



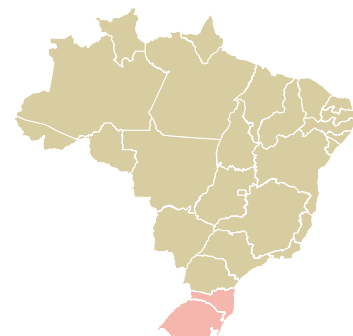
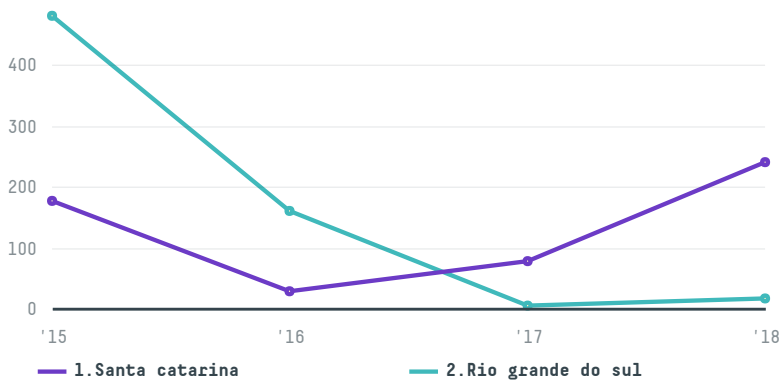
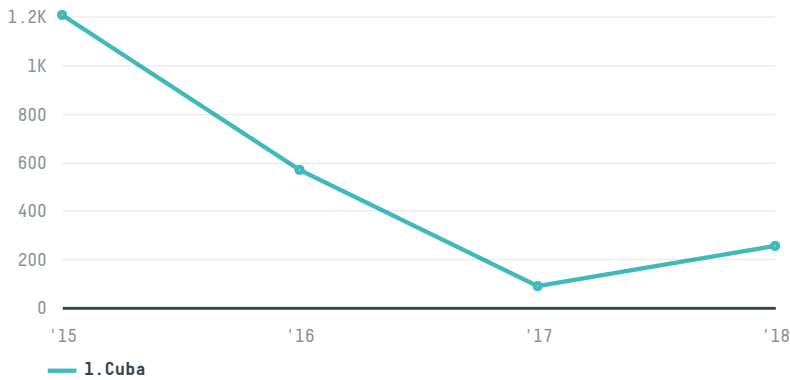

ALIMENTOS DE LAS AMERICAS was the 284th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2018, accounting for 256 tons. This is a 187% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, ALIMENTOS DE LAS AMERICAS sources from 6 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by ALIMENTOS DE LAS AMERICAS is Cuba, accounting for 100% of the total.

