



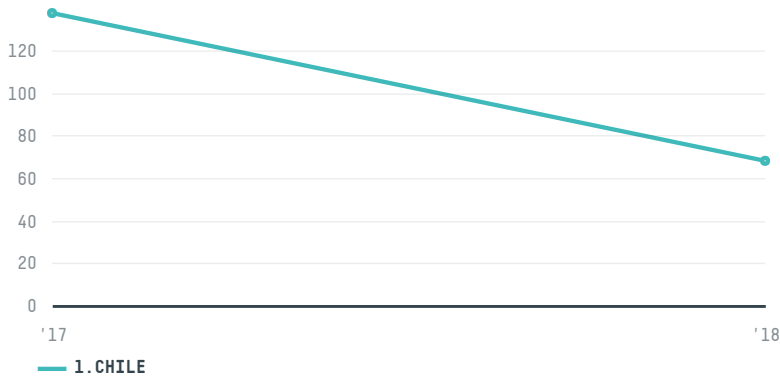

## ANDES MEAT

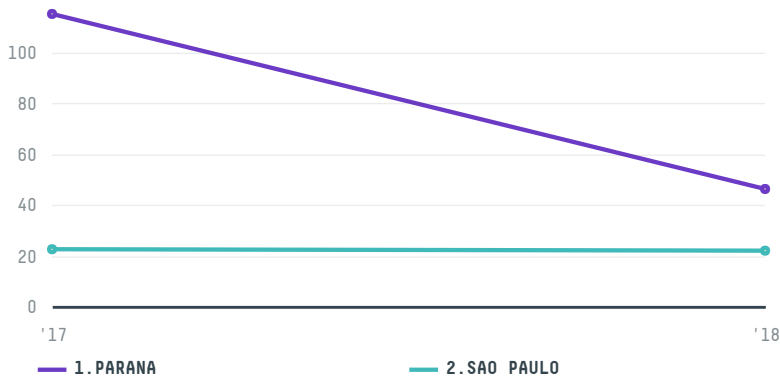

ANDES MEAT was the 555th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 68 tons. This is a 51% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, ANDES MEAT sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by ANDES MEAT is CHILE, accounting for 100% of the total.

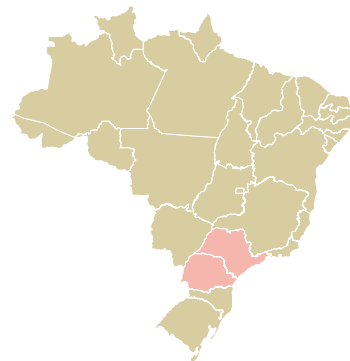
### TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN IMPORTED BY ANDES MEAT:

