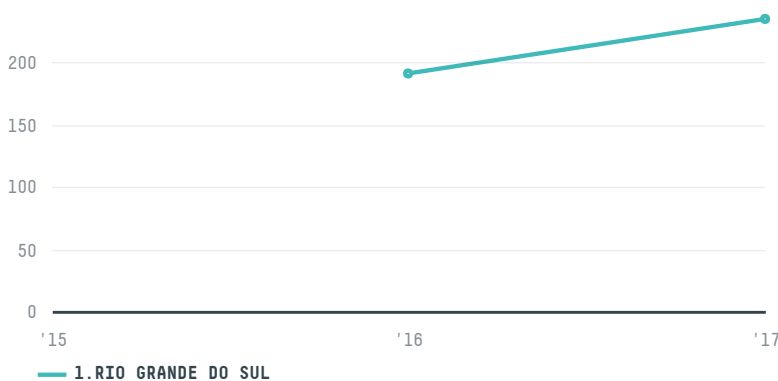
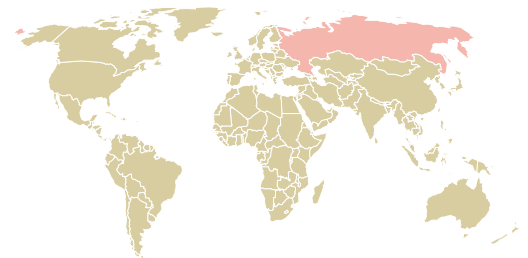
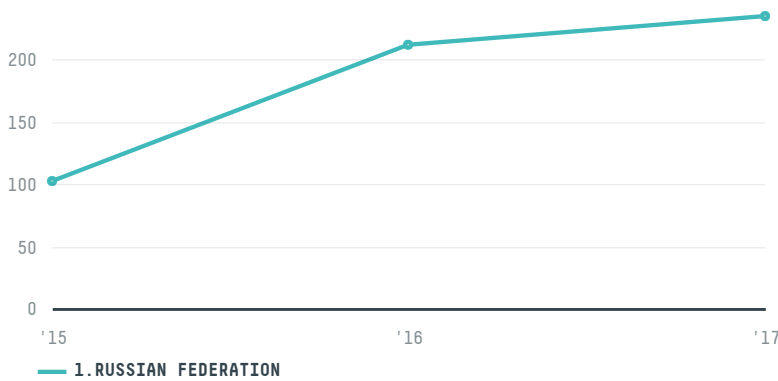


AGERRATUM

AGERRATUM was the 664th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 235 tons. This is a 11% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, AGERRATUM sources from 3 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by AGERRATUM is RUSSIAN FEDERATION, accounting for 100% of the total.

