



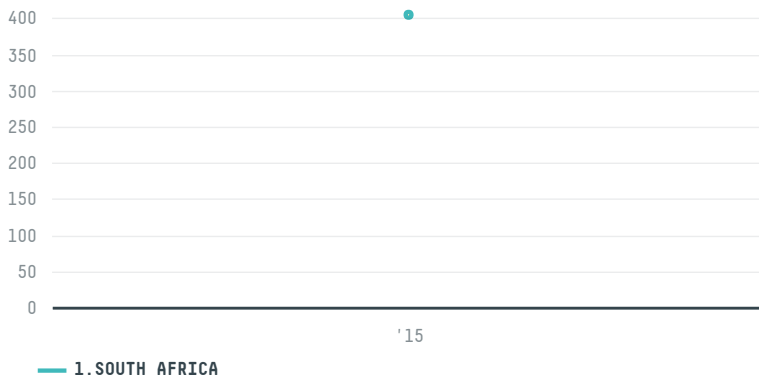

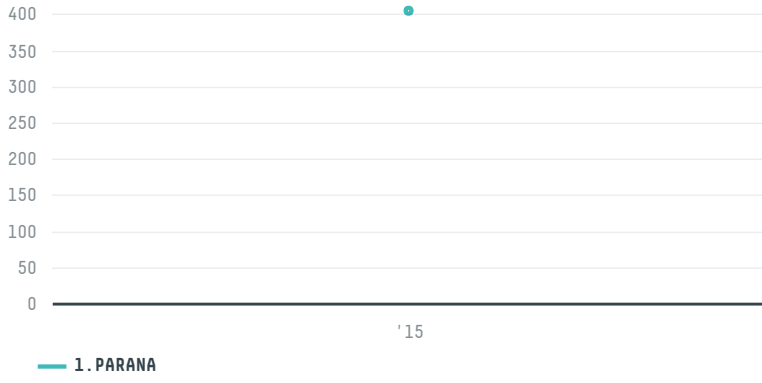
# BRITOS FOODS INTERNATIONAL CILMOR STREET

The main destination of the chicken imported by BRITOS FOODS INTERNATIONAL CILMOR STREET is SOUTH AFRICA, accounting for 100% of the total.

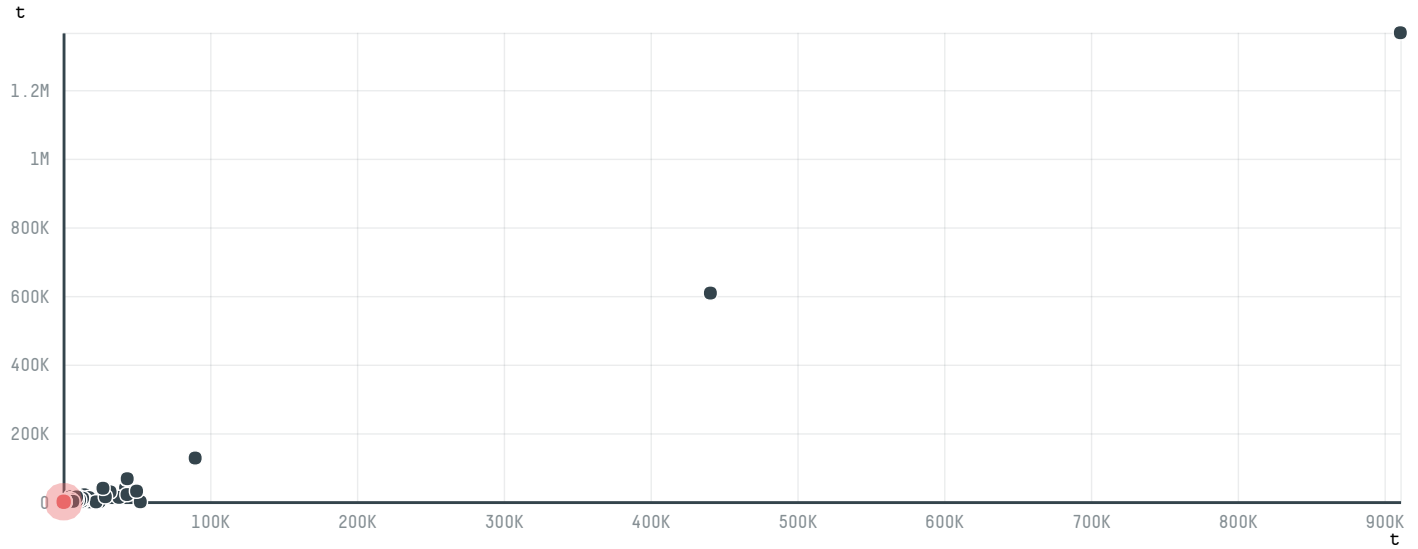

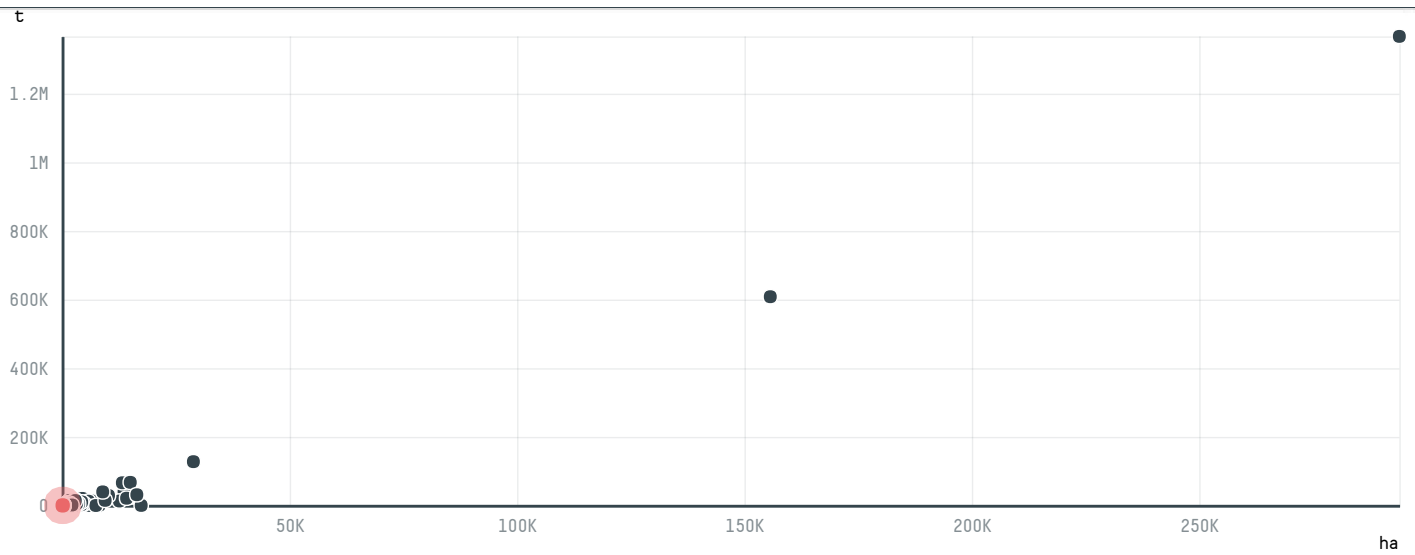
