MC AGRI ALLIANCE was the 137th largest importer of coffee from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 1 thousand tons. This is a 7418% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, MC AGRI ALLIANCE sources from 7 municipalities, or 1% of the coffee production municipalities.

**Recent updates to "Deforestation Exposure"**

On 10 November 2022, the term 'deforestation risk' was replaced with 'deforestation exposure' as a measure of the exposure of supply chain actors to deforestation from commodity production based on sourcing patterns.

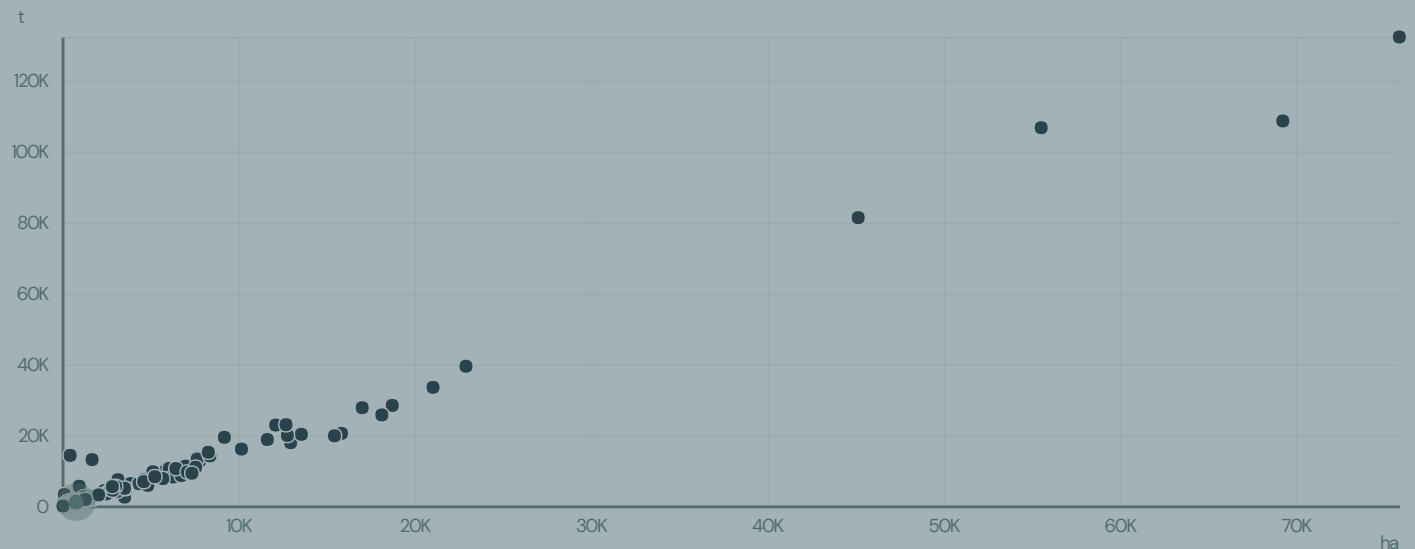
Improvements in how commodity deforestation exposure is calculated were made on 7 December 2022. Numbers accessed before that date will differ from those accessed after.
