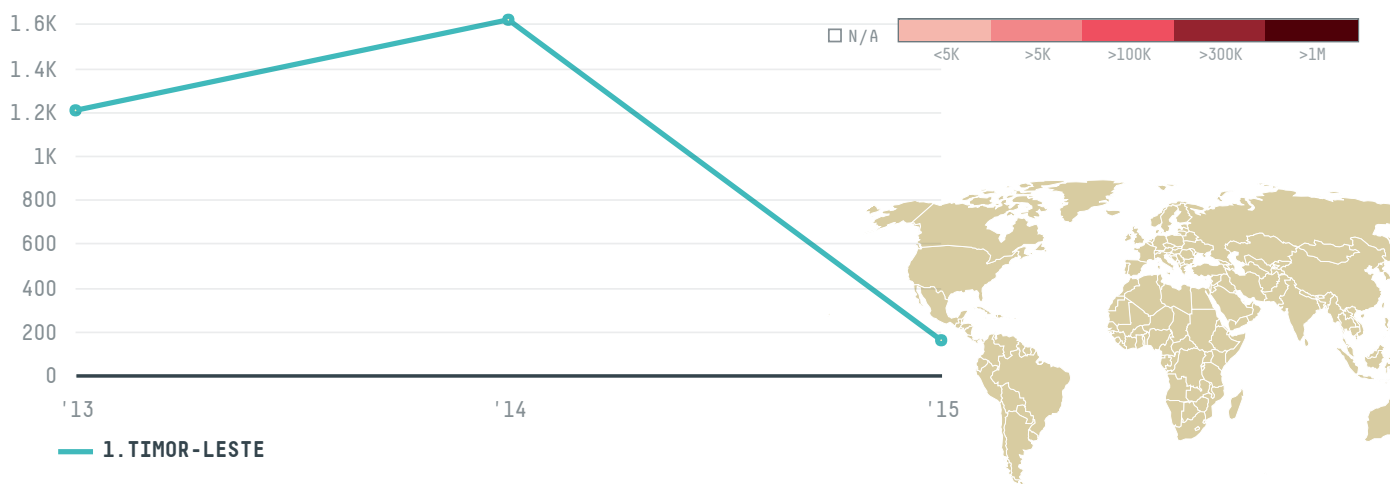

TIMOR FOOD was the 314th largest importer of palm oil from INDONESIA in 2015, accounting for 158 tons. This is a 90% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, TIMOR FOOD sources from 1 kabupatens, or 0% of the palm oil production kabupatens. The main destination of the palm oil imported by TIMOR FOOD is TIMOR-LESTE, accounting for 100% of the total.
