



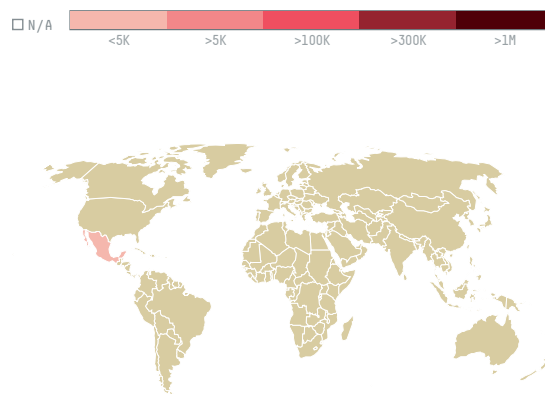
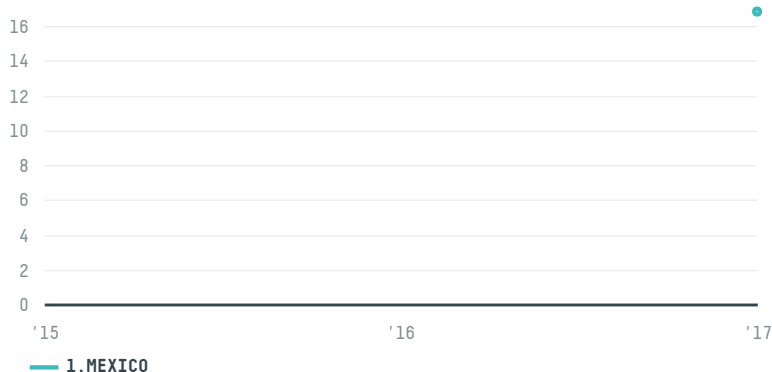

## ENGELHART

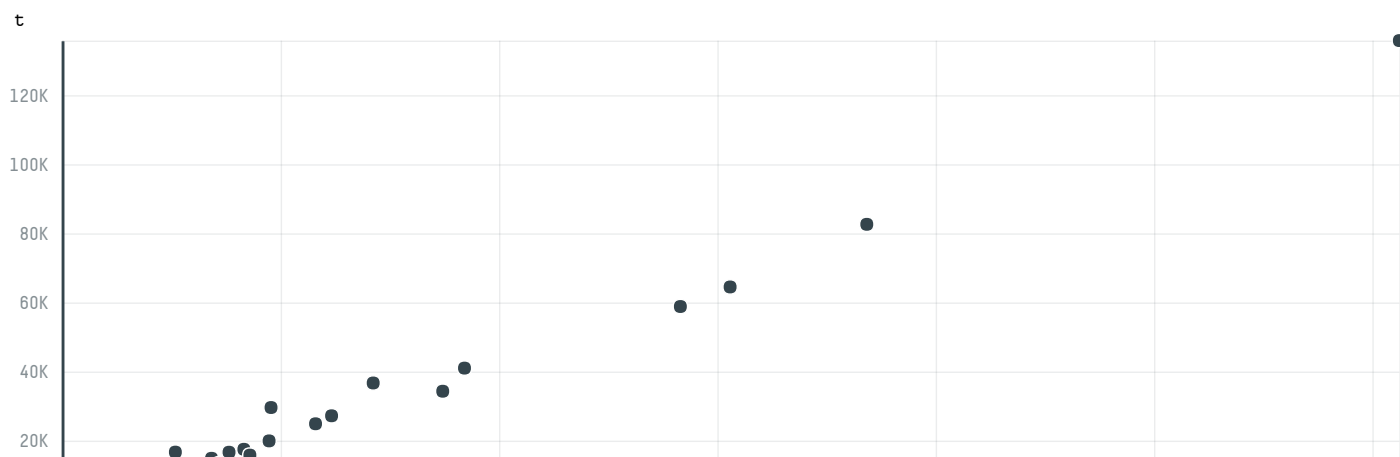

ENGELHART was the 163rd largest importer of cotton from BRAZIL in 2017, accounting for 17 tons. As an importer, ENGELHART sources from 1 municipalities, or 1% of the cotton production municipalities. The main destination of the cotton imported by ENGELHART is MEXICO, accounting for 100% of the total.