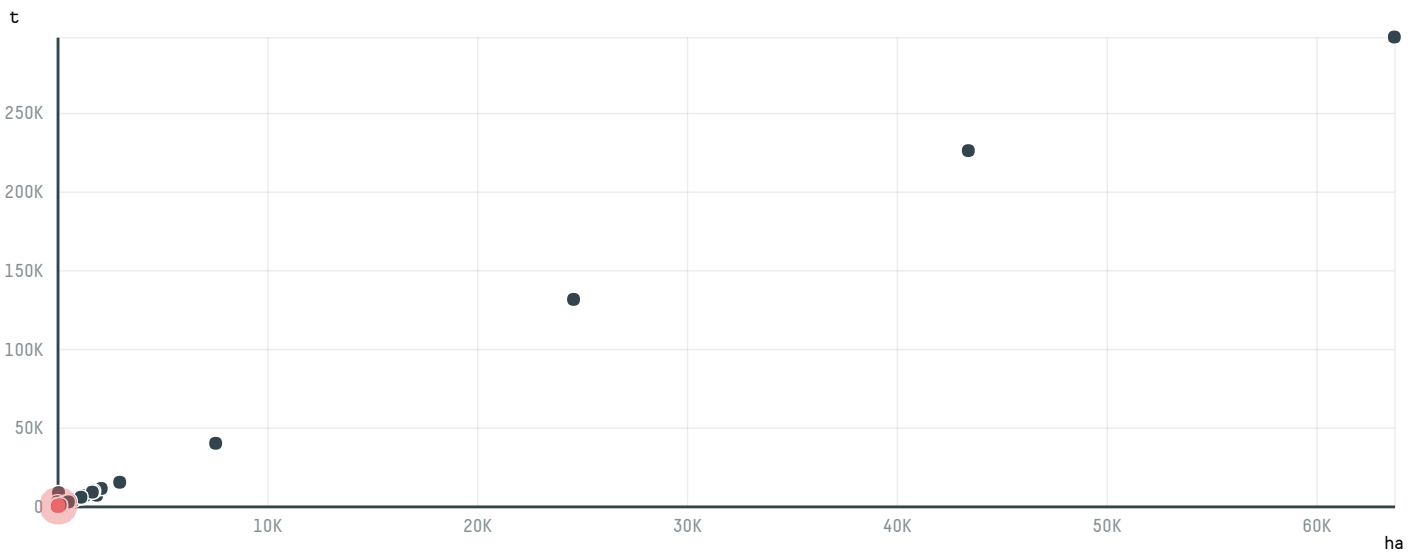
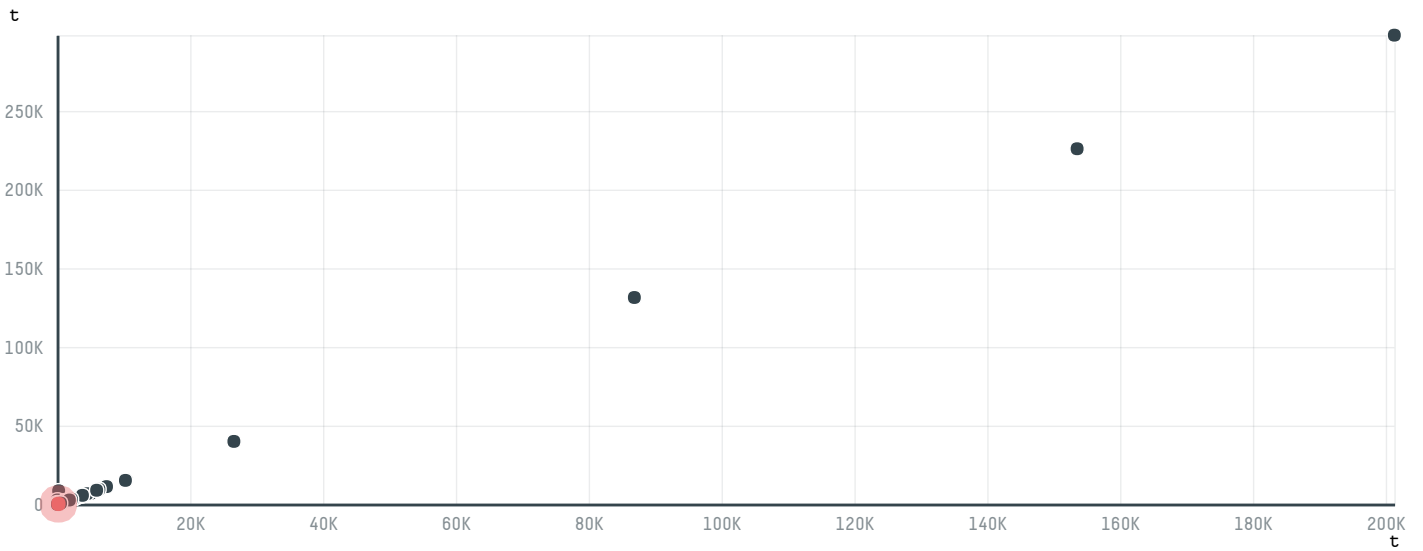
