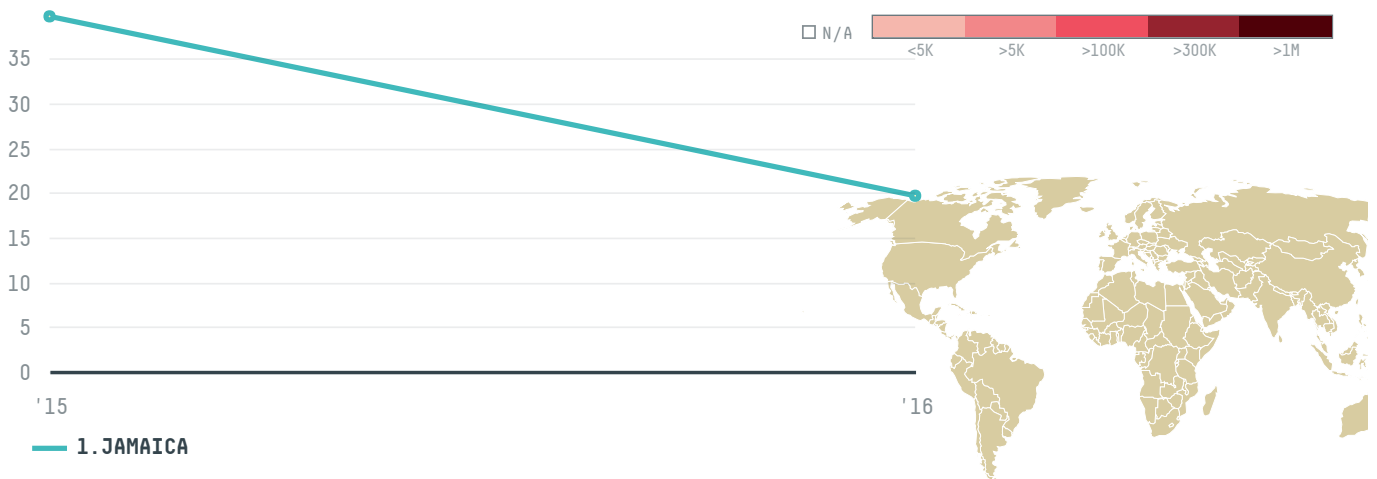

CARDINAL FOODS was the 572nd largest importer of palm oil from INDONESIA in 2016, accounting for 20 tons. This is a 51% decrease vs the previous year. As an importer, CARDINAL FOODS sources from 1 kabupatens, or 100% of the palm oil production kabupatens. The main destination of the palm oil imported by CARDINAL FOODS is JAMAICA, accounting for 100% of the total.
