

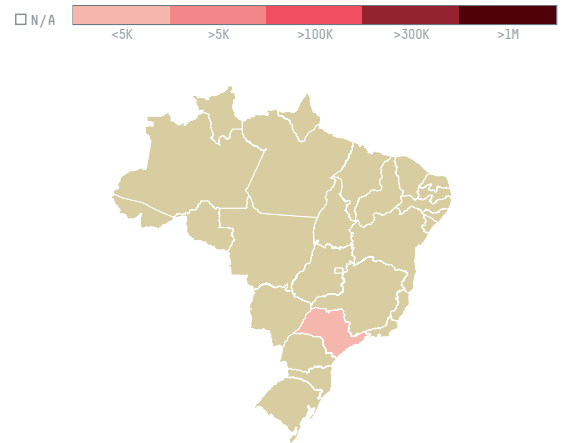
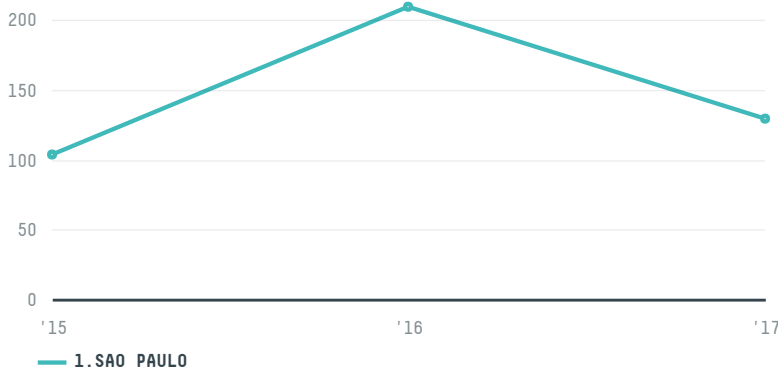

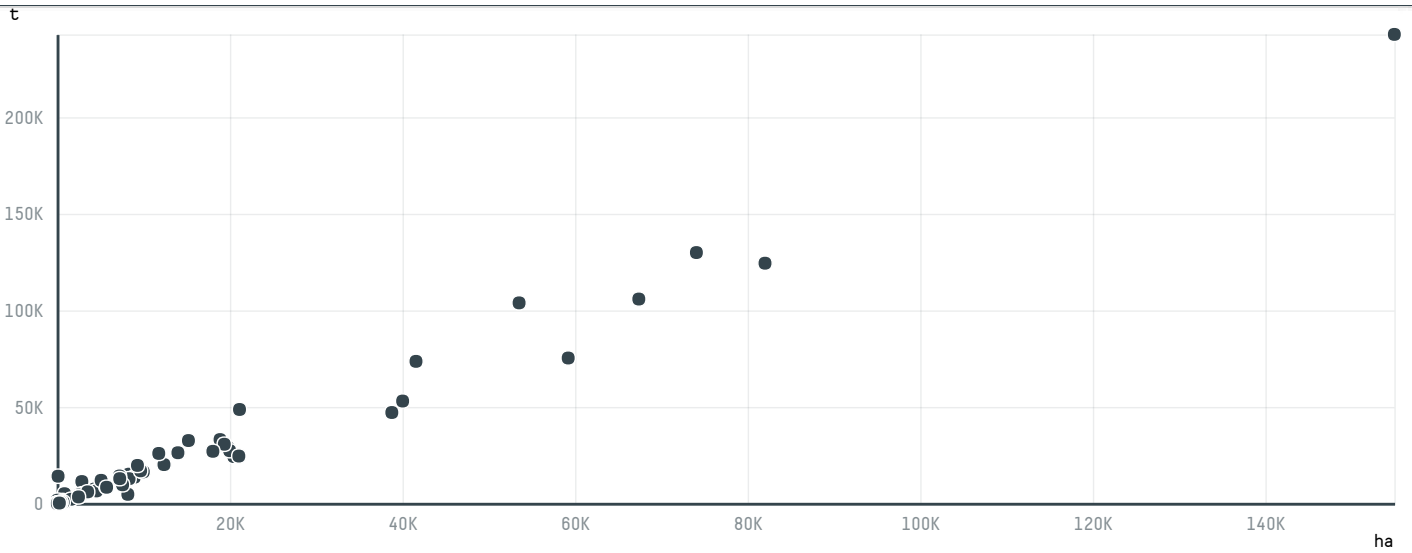

BRASILJUTA IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO EIRELI - EPP was the 115th largest exporter of coffee from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 130 tons. This is a 38% decrease vs the previous year. As an exporter, BRASILJUTA IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO EIRELI - EPP sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the coffee production municipalities. The main destination of the coffee exported by BRASILJUTA IMPORTACAO E EXPORTACAO EIRELI - EPP is ALBANIA, accounting for 41% of the total.
