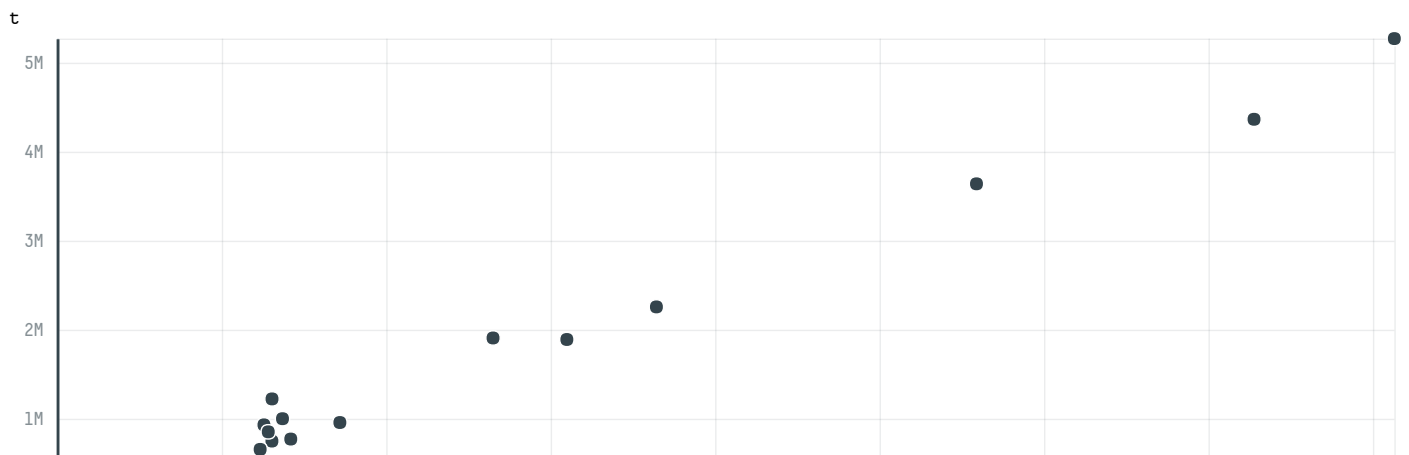

CARLOS PADILLA was the 125th largest importer of corn from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 37 tons. As an importer, CARLOS PADILLA sources from 1 municipalities, or 0% of the corn production municipalities. The main destination of the corn imported by CARLOS PADILLA is BOLIVIA, accounting for 100% of the total.
