



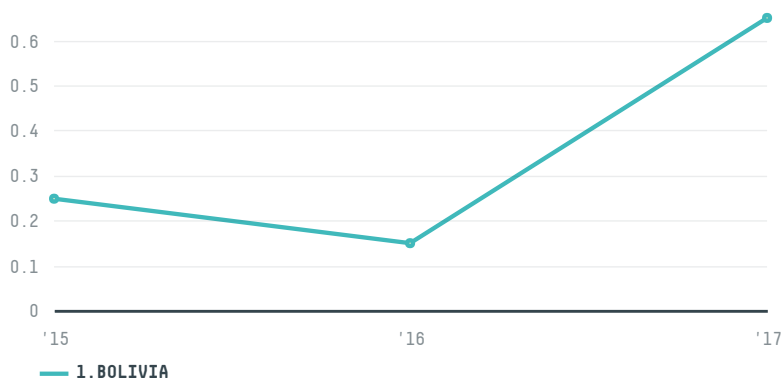

## CIPRIANO MARCA CHOQUE

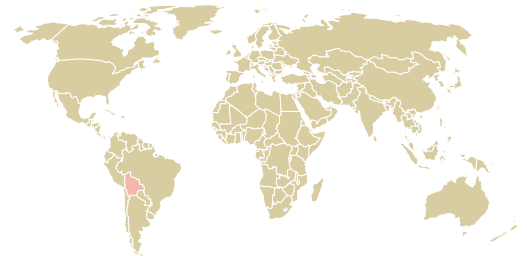

CIPRIANO MARCA CHOQUE was the 173rd largest importer of corn from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 1 tons. This is a 333% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, CIPRIANO MARCA CHOQUE sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the corn production municipalities. The main destination of the corn imported by CIPRIANO MARCA CHOQUE is BOLIVIA, accounting for 100% of the total.

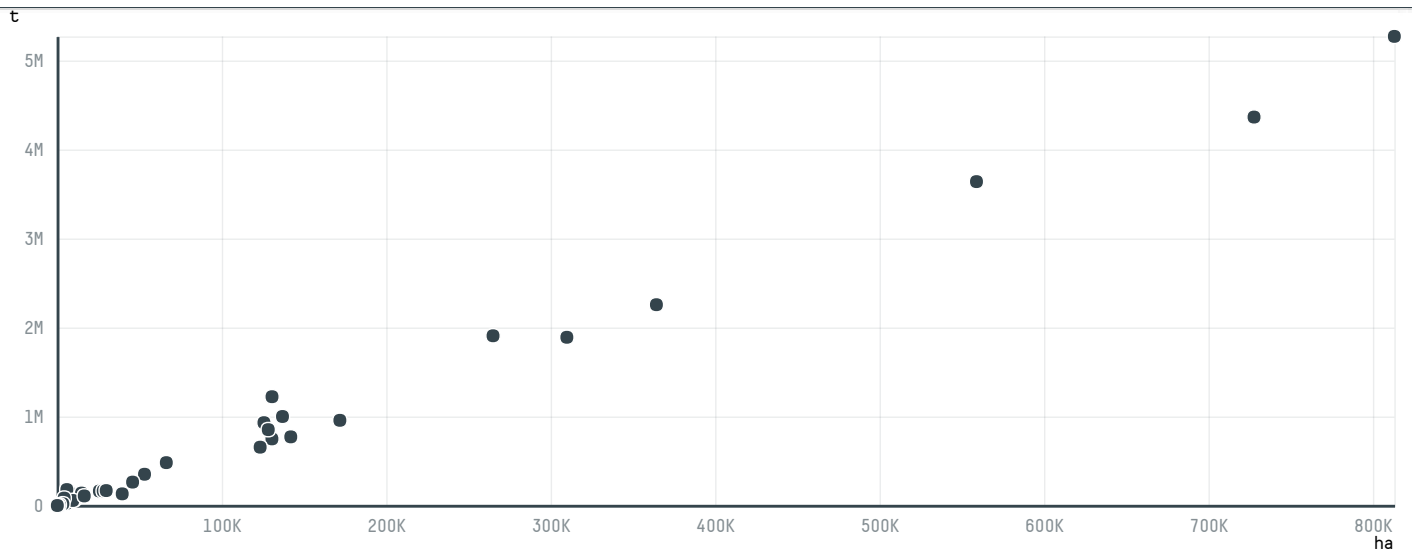
### TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CORN IMPORTED BY CIPRIANO MARCA CHOQUE:
