PJ IMPEX was the 994th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2015, accounting for 139 tons. As an importer, PJ IMPEX sources from 6 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by PJ IMPEX is SOUTH AFRICA, accounting for 100% of the total.

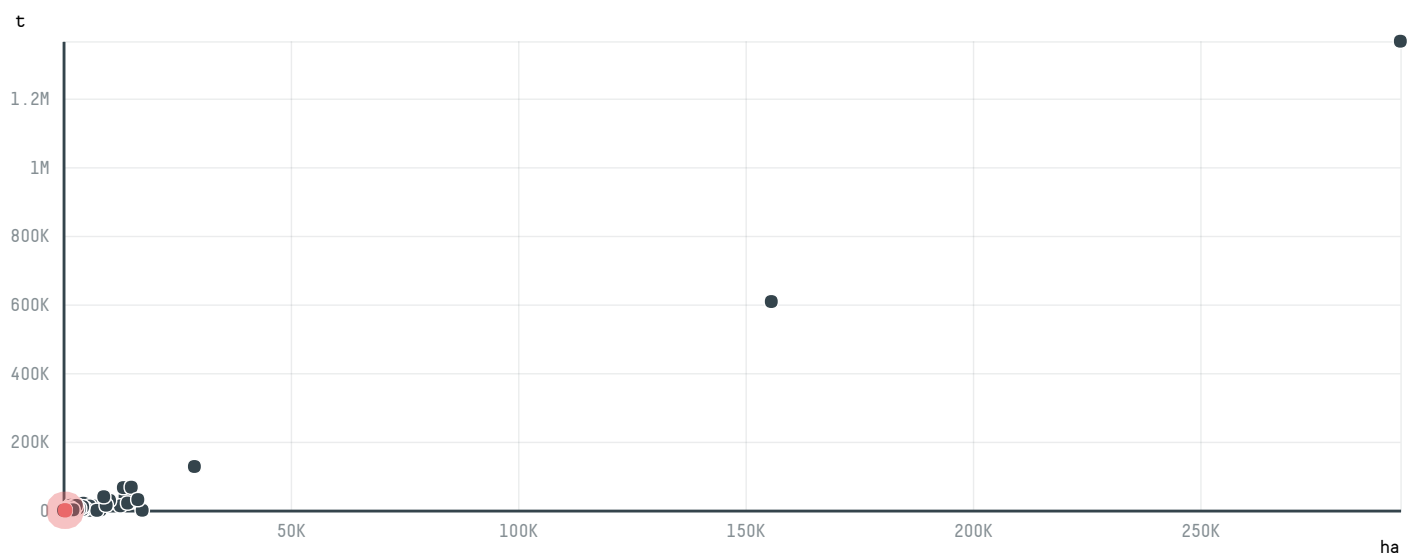
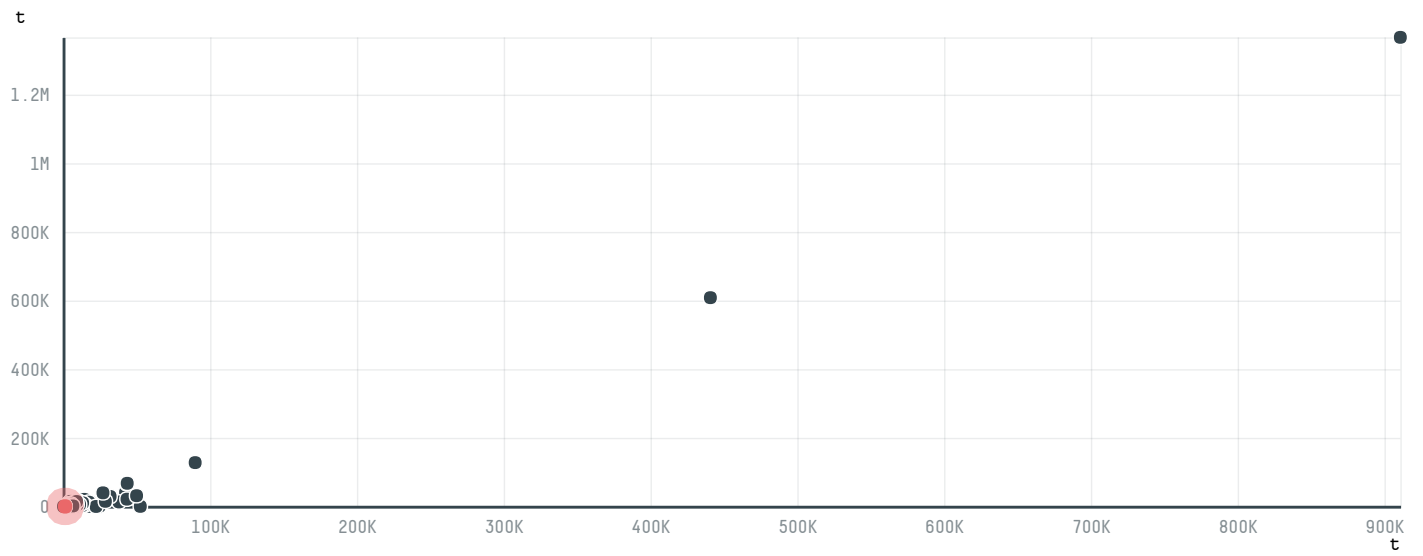
