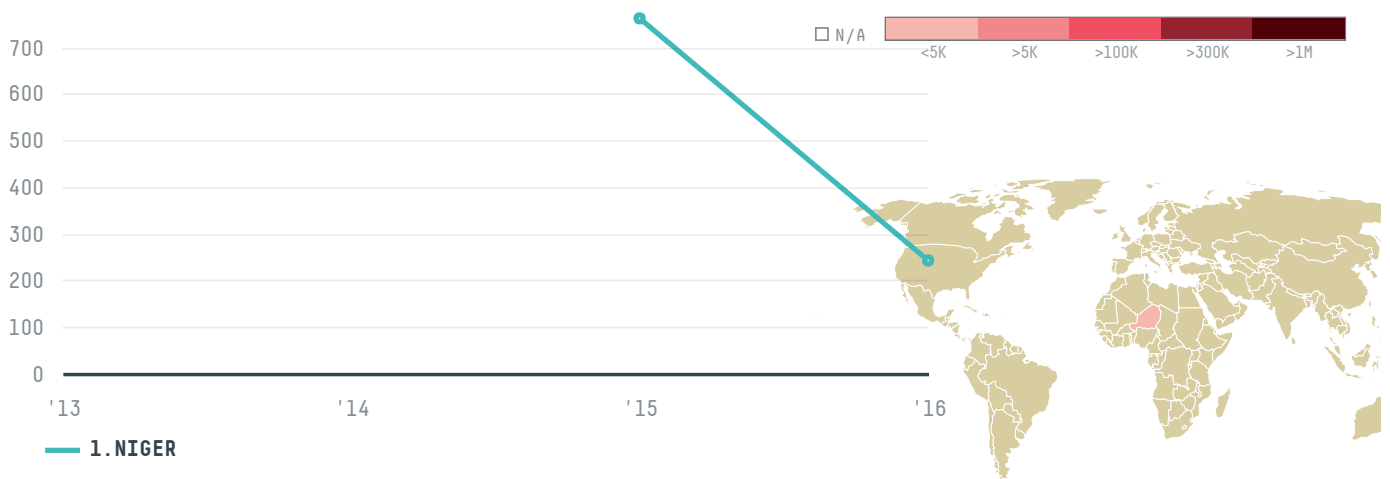

TAJUDDEN AUWAL was the 391st largest importer of palm oil from INDONESIA in 2016, accounting for 241 tons. This is a 68% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, TAJUDDEN AUWAL sources from 1 kabupatens, or 100% of the palm oil production kabupatens. The main destination of the palm oil imported by TAJUDDEN AUWAL is NIGER, accounting for 100% of the total.
