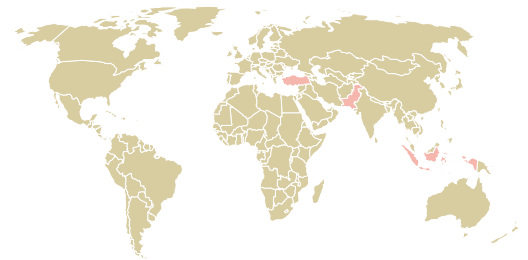
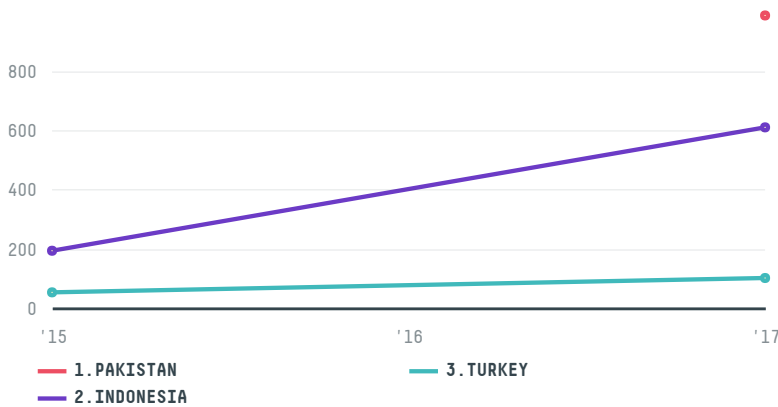

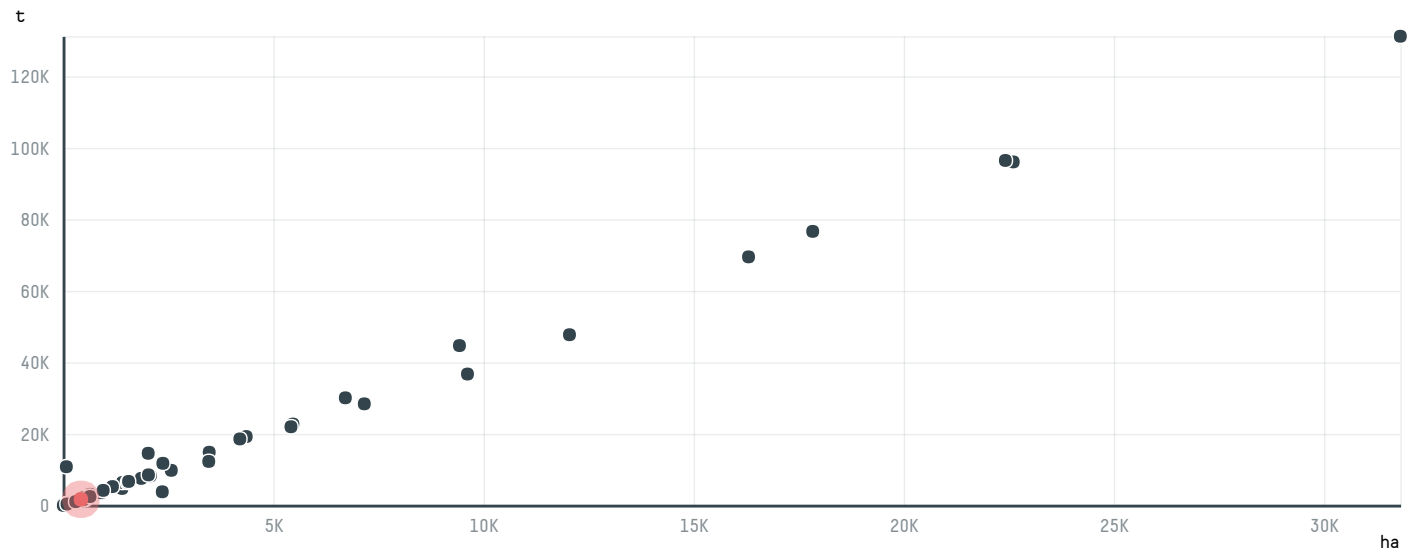

MARINO JOSE FRANZ was the 43rd largest exporter of cotton from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 2 thousand tons. As an exporter, MARINO JOSE FRANZ sources from 1 municipalities, or 1% of the cotton production municipalities. The main destination of the cotton exported by MARINO JOSE FRANZ is PAKISTAN, accounting for 58% of the total.
