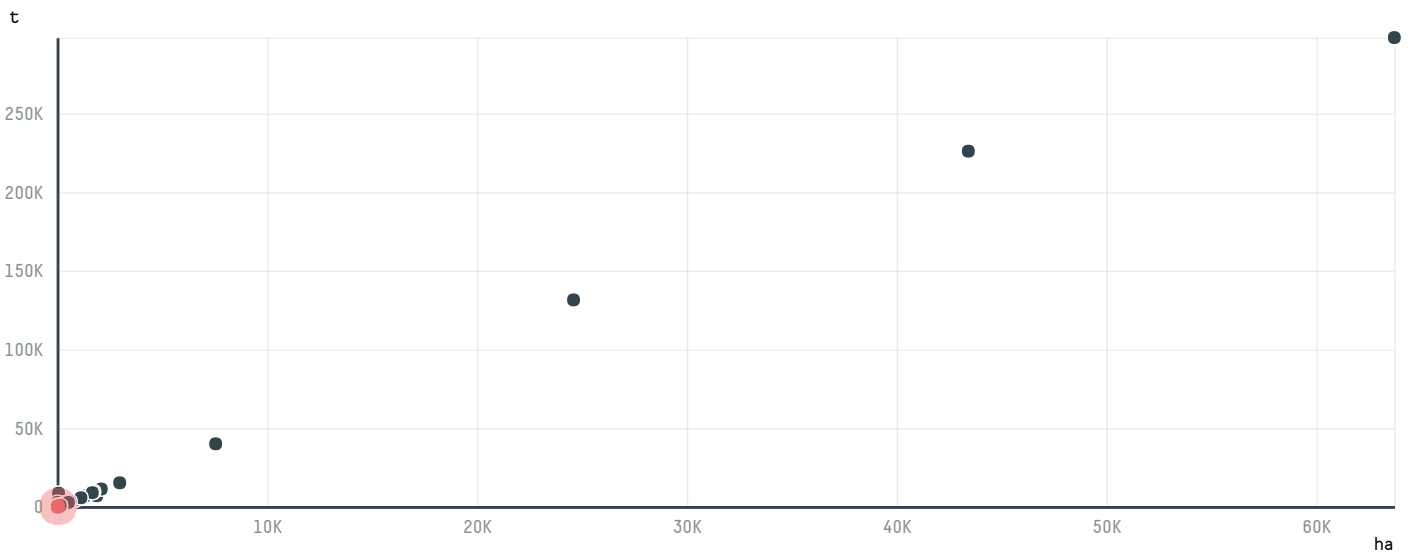
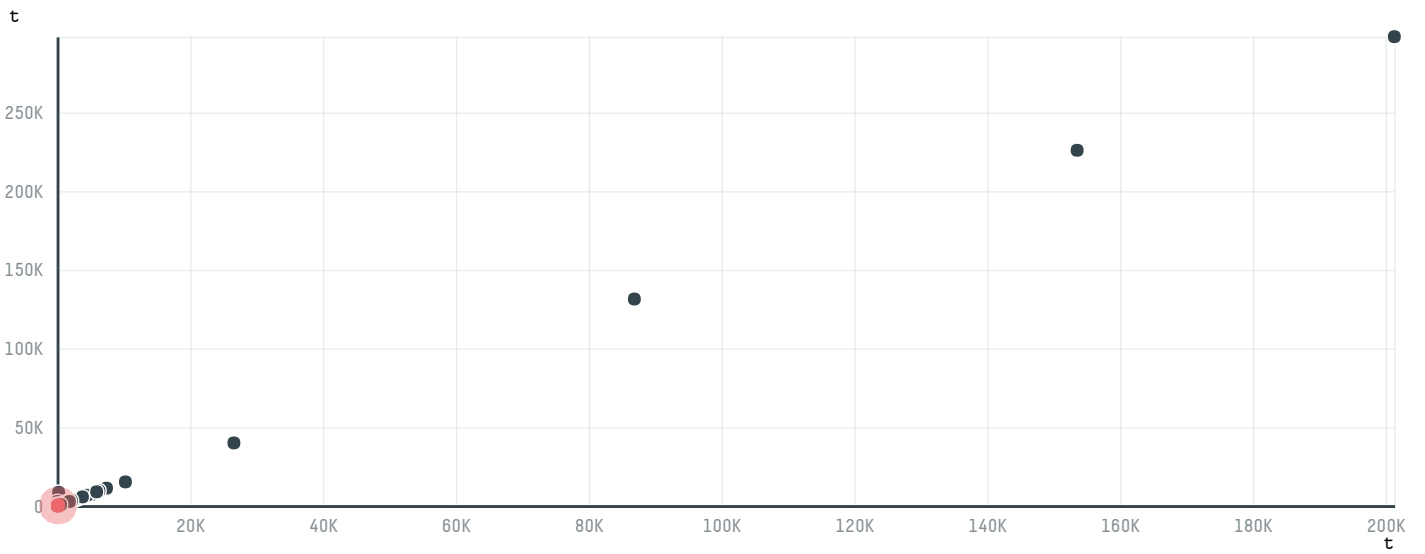
