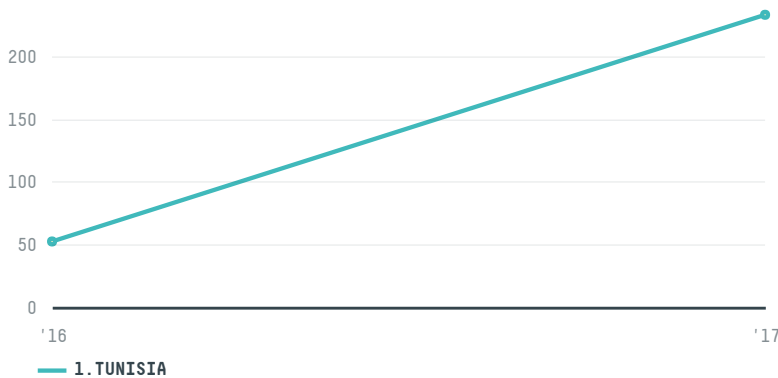


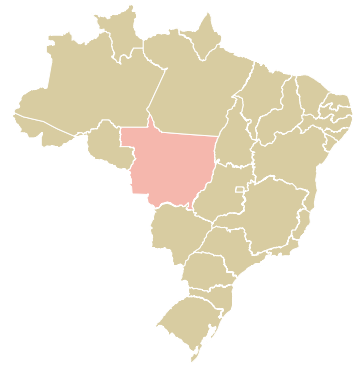
# STE EL KARAMA INTERNATIONAL TRADING

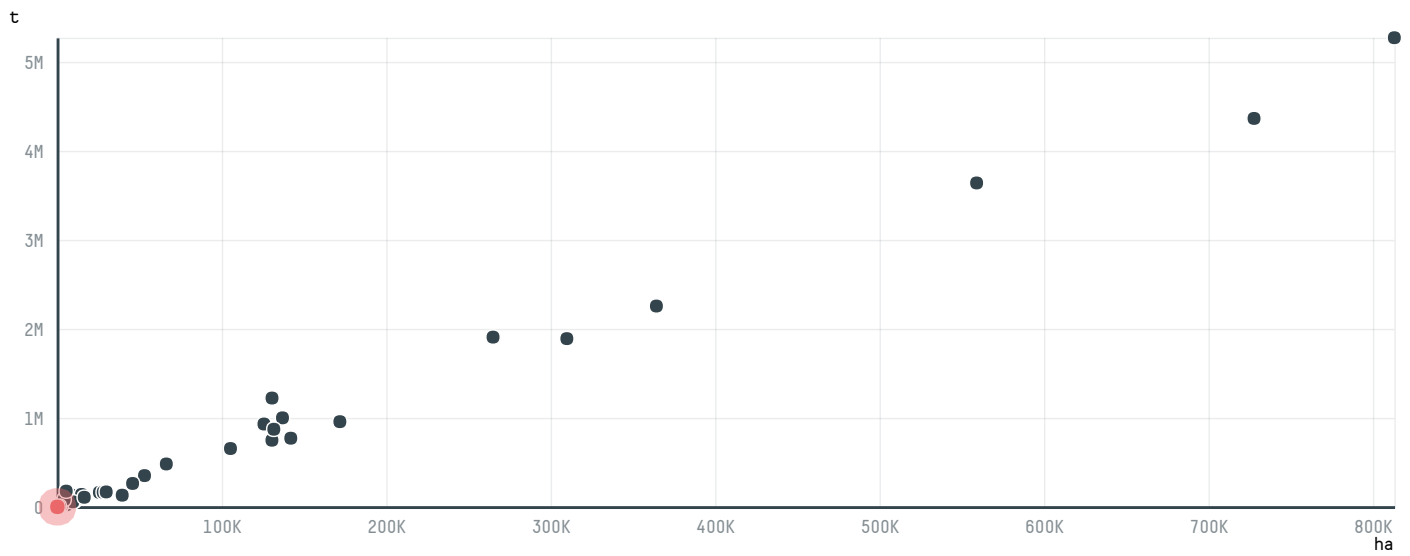
STE EL KARAMA INTERNATIONAL TRADING was the 71st largest importer of corn from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 233 tons. This is a 348% increase vs the previous year. As an importer, STE EL KARAMA INTERNATIONAL TRADING sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the corn production municipalities. The main destination of the corn imported by STE EL KARAMA INTERNATIONAL TRADING is TUNISIA, accounting for 100% of the total.

## TOP DESTINATION COUNTRIES OF CORN IMPORTED BY STE EL KARAMA INTERNATIONAL TRADING:

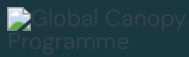
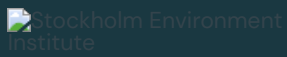




### COMPARING COMPANIES IMPORTING CORN FROM BRAZIL IN 2017