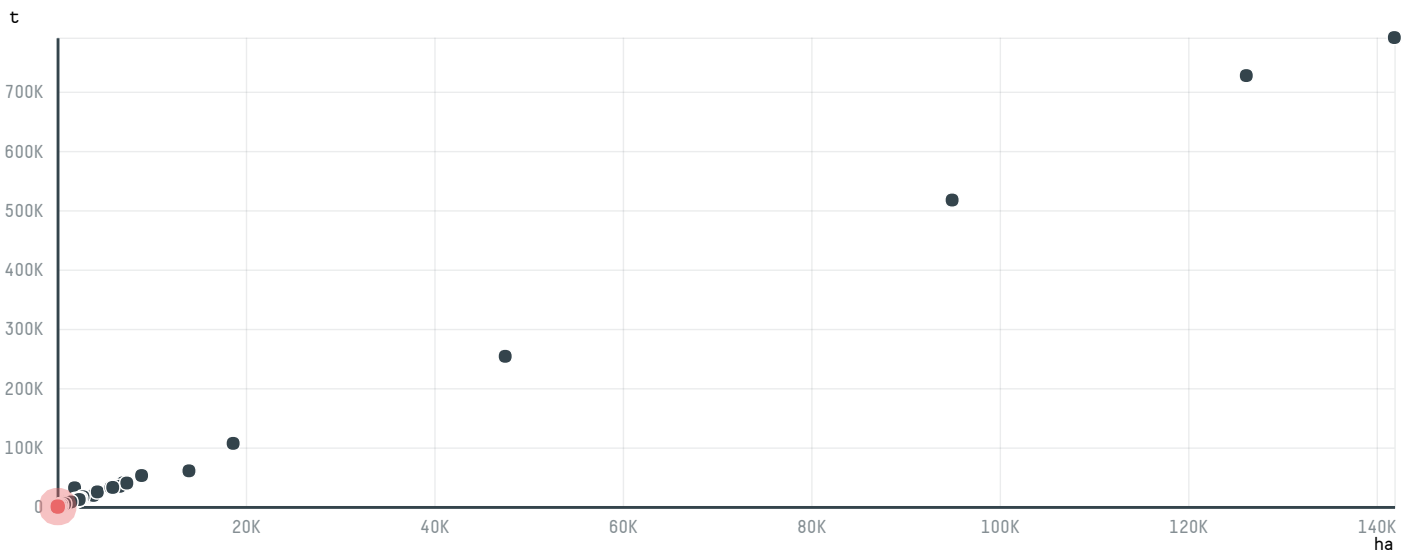
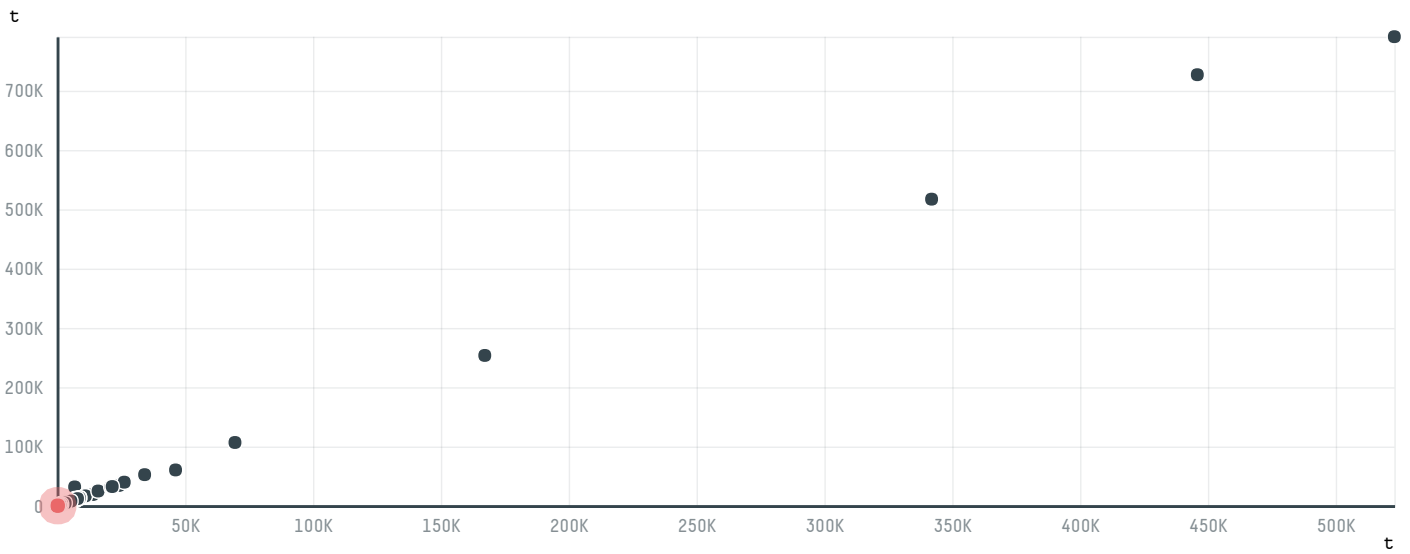
TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN IMPORTED BY AGERRATUM:



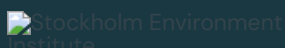