Legend for Brazil map:  N/A,  <5K,  >5K,  >100K,  >300K,  >1M

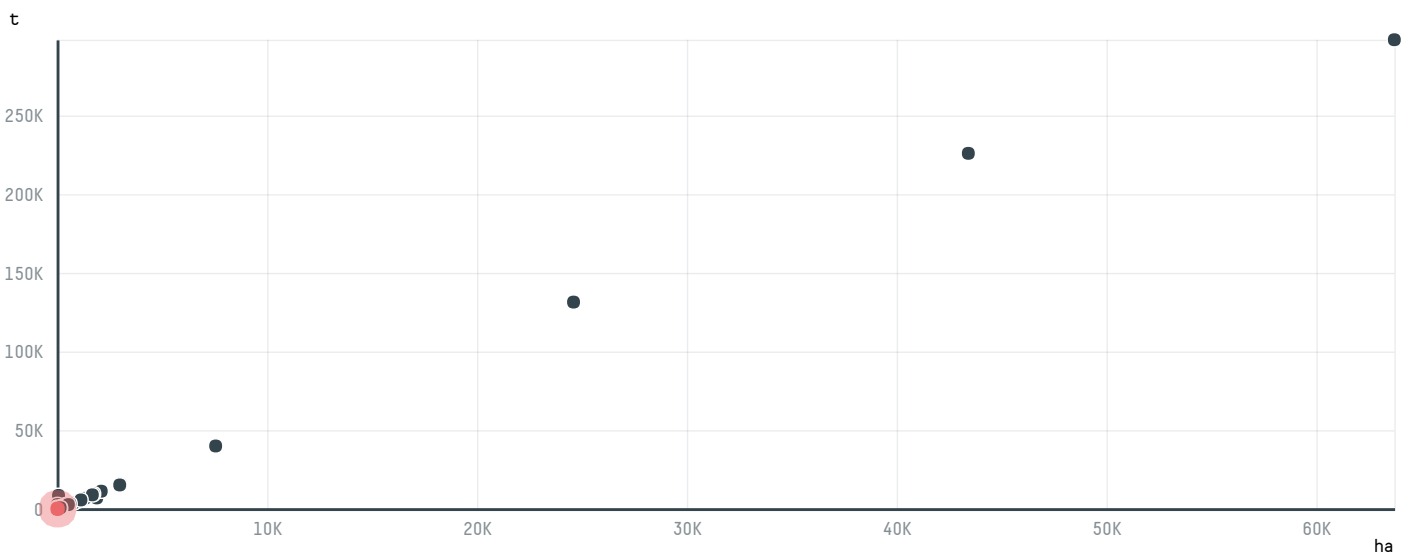
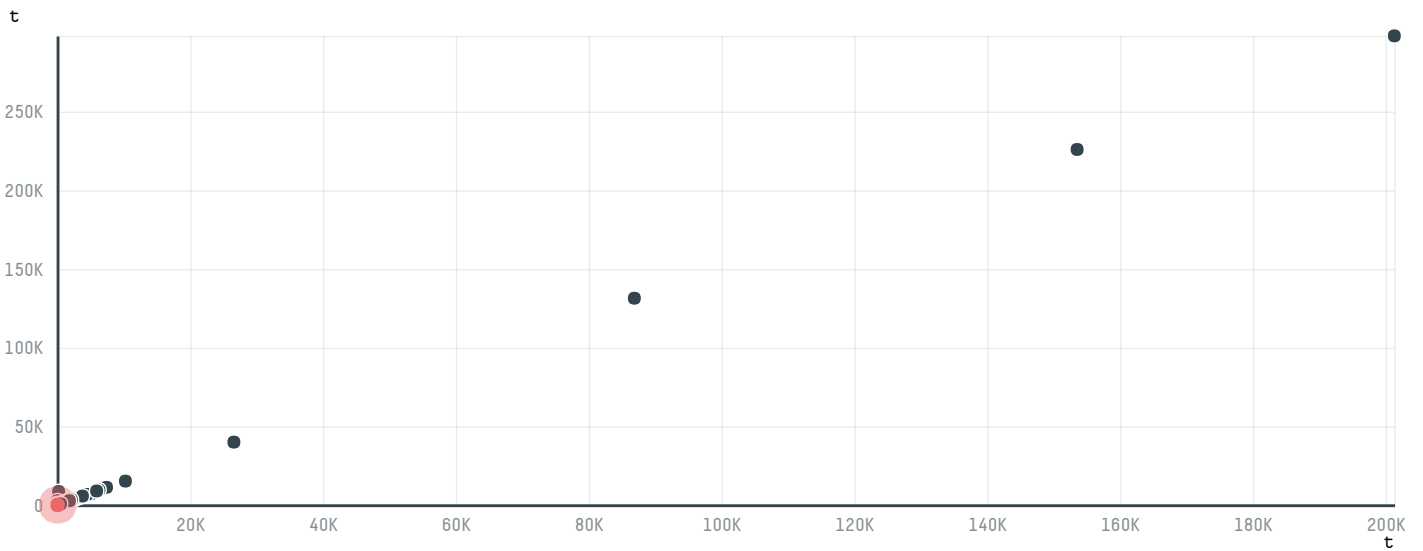
