



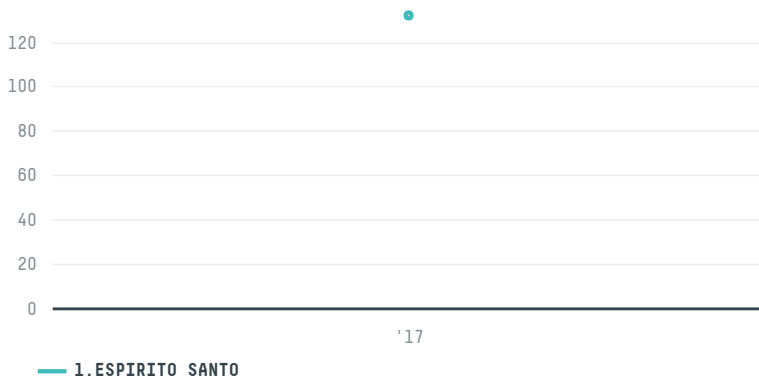

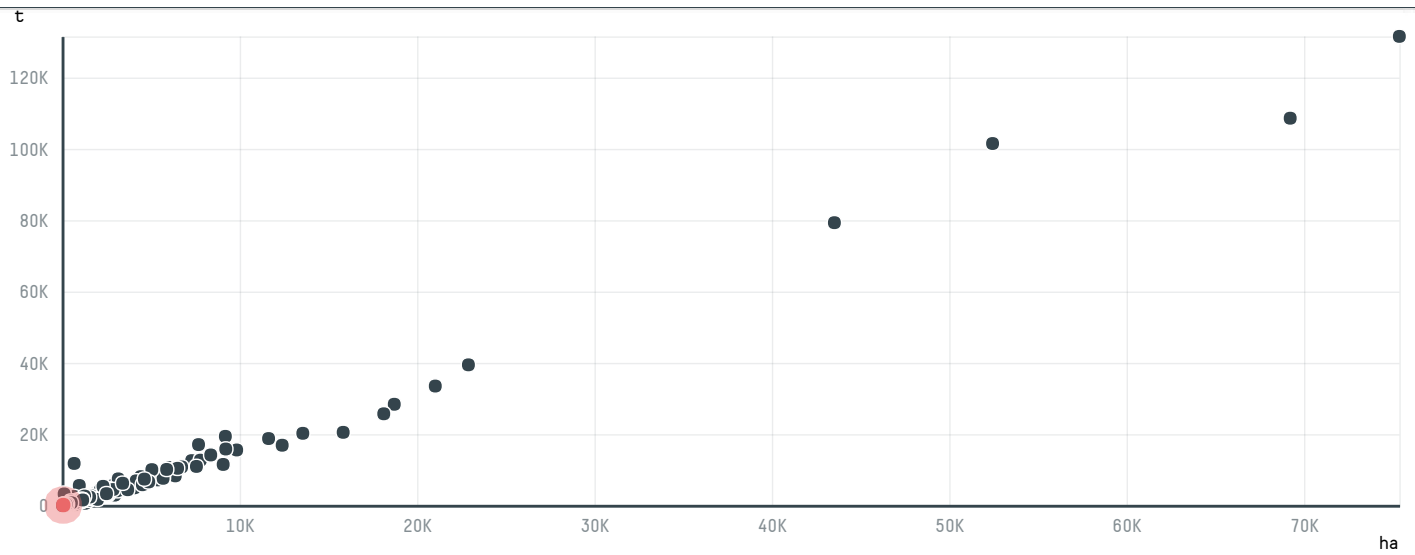

MOUFAK NAJJAR was the 623rd largest importer of coffee from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 132 tons. As an importer, MOUFAK NAJJAR sources from 2 municipalities, or 0% of the coffee production municipalities. The main destination of the coffee imported by MOUFAK NAJJAR is SYRIA, accounting for 100% of the total.
