NEWACO GRUPO was the 407th largest importer of chicken from BRAZIL in 2015, accounting for 699 tons. As an importer, NEWACO GRUPO sources from 27 municipalities, or 6% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by NEWACO GRUPO is ANGOLA, accounting for 100% of the total.

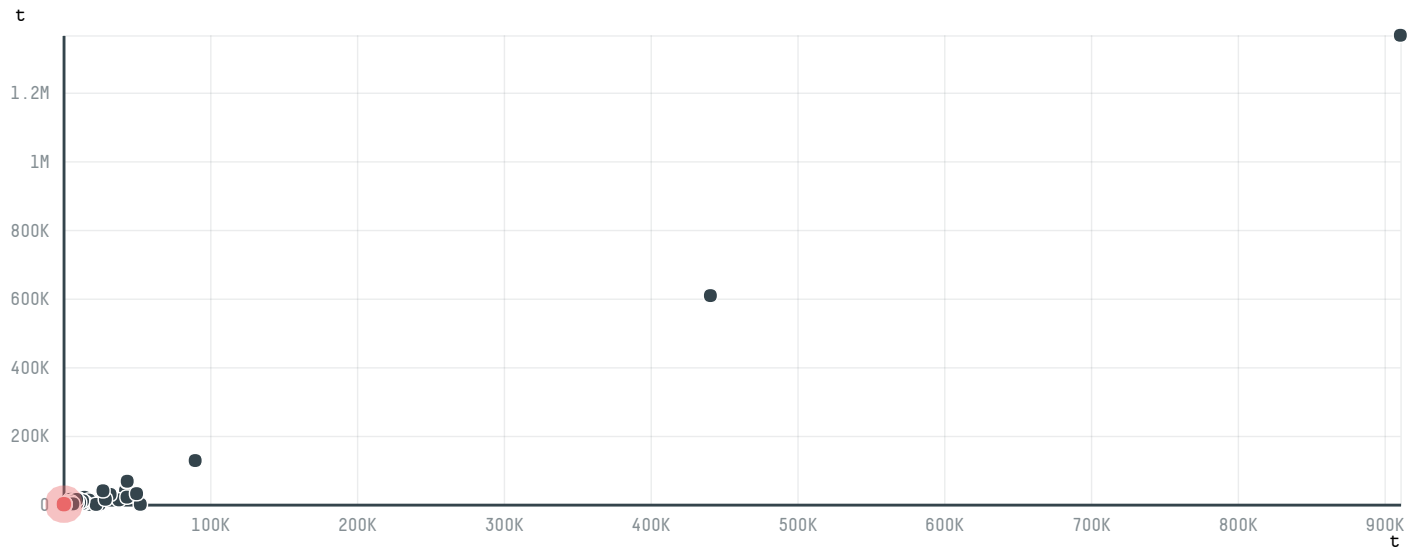

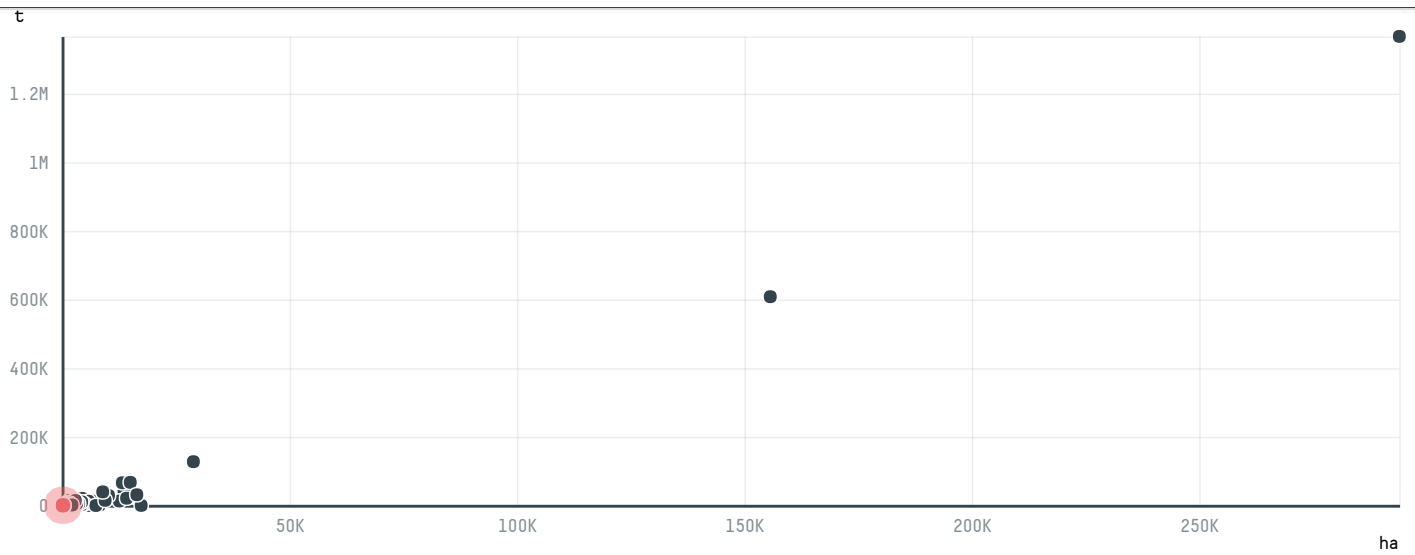
