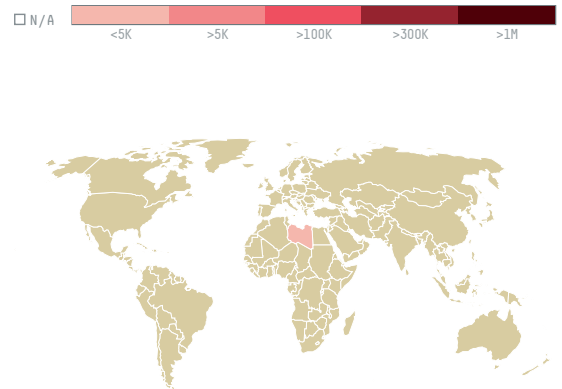
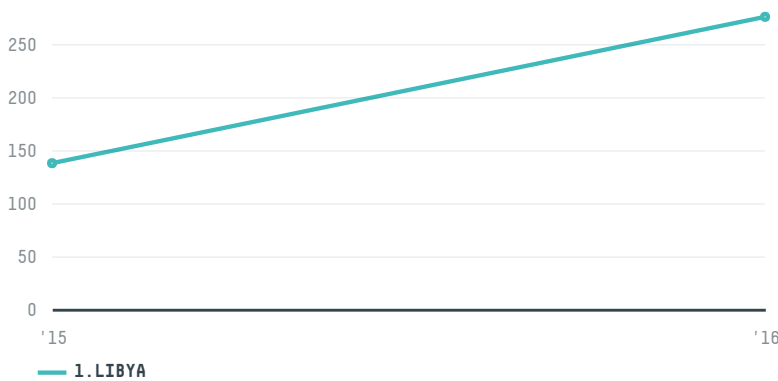


BUSTAN LIBYA FOR FOOD IMPORTATION & LIVESTOCK INVESTMEN

As an importer, BUSTAN LIBYA FOR FOOD IMPORTATION & LIVESTOCK INVESTMEN sources from 5 municipalities, or 1% of the chicken production municipalities. The main destination of the chicken imported by BUSTAN LIBYA FOR FOOD IMPORTATION & LIVESTOCK INVESTMEN is LIBYA, accounting for 100% of the total.

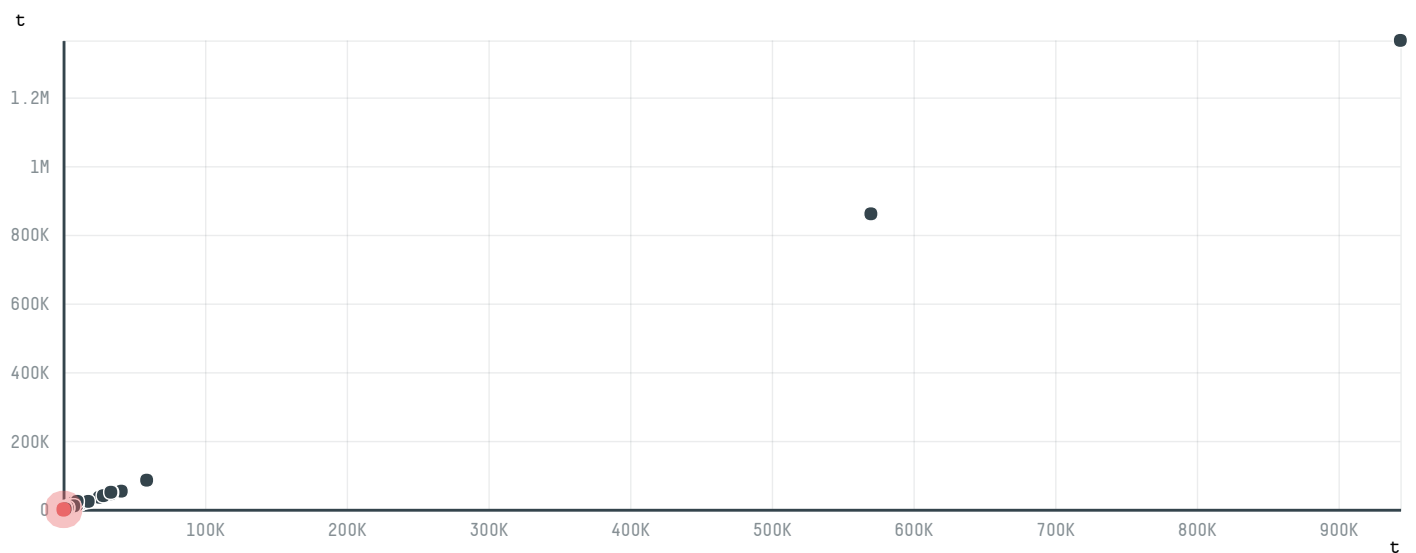


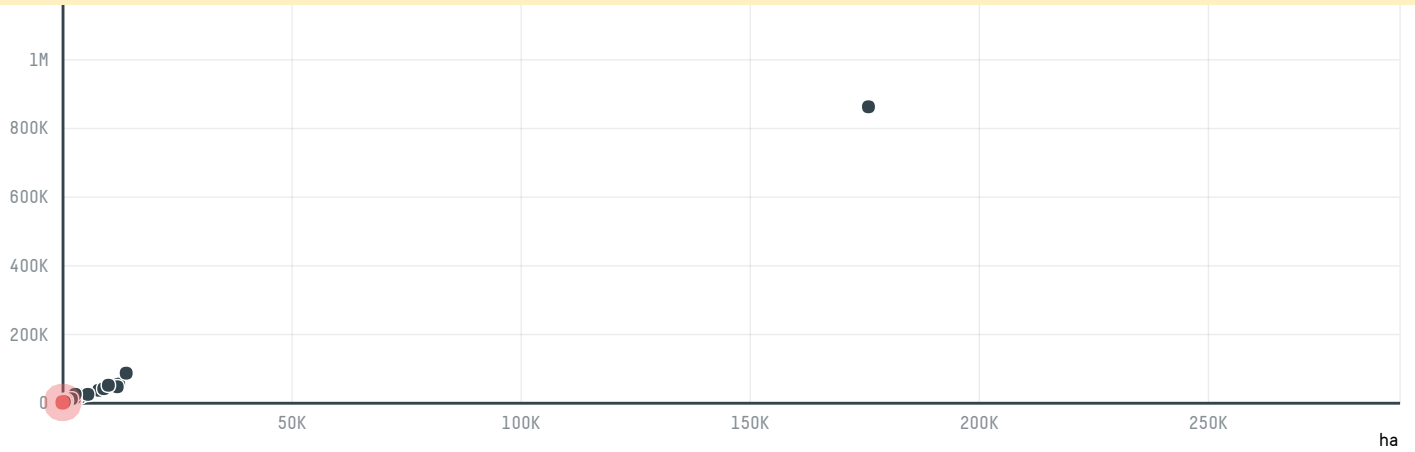
